"100 Palestinian Refugees Die during Last March, Including 83 Die Due to Torture"

Statistics

The AGPS monitoring and documentation team revealed that "100" Palestinian refugees died in Syria during last March, including "83" refugees died due to torture in the Syrian regime's prisons, while "5" refugees died as a result of the siege and the lack of medical care, "5" died due to a gunshot, two refugees were shot by a sniper, two refugees died after being kidnapped and then killed, a refugee was assassinated, and a victim died for unknown reasons as the case was documented without details.

Victims

Eight Palestinian victims died due to torture in the Syrian prisons, including five of them were identified through the leaked images of the victims of torture in Syrian prisons. They are:

The brothers Nidal Jihad Saadeya and Yamen Jihad Saadeya, Nour Ghbari, Yasser Ibrahim Jouda from the Yarmouk refugee camp, and" Hussein Abu Tion " a PLA recruit from Dmr area, where he died after being detained for more than two years.

Three women died due to torture; they are: the Palestinian refugee " Nadine Abu Salah, " 22 years resident of Al Tadamon neighborhood in Damascus, after being detained for a year and a half, as she was a five



month pregnant before her arrest and her ID was delivered to their family. Meanwhile the sisters Hanein Adel Abu Al Haijaa 20 years and Lina Adel Abu Al Haijaa 23 years were also died after being detained for two years and a half; they are from Damascus and their IDs were delivered to their family.

The AGPS statistic for victims of tortures increased to "376" Palestinian victims.

Recent Updates

A number of staff and volunteers of the PRC in the Yarmouk camp implemented yesterday a solidarity vigil to protest against the targeted of personnel and medical staff at the camp, and to expressed their condemnation of the assassination of the medical and relief activist, "Yahya Abdullah Al-Hourani," who was assassinated by gunshot while on his way to Palestine hospital.

In turn, each of the ICRC in Geneva and the IFRC condemned the murder of the relief and medical activist "Yahya Abdullah Hourani," and called the parties of the conflict in Syria to respect the international humanitarian law and to refrain from attacking the workers in the field of humanitarian as well as hospitals and ambulance cars.

The charity and relief associations in the Yarmouk refugee camp continue land reclamation, where these associations planted those lands with winter and summer vegetables like spinach, chard, radishes, onions, ..), irrigated and fertilized, and then harvested, to be distributed to the people of Yarmouk in an attempt to meet the acute shortage of food and supplies inside the camp due to the continuation of the siege imposed by the Syrian army and the GC for 633 days respectively.

In the meantime the Palestinian families at Jaramana camp are suffering of stressful living and economic crises because of the continued war in Syria, where residents complain of rising house rents and the prices of foodstuffs.

In terms of the medical aspect, the camp suffers from some cases of Hepatitis among the residents because of contaminated water, which caused a state of fear of increase and spread of the disease, especially among children.

Lebanon

Palestine Charity Committee in Lebanon in cooperation with the Medical Care Center at Al Bidawi camp distributed baby milk to the Displaced

Numbers and Statistics till 31/3/2015

- *At least 27933 Palestinian Syrian refugees have reached Europe during the last 4 years.*
- ***The Yarmouk Camp:** - Siege, imposed by the Regular Army and PFGC, continued for 633 days respectively. In addition, power cuts continued for more than 713 days, water was cut for 203 days respectively. The number of victims due to the siege has reached to 173 victims.*
- *80,000 Palestinian Syrian refugees escaped from Syria to the neighboring towns, including 10,687 refugees in Jordan, 51,300 in Lebanon and 6,000 refugees in Egypt, according to UNRWA statistics till February 2015.*
- ***Al Husayneyya Camp:** - Regular Army is still preventing the residents of the camp to return back to their houses for 534 days respectively.*

- ***Al Sbeina Camp:*** - Regular Army is still preventing the residents of the camp to return back to their houses for **504** days respectively.
- ***Handarat Camp:*** - Residents have left the camp for **706** days after the Syrian Opposition Groups controlled it.
- ***Dara'a Camp:*** - It is now almost **350** days without water and **70%** of its buildings were demolished.
- ***Jermana, AL SaiedaZainab, Al Raml, Al Aedein Camps in Homs and Hamma:*** - A relatively quiet situation in light of the economic crises.
- ***Khan Al Sheih Camp:*** - Roads linking the camp to the city center are still closed except for Zakia- Khan Al Sheih road.
