"ISIS Executes and Cuts the Heads of Some Residents of Yarmouk, Including a Palestinian Refugee"

Recent Updates

A number of social media pages affiliated to ISIS shared a recorded video issued by the so-called 'Damascus State' entitled as 'Picking Spies'. The video contains a number of people were executed in different charges by ISIS, where the refugee Naem Younis Bahnasawi,' was born on 1972, from Sbeina camp, was executed in charges of affiliating to Aknaf Brigades, according to the Video.



At the end of the recorded video, ISIS members slaughtered and cut the heads of two defendants, while others were executed by shooting in the heads, while the AGPS could not assure the recorded video

It is worth mentioning that ISIS had stormed the Yarmouk refugee camp early on last April.

On the other hand, a mortar shell landed on a house in Khan Al Shieh camp at dawn on Thursday, where the shell was dropped in front of the police station, causing a state of fear among people, especially children.



The damage was confined to materialism, and coincided with violent clashes broke out at Al Salam highway amid artillery shelling that targeted the eastern vicinity of the camp, coincided with illumination rounds by the regular army in the vicinity of the camp.

Moreover, all roads connecting Khan Al Shieh camp with neighboring regions are still closed except (Zakya – Khan Al Shieh), amid suffering experienced by residents as a result of targeting the only port which feeds the camp.

In the same context, activists in Khan Al Shieh camp confirmed to the AGPS that about 40% of homes and buildings have been damaged due to the repeated bombing that targeted the camp.

Activists added that damage ranged from full destruction, where some affected houses have become totally uninhabitable and need to be demolished and rebuilt again, and partially damaged, where some homes need immediate maintenance in order to be inhabitable.



It is worth mentioning that the camp witnessed a remarkable rise of military operations that targeted the camp in recent weeks with explosive barrels and artillery shells, which are the most dangerous and the most commonly used.

On the other hand, the AGPS monitoring and documentation team confirmed that it documented (917) Palestinian detainees from all camps and areas of Syria, where the number of Palestinian prisoners from Damascus and its suburb were the highest percentage, while the number of detainees has reached 354 detainees, in the province of Homs (182) detainees, while in the province of Aleppo (114) detainees, in Latakia (79) detainees, in Hama(51) detainees, in Daraa province(44)detainees, and (93) detainees are unknown housing.

The Syrian regime and its security services are still reticent about the fate of Palestinian detainees or places of detention, at a time the Action Group documented 404 victims of Palestinian refugees who died due to torture in the Syrian prisons, while 78 victims were identified through the leaked images of victims of torture, including youth, women, and elderly people.

The Italian authorities issued an 18-year-sentenced against a Tunisian who was involved in the accident of a ship sinking that was carrying migrants on 2013, which caused the death of at least 366 migrants, including Syrians and Palestinians.

On 11th of October 2013, a ship was carrying Palestinian and Syrian immigrants sank, and it was the largest tragedy among sinking disasters in the Mediterranean Sea.



The boat sank after hours of being shot by an unknown group in Libyan waters, which caused failure in the Engines in front of the Italian and Maltese coast, the thing that resulted in the sinking of the boat, while most immigrants died.

Civil Work Committees

Global Relief Organization and Al Marhama campaign in cooperation with the Charity Organization provided (1000) breakfast meals to the families of orphans, people with special needs, and poor families at the charity center in Qudseia area at Damascus Suburb.

'We Were and We Will' institution in collaboration with the Charity Organization also provided 260 breakfast meals for families in Al Zahira area in Damascus within the initiative of 'Kesret Khubz',

In Al Aedein camp in Homs, Shabab Al Khair Association in cooperation with the Charity Commission introduced breakfasts for 150 families of orphans and displaced people, as well as food aid in Hama camp, which included the poorest and most needed families.



Meanwhile, Palestinians of Syria committee in Lebanon in collaboration with Al Taqwa Committee for Charity distributed food parcels to displaced Palestinian Syrian families at Nahr al-Bared camp in Tripoli, northern Lebanon.

Furthermore, Palestinians of Syria committee in Turkey distributed financial and food aid to Palestinian families in the coastal city of Izmir, and briefed on their situation, while the number of families, according to the Committee statistics, was estimated with nearly 40 families.

In addition, it also distributed a number of food rations provided by Al Wafaa European Campaign and Palestine Scholars Abroad Commission to Palestinian families in the city of Diyarbakir, southern Turkey, while the Commission has provided financial assistance to almost 160 Palestinian families in the city of Kilis.

The Commission visited nearly 21 Palestinian families in the city of Izmit; briefed on their difficult living conditions, and provided them with food rations.



The Committee also took notes of the Palestinian families' conditions in the cities of Bursa and Alawa, and also distributed food rations to nearly 20 families

Numbers and Statistics till 2/7/2015

- *80,000 Palestinian refugees escaped from Syria, including 10,687 refugees in Jordan, 51300 refugees in Lebanon, and 6,000 refugees in Egypt, according to the UNRWA's statistics till February 2015.*
- *At least 36,000 Palestinian Syrian refugees have reached Europe during the last 4 years.*
- *The number of Palestinian detainees who were documented by the AGPS has reached 901 detainees, and 398 victims were killed due to torture in the Syrian prisons.*
- *The Yarmouk Camp: - Siege, imposed by the Regular Army and PFGC, continued for 735 days respectively. In addition, power cuts continued for more than 805 days, water was cut for 295 days respectively. The number of victims due to the siege has reached to 176 victims.*
- *Al Husayneyya Camp: - Regular Army is still preventing the residents of the camp to return back to their houses for 616 days respectively.*
- *Al Sbeina Camp: - Regular Army is still preventing the residents of the camp to return back to their houses for 597 days respectively.*
- *Handarat Camp: - Residents have left the camp for 799 days after the Syrian Opposition Groups controlled it.*

- *Dara'a Camp: - It is now almost 442 days without water and 70% of its buildings were demolished.*
- *Jermana, AL Saieda ZAINAB, Al Raml, Al Aedein Camps in Homs and Hamma: - A relatively quiet situation in light of the economic crises.*
- *Khan Al Sheih Camp: - Roads linking the camp to the city center are still closed except for Zakia- Khan Al Sheih road.*
