"The Palestinians in South of Syria Suffer of the Miserable Health Status"

Recent Updates

The Palestinians of Syria in Daraa camp , Al Muzeereeb Compound, Jilin, Tal Shehab and other areas in southern Syria suffer from a miserable health situation, where the frequent bombing in these areas led to the a semi-destruction of the medical entity in these areas.

The areas lack hospitals or medical centers that provide health services to the residents, where the medical points provide only some medical assistance. In addition to the complete stop of UNRWA services in the mentioned areas, which led to a huge bad increase to the health status because of some reasons such as cutting all main roads, the strict siege, the materials and medical assistance shortages. There are no real international or relief efforts to reach the aid to those areas specially the negligence of UNRWA to provide its services towards the Palestinians of Syria in southern Syria.



In the middle of Syria, the Syrian Security released the Palestinian refugee Khalid Mahmoud Edrees from Al Aedin camp in Homs. Khalid spent 60 days in Adra prison. Mohamemd Zeyad Ayoub was released



after detention for 40 days, where he was released the day before and he is from Al Jash village in Palestine. Ayman Khattab also was released after 40 days detention in Palestine Branch in Damascus, he is from Ein Al Zaytoun village in Palestine. It is referred that AGPS documented 1100 detention cases for the Palestinians of Syria during the past 5 years.

In a different context, a group of secondary school students left Yarmouk camp the day before to Damascus to perform the level exam of the 10th and 11th grades through Yelda town then to Bait Sahem.



UNRWA started to distribute the financial assistance for the third round of 2016 to the Palestinians of Syria refugees, where it provided each individual 36000 Syrian Lira and 18000 for each individual in the shelter centers. UNRWA referred that there are no lists for the difficult cases but the families are listed within the normal lists.

It is noted that UNRWA carried out data audition for individuals of the Palestinians of Syria, who did not benefit from the last rounds, in order to insure that everyone is in the lists of the financial aid in Syria and to update the data of the families number for the financial aid program. It is



mentioned that the Palestinians of Syria refugees live in difficult situation in light of the displacement operations, high prices, unemployment spread, and high rents in addition to the arrest raids and death in the ongoing conflict in Syria.

In Greece, hundreds of Palestinians of Syria who are stranded in Greece suffer from miserable living conditions, lack of medication, and medical neglect, due to the roadblocks between Greece and European countries for the refugees, who risked their lives to reach Greece from Turkey.

After closing the borders leading to Europe, the refugees were forced to stay in the temporary refuges in Greece within the miserable living conditions that they pass through. Moreover, the refugees suffer from the lack of hygiene and basic services, where they live in temporary tents that full of insects, reptiles, scorpions, and poisonous snakes. The stranded families appealed all the international and humanitarian organizations, ICRC and the Palestinian Embassy in Greece to put an end to their plight.





It is noteworthy that many activists accused the PLO, Palestinian Embassy in Greece of neglecting the Palestinian of Syria conditions. Moreover, they called the families not to appeal the Palestinian Authority because they neglect the refugees' affairs.

Palestinians of Syria Numbers and Statistics until 31|08|2016

- *15500 Palestinian Syrian refugees are in Jordan*
- *42.500 Palestinian Syrian refugees are in Lebanon*
- *6000 Palestinian Syrian refugees are in Egypt, according to the UNRWA statistics till July 2015*
- *8000 Palestinian Syrian refugees are in Turkey*
- *1000 Palestinian Syrian refugees are in Gaza*
- *More than 79,000 Palestinian Syrian refugees have reached Europe till mid -2016*
- *The Yarmouk Camp: siege, imposed by the Regular Army and PFGC groups, continued for 1170 consecutive days. Power cut continued for more than 1231 days, water was cut for 720 days respectively. The number of siege victims is 187.*
- *Al Sbeina Camp: - Regular Army is still preventing the residents of the camp to return back to their houses for 1021 days respectively.*
- *Handarat Camp: - All Residents have left the camp for about 1215 days after the Syrian Opposition Groups controlled it.*
- *Dara'a Camp: - It is now almost 874 days without water and almost 70% of its buildings were demolished.*
