Recent Updates

Social media pages shared recently many videos in which foods, vegetables, and sweets spread inside the Yarmouk camp markets, such recordings adopted by ISIS, its supporters, and some journalists who were subjected to blackmail and threats, in order to improve the image of ISIS in front of the media by claiming that the organization is entering food supplies and distributes it to the trapped people.

About these recordings, our correspondent research on the subject and question some residents and activists in the camp for what it really is.

A resident, who asked not to be identified for fear of "Daash," said that:

"All material that became available in the markets of the camp come from the nearby town of Yalda, and many members of Daash or affiliates sell them to people at very expensive prices compared with the living situation of trapped people inside the camp."





An activist inside the camp adds, " the Syrian authorities has significantly facilitated the arrival of food aid to the towns of Aldao and Babbila since the storming of ISIS after it blocked it over the past months, therefore food were available where many merchants and some people affiliated to Daash sold to residents at least four times the price!! ".

On the other hand, one of the people added to our correspondent, "The desserts video recording is just for Media and for improving the image of Daash. How could the people who cannot afford buying a kilo of sugar would be able to buy desserts?? !!".

For his part, our correspondent pointed out that the state of fear and anxiety faced by the people of Yarmouk, especially activists who are threatened by ISIS with death if transferred any information exposing the role of ISIS and some affiliated people inside the camp, where he confirmed that all those interviewed asked for anonymity out of fear for their lives.

It is worth mentioning that the so-called press office of the mandate of Damascus which is affiliated to Daash had published yesterday a video entitled "picking spies" in which the members Daash executing a number of residents either slaughter or shooting.

Turning to Lebanon, where "Moussa Abu Marzouk," Deputy Head of the Political Bureau of Hamas, declared the end of residency problem facing the Palestinian Syrian refugees in Lebanon.



He stressed that "refugees from Syria can go to residency centers, and that decision was made in this regard."



It is worth mentioning that Abu Marzouk Declaration came after his visit to Major General Abbas Ibrahim, Director-General of the Lebanese General Security.

Civil Work Committees

The Pharmacy of Palestine Charity Commission, which was established in one of the neighboring countries of Yarmouk camp, distributed free medicine on the patients of Yarmouk camp at Yelda town in order to alleviate the consequences of siege and displacement that they were exposed to.

In a different context, the services department of Jafra Association distributed drinking water to the residents of Khan Al Shieh camp at Damascus suburb in order to alleviate the suffering of the besieged people who live in a worry and fear state due to the continuation of targeting their camp with explosive barrels, rockets, and mortar shells.



In terms of living aspect, Khan AL Shieh residents complain of sever living crises due to closing Zakia- Khan Al Shieh road which negatively impacted the residents and led to lose many food items in the camp.



The Merciful Hand Charity - Germany carried out Iftar campaign to the Palestinians at Der'aa city south of Syria, the implementing members declared that the number of beneficiaries from the campaign during Ramadan 2015 is 30000 Palestinians, and they mentioned that the campaign will last till the end of Ramadan.



The QRC and Irshed Organization in cooperation with Palestinians of Syria Committee in Lebanon distributed 200 food parcels on the displaced Palestinians of Syria families at Al Baqa' Al Gharbi



northern Lebanon within a charity campaign titled Iftar Saem which targets the Palestinians of Syria and the Palestinians of Lebanon families who are in Lebanon.

In Turkey, the Palestinians of Syria Committee in Turkey distributed a number of food parcels, which are presented from Al Wafa European campaign and the Palestine Scholars Commission abroad, on the Palestinians families at Gaziantep Turkish city. Previously, the committee distributed food parcels of the Palestinians of Syria at Deyar Baker south of Turkey and distributed financial aid to about 160 Palestinian families at Kilis city , moreover, the committee witnessed the situation of about 41 Palestinian families in Izmit,Bursa and Yalova and witnessed their living situation and presented food parcels.



Numbers and Statistics till 3/7/2015:-

- 80,000 Palestinian refugees escaped from Syria, including 10,687 refugees in Jordan, 51300 refugees in Lebanon, and

6,000 refugees in Egypt, according to the UNRWA's statistics till February 2015.

- At least 36,000 Palestinian Syrian refugees have reached Europe during the last 4 years.
- The Yarmouk Camp: - Siege, imposed by the Regular Army and PFGC, continued for 736 days respectively. In addition, power cuts continued for more than 806 days, water was cut for 296 days respectively. The number of victims due to the siege has reached to 176 victims.
- Al Husayneyya Camp: - Regular Army is still preventing the residents of the camp to return back to their houses for 617 days respectively.
- Al Sbeina Camp: - Regular Army is still preventing the residents of the camp to return back to their houses for 598 days respectively.
- Handarat Camp: - Residents have left the camp for 800 days after the Syrian Opposition Groups controlled it.
- Dara'a Camp: - It is now almost 443 days without water and 70% of its buildings were demolished.
- Jermana, AL Saieda ZAinab, Al Raml, Al Aedein Camps in Homs and Hamma: - A relatively quiet situation in light of the economic crises.
- Khan Al Sheih Camp: - Roads linking the camp to the city center are still closed except for Zakia- Khan Al Sheih road.
