### “A Palestinian Girl Dies and her Sister Injured due to the Shelling at Al Adawi Neighborhood in Damascus”

## Victims

The 15-year-old girl "Shahd Al Qusi" died and her twin sister was injured following the mortar shelling which targeted their home at Al Adawi neighborhood in Damascus.

It is worth mentioning that the AGPS documented the death of 1052 Palestinian refugees following the direct bombing of their homes in Syria.



On the other hand, the PLA Lieutenant "Mohamed Mounir Rdene" died on Wednesday 28/10/2015 during clashes between the Syrian armed opposition groups and the regular army alongside the Palestinian Liberation Army in the town of Tal Sowan on the outskirts of Douma area in Damascus suburb.

The AGPS documented the death of many young people who were mostly died due to clashes in different parts of Damascus. Military service is mandatory for Palestinian refugees in Syria and many young people to refuse performing military service in Syria and travel to neighboring countries.





### Recent Updates

Residents of Khan Al Shieh camp in Damascus suburb organized a solidarity activity, as they showed their solidarity with people of Jerusalem against aggression and attacks by the Israeli occupation army.



It is worth mentioning that the activity coincided with a number of raids that targeted the outskirts of the camp with four explosive barrels.

This comes in light of the ongoing battles and clashes between the regular army and the Syrian armed opposition groups in the surrounding villages and towns.

The Syrian security forces arrested the Palestinian refugee "Qasim Al Rayyan," a resident of the Yarmouk camp, at the checkpoint of Naher Aisha area in Damascus and he was transferred to an unknown location.

Turning to Aleppo, clashes have been ongoing for two weeks between the regular army and affiliated groups on one hand, and armed opposition groups on the other hand, in Khanasser and Athareya areas, which is the only way for the people of Aleppo and Neirab that leads to the city of Hama and Damascus, which supplies Neirab camp with various goods and materials.

The AGPS correspondent at Neirab camp monitored a significant rise in the price which has increased the burden of Palestinian refugees in Aleppo and Neirab camp, as he described.



The road between Neirab and Aleppo city was closed after the armed opposition groups preceded towards Sheikh Saeed and Ramouseh road, while people of Neirab and university students in Aleppo are waiting for the road to open.

It is noteworthy that the camp is witnessing a state of instability and unsafety due to the tense security situation in the adjacent areas, and the Neirab's location near the Neirab military airport which made it a strategic location for the conflict parties in Syria, as well as for being subjected previously to bombing and shooting which led to casualties among civilians.

### Civil Work Committees

Al Rahma campaign completed food aid distribution to the people of Husseneia camp in Damascus suburb. The campaign distributed on Saturday morning, in cooperation with the Charity Organization for the Relief of Palestinian people, 1000 food baskets, and about 500 baby milk cartons.

It is worth mentioning that the regular army checkpoints prevented residents of Husseneia camp to return to their homes for more than two years, before allowing hundreds of them to enter the camp August last.





**Numbers and Statistics till 31/10/2015:-**

- 15,500 Palestinian Syrian refugees in Jordan, 45,000 Palestinian Syrian refugees in Lebanon, and 6,000 refugees in Egypt, according to the UNRWA's statistics till July 2015.
- At least 36,000 Palestinian Syrian refugees have reached Europe during the last 4 years.
- The Yarmouk Camp: - Siege, imposed by the Regular Army and PFGC, continued for 852 days respectively. In addition, power cuts continued for more than 922 days, water was cut for 412 days respectively. The number of victims due to the siege has reached to 182 victims.
- Al Sbeina Camp: - Regular Army is still preventing the residents of the camp to return back to their houses for 713 days respectively.
- Handarat Camp: - Residents have left the camp for 914 days after the Syrian Opposition Groups controlled it.
- Dara'a Camp: - It is now almost 558 days without water and 70% of its buildings were demolished.
- Jarmana, AL Saieda Zainab, Al Raml, Al Aedein Camps in Homs and Hamma: - A relatively quiet situation in light of the economic crises.
- Khan Al Sheih Camp: - Roads linking the camp to the city center are still closed except for Zakia- Khan Al Shieh road.
