Daily report on the situation of Palestinian refugees in Syria



"14 Palestinian-Syrians died in December 2017, while 15 died in the same month of 2016"

Victims

35 year-old Palestinian, “Khaled Al-Zamel” has died on 6th of December 2017, in bombardments by Russian aircrafts, targeting the city of Harasta and a number of areas in the eastern Ghouta, in the suburbs of Damascus. He was from the city of Harasta.

On its part, the Action Group documented the death of 1148 Palestinian refugees, due to the bombardments in Syria.



Latest Developments

AGPS’s Documentation and Monitoring Team has announced that 14 Palestinian refugees have died during December 2017, according to its records, while 15 refugees died in the same month of 2016, due to the ongoing conflict in Syria.

The Action Group indicated that the victims who died in December 2017, were distributed across the following areas: 8 refugees in Hama, 2 refugees died in unknown areas, 2 in Deir ez-Zour, one in Deraa and another in Idlib.

Meanwhile, the Action Group noted that the 15 victims of December 2016, died across the Syrian cities as follows: 4 refugees died in the suburbs of Damascus, 4 in Homs, 4 in different areas, one in Aleppo, a refugee in Damascus and the last in Deir ez-Zour.

In south Syria, Deraa camp for Palestinian refugees was bombarded with a number of mortar shells, causing material destruction only.



The residents of Deraa camp, in which 80% of its buildings are destroyed, and the Sad Road neighborhood, are still complaining of harsh humanitarian conditions, due to siege imposed the regime's army on the camp and the areas adjacent to it. They are also suffering from an extreme lack of food supplies, as well as the continuous water, electricity and communication cuts for long periods of time.

In a similar context, the Tadamon neighborhood and the outskirts of Yarmouk camp (Palestine Street and the Martyrs sector), have been violently bombarded with gas cylinders, causing material destruction and damages to the residents' houses.

Meanwhile, Yarmouk camp and the Tadamon neighborhood have seen a sharp escalation in the intensity of fighting and bombardments, after ISIS launched a surprise attack on the Syrian regime's checkpoint in the Nisreen neighborhoods, on 11th of December, and took control over a number of building blocks in the neighborhood.

In the meantime, six members of ISIS and three civilians, left through the Maamal Bardy checkpoint, after coordinating with the regime. Among those who left was "Bassel Ghabsh," known as the Sarot, and "Zayed Al-Ashqar" and Osama, known as Al-Ashqar.

According to the sources in south Damascus, the nine members will enter Idlib. The exit of at least five members of ISIS was confirmed a few days ago, with the company of a civilian, through the Maamal Bardy checkpoint, in coordination with the Syrian regime in return for money, according to our correspondent in the south of Damascus.

Palestinians of Syria: January 07, 2018 Statistics:

- The total number of victims documented by the Action Group is 3632, including 463 women



- 1644 Palestinians are locked up behind Syrian government's bars, 106 of which are women
- Yarmouk refugee camp is under the Syrian regime army and Popular Front for the Liberation of Palestine's siege for 1,635 days in a row
- 204 refugees, mainly in Yarmouk Camp, have died due to lack of medical care and malnutrition
- Water supplies have been cut off Deraa Camp for 1372 days, and 1212 days in Yarmouk Camp
- The Regime army has been in control of Handarat camp for more than 470 days. More than 80% of its buildings have been completely or partially destroyed.
- Approximately 85 thousand Palestinian-Syrian refugees fled to Europe by the end of 2016
- 31 thousand refugees are located in Lebanon
- 17 thousand refugees are sheltered in Jordan
- 6 thousand refugees are in Egypt
- 8 thousand refugees are staying in Turkey
- One thousand refugees are present in Gaza
