Victims

Torture to Death policy practiced by Syrian security forces against the Palestinian refugees in its prisons is still continuing, while 3 refugees died yesterday due to torture and their families received their IDs. In addition, a refugee died after hours of being released; the four victims are:

- *The Palestinian Syrian refugee "Fayez Abdullah Saeed Al-Issa," from Khan Al Shieh camp in Damascus suburb, died due to torture after being detained for more than four months and his family received his ID and belongings.*

- *The two Palestinian refugee brothers, who were born in Damascus, "Wael Alaissat," 38 years, and his brother "Firas Alaissat," 33 years, and their family received their belongings and their death certificate.*
- *The Palestinian refugee "Samir Hassan Hassan", General Coordinator of Hemma Youth Group in Khan Al Shieh camp, who*

died several hours after being released by the Syrian security. According to our correspondent in Khan Al Shieh camp, Mr. Hasan was released after having a stroke as a result of severe torture, as he was transferred to the hospital where he died a few hours later, pointing out that he was captured by Koukab checkpoint of the regular army on 27th of June, which handed him to the Political Security branch in Qatna.

Note that Hemma Youth Group is a group of youth began in 2012 in Khan Al Shieh camp, and its activities characterized by development and psychological relief, where it carried out many recreational activities and summer clubs in order to psychologically support children of the camp and shelters.

Hemma also implemented a number of seminars and workshops in order to rehabilitate its staff and raise scientific and cultural level to face all challenges and difficulties experienced by the camp.

Arrest

Syrian security forces arrested a number of Palestinian refugees; they are:

The Palestinian refugee "Maher Darwish" Abu Ahmed, in his thirties, originally from Safad city in Palestine, and from Al Aedein camp, was arrested for refusing to Join the Syrian army and security forces on the battlefield against the armed opposition groups, note that he is a member of pro-Syrian security groups.

The Palestinian young man, "Hamid Attallah Khattab," in his fifties, originally from Ain Alzaytoun village in Palestine, was arrested on 06/18/2015 at the Immigration and Passports Department in Homs, as he was trying to obtain a passport, noting that he was working in "HRC" for more than twenty-five years. It was mentioned that applied for routine retirement mobilization, while his application was conversed to security demobilization and was denied compensation and retirement throughout the service period.

The two brothers, "Mustafa Asaad," and "Ahmed Asaad," from Khan Al Shieh camp, were arrested by Syrian security forces on Al Qatifa checkpoint in Damascus suburb on Monday.

The Palestinian refugee woman "Ayat Radwan," 22 years and was arrested by Syrian security forces after a raid on her home in Jadedat Artouz in Damascus suburb.

The AGPS documented 400 Palestinian victims who died due to torture in Syrian jails, while the total number of Palestinian detainees since the



start of war events has reached 909 detainees, including 45 Palestinian refugees still unaccounted for.

The GPS had demanded Syrian authorities to reveal the fate of Palestinian prisoners and to release them, believing that what is happening in Syrian prisons is "a crime by all standards".

Recent Updates

Heavy shelling with explosive barrels targeted the vicinity of Khan Al Shieh camp, while our correspondent confirmed that the helicopters threw a number of explosive barrels at dawn today; one of them targeted the Western farms, which led to a number of casualties among civilians, as well as considerable damage in the Place of crash.

Over the past few days, Khan Al Shieh camp has witnessed the most violent wave of bombing with explosive barrels, where warplanes bombed more than twenty explosive barrels which led to the death of a woman and a fetus after being injured by shrapnel, in addition to a large number of wounded among civilians.

In southern suburb of Damascus, members of the negotiating delegation, Mohammad Alian and Adnan Ibrahim Abu Khaled entered the Yarmouk camp yesterday for talks and return to the negotiating table with the armed groups after they stopped following the storming of ISIS into the camp and that in new effort to neutralize the camp from shelling and clashes.



This comes with the continuation siege of the regular army and PFGC groups for 733 days respectively, power cut for more than (803) days, water cut for 293 days respectively, and prevents the entry of food and medical aid to the camp.

To the north of Syria, where civil defense crews in Nairab camp in Aleppo extinguished a fire that broke out inside a house of "Abu Firas al-Hawari," as a result of a short circuit on Monday.

Our correspondent from inside the camp said that residents and staff of emergency were able to control the fire that was burning inside the house, and added that residents' team managed to save three children. Meanwhile, the refugee woman Um Firas was slightly injured while trying to save her grandchildren and was evacuated to the hospital for treatment.

Italy

Italian Coastguard said it rescued nearly 4,400 migrants off the Libyan coast during the past two days, bringing the number of immigrants who arrived to its territories during the first half of 2015 to about 69,000.

The Coast Guard said in a statement issued yesterday, that they saved 21 boats last Sunday, while eight boats that were carrying 1500 migrants were rescued on Monday; the statement noted that the Italian ships and British, Irish, Swedish, and Spanish barges participated in the rescue operation.

The statement said that the number of refugees who have arrived in Italy in 2015 exceeds the number of immigrants who were counted by the Italian authorities during the first six months of 2014.

In a related context, the number of immigrants who arrived to Greece since the beginning of this year has reached nearly 80,000 migrants, a large proportion of them reached by sea.



Civil Work Committees

World Relief Organization in collaboration with the Charity Commission presented yesterday quantity of chicken meat to the people of the Yarmouk refugee camp in the town of Yalda within "Ramadan Al Kehir 7" campaign, which is the second part that entered by Relief Organization in collaboration with the charity during the month of Ramadan, where it also entered 1000 chickens before days.

Trapped and displaced residents of the camp at neighboring towns of Beit Sahem, Yalda, and Babila are suffering of difficult living conditions with lack of financial resources and the spread of unemployment, making the majority of them depend on assistance.

Numbers and Statistics till 30/6/2015

- *80,000 Palestinian refugees escaped from Syria, including 10,687 refugees in Jordan, 51300 refugees in Lebanon, and 6,000 refugees in Egypt, according to the UNRWA's statistics till February 2015.*



- *At least 36,000 Palestinian Syrian refugees have reached Europe during the last 4 years.*
- *The number of Palestinian detainees who were documented by the AGPS has reached 901 detainees, and 398 victims were killed due to torture in the Syrian prisons.*
- *The Yarmouk Camp: - Siege, imposed by the Regular Army and PFGC, continued for 733 days respectively. In addition, power cuts continued for more than 803 days, water was cut for 293 days respectively. The number of victims due to the siege has reached to 176 victims.*
- *Al Husayneyya Camp: - Regular Army is still preventing the residents of the camp to return back to their houses for 614 days respectively.*
- *Al Sbeina Camp: - Regular Army is still preventing the residents of the camp to return back to their houses for 595 days respectively.*
- *Handarat Camp: - Residents have left the camp for 797 days after the Syrian Opposition Groups controlled it.*
- *Dara'a Camp: - It is now almost 440 days without water and 70% of its buildings were demolished.*
- *Jermana, AL Saieda ZAinab, Al Raml, Al Aedein Camps in Homs and Hamma: - A relatively quiet situation in light of the economic crises.*
- *Khan Al Sheih Camp: - Roads linking the camp to the city center are still closed except for Zakia- Khan Al Sheih road.*
