### *"The Lebanese General Security Releases 40 Palestinians of Syria after Detaining them While Trying to Reach Europe"*

### ***Recent Updates***

*Palestinian Media sources insured that the Lebanese authorities released 40 Palestinian Syrian refugees, who were detained by the Lebanese security forces the day before while trying to reach Europe through Tripoli port north of Lebanon. It is referred that the Palestinians of Syria in Lebanon suffer from bad legal and living situation that prompt them to find ways to escape after they escaped from the ongoing war in Syria, where the number of the Palestinian Syrian refugees in Lebanon is 45000 refugees, however, the Palestinians of Syria continues to migrate to Turkey to ride the death boats in order to reach the European countries.*



*In Syria, activists in the Yarmouk camp insured that Al Nusra Front, which controls the Yarmouk with ISIS south of Syrian capital, dismisses most of the leaders who are close to ISIS and facilitated ISIS entrance to Yarmouk in the beginning of April 2015. According to the activists, the leaders who were appointed are known as they are hostile to ISIS amid news about the intention of Al Nusra dismissed leaders to form a new military faction inside the camp.*



*Al Tadamoun neighborhood adjacent to Yarmouk camp was targeted with a number of shells and heavy gun bullets; in addition some Regime's websites insured the targeting of a number of south Damascus neighborhoods. The living and humanitarian situation inside the Yarmouk camp is still deteriorating, where the strict siege continues for 821 days respectively by the Regular Army and the PFGC which led to the death of 182 refugees due to the malnourishment and lack of medical care, moreover, the bad situation was increased after the control of ISIS over the camp since the beginning of April 2015.*

*In Damascus Suburb, parts of Khan Al Sheih camp for Palestinian refugees were exposed to violent bombing with explosive barrels which led to a panic state amongst the residents. In addition, the adjacent towns were exposed yesterday to separate clashes with middle and heavy guns. On the other hand, the Regular Army and the affiliated Palestinian factions still prevent the residents to return back to their houses for 683 days after they were forced to leave due to the violent clashes between the Army and the Opposition ended with the complete control of the Regular Army over the camp.*





*Estimates indicate that 80% of the camp's houses are semi totally destroyed specially the area from Moath Ben Jabal mosque to the camp's oven "Al Akrad Oven" which forms the western entrance of the camp. The residents resorted to the adjacent camps and towns in a new displacement suffering that didn't stop to leave their houses but continued to all life aspects where the whole life transformed to tragedy due to the economic situation, the widespread of unemployment and the weak financial recourses.*



### **Turkey**

*Yesterday, the Turkish authorities declared for the first of its kind restrictions on movement of refugees from Syria in its states whether by land or by air without getting an official permission from the Turkish authorities.*

*According to media sources that the Syrians in Turkey should go to the Migration Department in the states they live in before travelling by land or by air to Turkish cities to get a permission due to the new decision, moreover, it is noted that the authorities will refuse any travelling cases without getting the permission.*



*According to media resources, a member of the National Syrian Coalition Public Relations confirmed that the Turkish Government informed the coalition of the new decision officially and he added that the new decision is temporary during the election period and it is to control the security situation in the country.*



### ***Numbers and Statistics till 01/10/2015***

- *15,500 Palestinian Syrian refugees in Jordan, 45,000 Palestinian Syrian refugees in Lebanon, and 6,000 refugees in Egypt, according to the UNRWA's statistics till July 2015.*
- *At least 36,000 Palestinian Syrian refugees have reached Europe during the last 4 years.*
- *The Yarmouk Camp: - Siege, imposed by the Regular Army and PFGC, continued for 821 days respectively. In addition, power cuts continued for more than 891 days, water was cut for 381 days respectively. The number of victims due to the siege has reached to 182 victims.*
- *Al Sbeina Camp: - Regular Army is still preventing the residents of the camp to return back to their houses for 683 days respectively.*

- *Handarat Camp: - Residents have left the camp for 884 days after the Syrian Opposition Groups controlled it.*
- *Dara'a Camp: - It is now almost 528 days without water and 70% of its buildings were demolished.*
- *Jarmana, AL Saieda Zainab, Al Raml, Al Aedein Camps in Homs and Hamma: - A relatively quiet situation in light of the economic crises.*
- *Khan Al Sheih Camp: - Roads linking the camp to the city center are still closed except for Zakia- Khan Al Shieh road.*
