Latest Developments

Three Palestinians from the Palestine Liberation Army were pronounced dead on Monday, July 16.

The victims are: Husain Ali Mohamed, Nidal Sa'id Oudeh, and Mohamed Abdullah Youssef. They were killed as they fought alongside the Syrian government forces in AlSuweida desert.



Brigadier General Ayman Kassab and officers Abdullah Rudeini were injured in Daraa hostilities, south of Syria.

The two brothers Ismail and Ziyad Adel Youssef Za'za', from AlHajar AlAswad, were also killed under torture in Syrian government lock-ups.

According to one of the victims' relatives, Ziyad was kidnapped in 2013 and Ismail in 2014. The Syrian government forces handed over their clothes and identity documents to their families.

Meanwhile, a Palestinian child from Syria drowned off Sweden's seashore on July 15.

The child, identified as Husam Mohamed Idris, reportedly sunk at sea as he tried to rescue his younger brother.

In the meantime, AGPS has learned that families of detained Palestinians who have been appealing for information regarding their relatives' fate may access such data at the office of the Arab Palestinian Refugees General Commission in Daraa.

Concerned families should apply for civil registration documents to identify their relatives' names and conditions.

A few days earlier, 34 Palestinians from AlAyedeen refugee camps in Hums and Hama were pronounced dead as a result of torture in Syrian government jails. Their families received the death reports through the Arab Palestinian Refugees General Commission in Syria.

At the same time, Palestinian refugee Omar Ya'kob Hijazi, aged 43, has been kept in Syrian government detention centers for six years.



Hijazi, a resident of Yarmouk Camp, was arrested by the government forces on the Syrian-Lebanese borders. His fate remains unknown.

In a related development, Palestinian refugee Yazen Ameen Hafedh, a resident of AlHajar AlAswad in Rif Dimashq, has disappeared from Naseeb town in Daraa some few days ago. No pieces of information have been received by his family as regards his fate and location.

According to AGPS data, 311 Palestinians have gone missing in war-torn Syria.

In another development, Palestinian refugee Samer Faraj Idris, from AlAyedeen Camp in Hums, finished second at the Classic body building championship staged in Hums on July 16.
