"7 PLA Members Died in Damascus Suburb, which Raises the Number of its Members to 173 Refugees"

Recent Updates

Seven PLA members died during violent clashes in Damacus Suburb. Social Media pages, which are closed to PLA, published that Alaa Ali Al Haj, the First Lieutenant, Mohanned Humeed Abdullah, Honor Lieutenant, Mustafa Mohammed Hawwari, Honor Lieutenant, from Handarat Camp, Mohammed Naser falah, Deyaa Mohammed Ahmed, Mohammed fathi Bru, and Ahmed Zuher Shaban died during the clashes, which broke out in Tal Sowan in Adra City between the Syrian Army alongside the affiliated groups and the Opposition. A number of PLA recruits from Khan Danoun Camp were injured during clashes.



Major General Tariq Al Khadra', the PLA Chief of Staff, insured that PLA is fighting alongside the Syrian Army since the beginning of the ongoing war in Syria in more than 15 locations in Daraa Suburbs, Al Sowayda, Damascus, Al Zabadani, Adra, Al Maliha, Jober, Al Madameyya, and Tal Kurdi. It is noted that the Palestinian refugees in Syria are obliged to join the military service in PLA, and everyone who



doesn't join , will be subjected to chase and jail. Many members left the army and joined the Opposition to fight the Syrian Regime.

It is worthy to mention that the death toll in the Palestinian Liberation Army reached 173, excluding the members who left to fight against and died in clashes with the regime or due to torture in the Syrian prisons, according to AGPS.

The reported news from Daraa Camp for Palestinian refugees insured that the Syrian Regime forces targetd the camp yesterday with a surface – to-surface Fil rocket, which led to the death of the wife of Hani Al Khayat and his Daughter Malak and they are from the Occupied Golan. The bombing also led to wounded amongst the Palestinian refugees including children, which caused a panic state amongst the residents due to the security tension in the camp. The camp witnessed yesterday the outbreak of violent clashes coincided with targeting the camp with sporadic shelling.



The bombing coincided with targeting the Regime forces centered in Daraa Al Mahata with anti-aircrafts and heavy weapons in Daraa town



neighborhoods and Al Sad road. It is noted that many families, who left Daraa camp, live in Daraa town neighborhoods. The refugees in southern Syria live miserable living and security situations, where the remaining refugees inside Daraa suffer of serious health and living situation. They also suffer of the water cut in addition to the frequent violent clashes in the camp that led to many victims and the destruction of 70% of its buildings, according to unofficial statistics.

The Palestinian refugees in southern Syria, Muzeireeb, Glenn, Tel Shehab, and other areas of Daraa governorate live in difficult and miserable health situation, four years of war were enough to collapse the medical system of hospitals, medical centers and cadres. The suffering increased because of the weak administration of the Opposition in the southern areas that the opposition controls and the not putting mechanisms for serving the residents on all levels. There is no any hospital or medical center in Daraa camp in addition to the lack of medical materials and equipment needed for first aid and the unavailability of ambulances to get the wounded out of the camp for treatment. Some activists warned from the spread of diseases among the residents specially that they are forced to drink from the contaminated water due to the water cut since about 876 days.

Field activists mentioned that the health-deteriorated situation in Syria is because of some reasons, most important that the Syrian Army prevents the entry of any type of medicines and medical equipment, in addition to bombing hospitals and this led to change the field hospitals into first aid centers due to the lack of support. Activists added that the doctors' immigration led to close many medical centers because they are empty of



staff in addition to the continuous clashes between ISIS and Opposition military groups that led to stop the movement of the families and the health staff. The Jordanian authorities also prevented the Palestinian refugees to enter its territories for treatment, which oblige some of them to fake names of Syrian residents. It is referred that AGS documented about 347 Palestinian refugees' victims in Daraa governorate, who died since the beginning of the ongoing war in Syria, including 241 victims from Daraa camp.

In Damascus Western Suburb, the warplanes launched yesterday airstrikes on the outskirts of Khan Al Sheih camp for Palestinian refugees using cluster bombs, which its ruminants were spread widely. The Regular Army continues to cut all roads that connect the camp with the Damascus center that resulted in increasing the living and health crises inside the camp. It is mentioned that the camp witnessed recently an escalation in airstrikes, which Russian warplanes participated in some of the airstrikes, where it resulted in dozens of victims and wounded from the camps' residents.





Palestinians of Syria Numbers and Statistics until 2\09\2016

- *15500 Palestinian Syrian refugees are in Jordan*
- *42.500 Palestinian Syrian refugees are in Lebanon*
- *6000 Palestinian Syrian refugees are in Egypt, according to the UNRWA statistics till July 2015*
- *8000 Palestinian Syrian refugees are in Turkey*
- *1000 Palestinian Syrian refugees are in Gaza*
- *More than 79,000 Palestinian Syrian refugees have reached Europe till mid -2016*
- *The Yarmouk Camp: siege, imposed by the Regular Army and PFGC groups, continued for 1172 consecutive days. Power cut continued for more than 1233 days, water was cut for 722 days respectively. The number of siege victims is 187.*
- *Al Sbeina Camp: - Regular Army is still preventing the residents of the camp to return back to their houses for 1023 days respectively.*
- *Handarat Camp: - All Residents have left the camp for about 1217 days after the Syrian Opposition Groups controlled it.*
- *Dara'a Camp: - It is now almost 876 days without water and almost 70% of its buildings were demolished.*
- *Jermana, AL Saieda ZAinab, Al Raml, Al Aedein Camps in Homs and Hamma: - A relatively quiet situation in light of the economic crises.*
- *Khan Al Sheih Camp: - Roads linking the camp to the city center are still closed except for Zakia- Khan Al Sheih road.*
