### *“Aids Distribution Suspension after Opening Fire in the Yarmouk Camp, the AGPS: A Complete Palestinian Official Shortage towards the Catastrophes of the New Palestinian Asylum”*

### **Victims**

*The Palestinian refugee "Amer Hasan AL Masri", was born in 1969 and died due to lack of medical care in the besieged Yarmouk Camp, after he had burns that led to dehydration then a kidney failure.*

*It is noted that Palestine hospital is the only remaining hospital in the Yarmouk camp and works with its minimum capacity due to the lack of medical supplies, tools and medicines, and the severe shortages of medical specialist crews. Coincided with electricity cut "the backbone of operating the hospital", as well as water cut, due to the continuation of the Palestinian Groups and the Syrian Army's siege for 573 days respectively, which to 164 victims; their names are documented at the AGPS.*

*Meanwhile, two young men, "Nawras Samara" and "Mustafa Hamidi", from Al Hajar Al Aswad neighborhood adjacent to the Yarmouk camp, were killed during the clashes between the Syrian Regular Army alongside with the Palestinian Committees and the armed opposition groups at Al Tadamon region.*

*News reported that the Syrian Army and the pro-Syrian committees sneaked into a building, where members of the armed opposition stabilize, and they explode the building.*

*As the young man "Sultan Ahmed Abdel Kader –Al Saleim" died due to wounds he attained a few days ago in the Yarmouk refugee camp.*



### **Recent Updates**

*The aids distribution in the Yarmouk camp was suspended after only 6 boxes were distributed due to clashes, while the residents returned back to the camp with no aids, amid accusations that the pro-Syrian army Palestinian Popular Committees of shooting and sniping at the distribution point.*

*News reports that clashes broke out in the Yarmouk and Al Thalathein Streets, as it's not the first time to fabricate shooting and sniping in order to fail the distribution process, which always ends with recriminations between the two parties. The clashes came in light of the siege imposed by regular army and PFGC for (574) days, power cut for (654)days, and water cut for (144)days respectively, and the high number of siege victims to (164) victims were killed due to siege.*

*In the same context, the AGPS confirmed, in a documentary report was published this morning titled "Palestinians of Syria, the wound still bleeding," that the reaction and shy mobility of the National references about the disasters of the new Palestinian asylum was remarkable. The required role to follow the drowning and open the necessary investigations regarding the violations towards the Palestinian refugees in the Mediterranean Sea or on land between the countries at airports or border, and the arrest and detention in very bad conditions, or deported to the countries where they came from, is till absent.*

*The group adds that "the Palestinian official shortage seemed clear from the inability to resolve the Palestinian refugees stranded problems in various places of refuge and limiting the role of reassuring at best without making any changes to their situation, but there was a clear run away of any role towards them. The role of the Palestinian embassy in Egypt confined to send a representative, who told the detainees that there are no solutions, as they will remain in prison until they accept deported to Syria", as the Palestinian embassy in Turkey transferred the issue of the detainees in Adana prison to the UNRWA, in clear evasion of their responsibilities.*

*On the other hand, the AGPS received a copy of the generalization letter of the Syrian Airline Company "Cham Wings Airline" to the travel and tourism offices in Syria, about the fulfillment of the conditions required*



*for the travel of the Palestinians, Syrians, and Iraqis to the Lebanese territory.*

*In Libya, news about detaining 25 Palestinian and Syrian refugees in Qernada in Al Baydaa city at the Green Mountain in the eastern north of Libya since 3 months and ten days. The reports mentioned that the decision to release them is suspended because they are waiting issuing papers from the Palestinian Consul in Libya. It is mentioned that Libya is considered one of the important gates towards Europe, thousands of Palestinian and Syrian refugees got out of Libyan shores to Europe escaping from the ongoing war in Syria.*

*In Cyprus, the Cypriot authorities extended the allowance period of the Palestinian refugees to empty the camp of Kokkina Tarmesiya for more 24 hours, after they began to unbind some tents. The authorities also stopped all services provided to the Palestinian refugees such as place, food and water, moreover, they closed the medical center. A refugee said” they will transfer everybody to streets, parks and mosques because there is no place to go to “.*



### ***Refugee camps in Cyprus***

*It is noteworthy that 240 Palestinian refugees were on a ship that was heading to Italy before the Cypriot Navy forced them to enter its land then they were transferred to the refugees' camp and lived in difficult and humanitarian situations. Some of the refugees refused to make asylum to Cyprus because of the difficult asylum procedures but under the threat to*



*cut the aids and for fear of ending the situation in the streets they were obliged to accept the asylum procedures to Cyprus and some of them refused to make asylum to Cyprus.*

*It is noted that the refugees performed many protests and sit-ins in front of the international and humanitarian organizations and sent some official letters to the Palestinian Authority Embassy but without any noted result that mention their transfer to the Asylum European countries.*

### ***Numbers and Statistics till 30/1/2015***

- *At least 27933 Palestinian Syrian refugees have reached Europe during the last 4 years.*
- *2629 Palestinian refugees were documented by the AGPS.*
- ***The Yarmouk Camp:*** - *Siege, imposed by the Regular Army and PFGC, continued for 574 days respectively. In addition, power cuts continued for more than 654 days, water was cut for 144 days respectively. The number of victims due to the siege has reached 164 victims.*
- *80,000 Palestinian Syrian refugees escaped from Syria to the neighboring towns, including 14348 refugees in Jordan, 42,000 in Lebanon, according to UNRWA statistics till November.*
- ***Al Husayneyya Camp:*** - *Regular Army is still preventing the residents of the camp to return back to their houses for 476 days respectively.*
- ***Al Sbeina Camp:*** - *Regular Army is still preventing the residents of the camp to return back to their houses for 445 days respectively.*
- ***Handarat Camp:*** - *Residents have left the camp for 647 days after the Syrian Opposition Groups controlled it.*
- ***Dara'a Camp:*** - *It is now almost 291 days without water and 70% of its buildings were demolished.*
- ***Jermana, AL SaiedaZainab, Al Raml, Al Aedein Camps in Homs and Hamma:*** - *A relatively quiet situation in light of the economic crises.*
- ***Khan Al Sheih Camp:*** - *Roads linking the camp to the city center are still closed except for Zakia- Khan Al Sheih road.*
