Latest Developments

AGPS's correspondent confirmed that ISIS continues to terrorize teachers in Yarmouk camp. It forced them to attend a meeting a few days ago in Al-Safadi mosque, to warn the teachers of strict punishments if they remain teaching children according to the present curriculums, which it described as “infidel.”



In a similar context, Yarmouk camp saw night clashes between ISIS and “Jaish Al-Islam” in “Dawar Palestine” axis and Al-Zein neighbourhood.

Our reporter said that these clashes have been breaking out on a daily basis, between ISIS and a number of factions affiliated to the armed Syrian opposition groups, without causing losses on either side.

For its part, Facebook pages close to the Syrian regime posted a statement made by “Saed Abd Al-Aal,” commander of the military wing in the Free Palestine Movement affiliated to the Syrian regime, that that a preliminary agreement between the Syrian government and representatives of the armed factions in “Al-Qadam” neighborhood, south of Damascus, urges the armed groups and their families that want to leave, to move in the northern direction towards Idlib and Jarabulus in the Aleppo suburbs. They are expected to leave on the upcoming Tuesday or Wednesday.

According to “Abd Al-Aal” the number of opposition fighters in Al-Qadam neighborhood has reached 600, without the ISIS fighter who were not included in the agreement. This comes amid the announcement of the armed Syrian opposition in Al-Qadam on the preparation for the implementation of a preliminary agreement between them and the Syrian regime to withdraw its members from the neighborhood.

In south Syria, Palestinians in Syria Relief and Development Association, in cooperation with “Shorouk Al-Shams” Organization, distributed financial aid to 50 Palestinian orphans in the towns of Al Muzeereeb, Tal Shehab, Al-Ajami, Jileen, Al-Muzairah and Deraa camp.

Palestinians of Syria: September 24, 2017 Statistics:

- The total number of victims documented by the Action Group is 3587, including 462 women
- 1637 Palestinians are locked up behind Syrian government's bars, 103 of which are women
- Yarmouk refugee camp is under the Syrian regime army and Popular Front for the Liberation of Palestine's siege for 1,530 days in a row
- 199 refugees, mainly in Yarmouk Camp, have died due to lack of medical care and malnutrition
- Water supplies have been cut off Deraa Camp for 1267 days, and 1107 days in Yarmouk Camp
- Residents of Handarat Camp, in Aleppo have been banned from their homes for 1,603 days. Government troops have taken over the camp for more than 354 days.
- Approximately 85 thousand Palestinian-Syrian refugees fled to Europe by the end of 2016
- 31 thousand refugees are located in Lebanon
- 17 thousand refugees are sheltered in Jordan
- 6 thousand refugees are in Egypt
- 8 thousand refugees are staying in Turkey
- One thousand refugees are present in Gaza
