



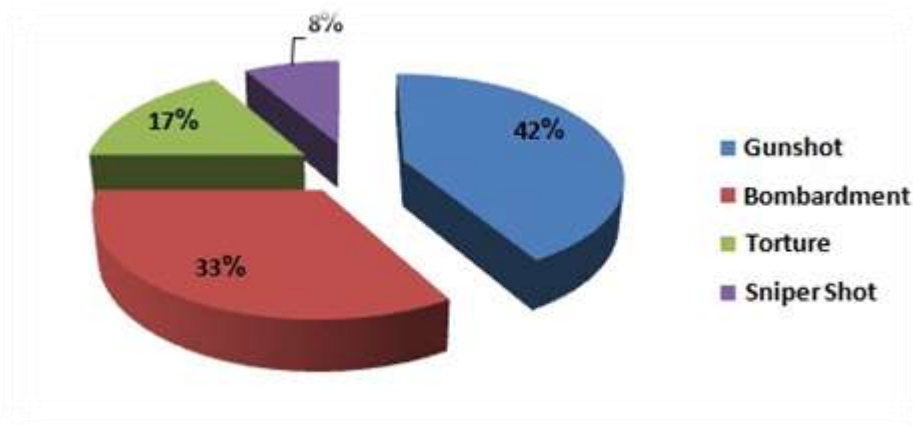

"Twelve Palestinians Died in Syria during August, 2016"



- The PLA Members Death Toll Reached 10 within 24 hours in Syria
- A Palestinian Refugee was killed by the Opposition Groups in Damascus Suburb
- One of Yarmouk Residents Died by a Regular Army Sniper in Yelda
- Three Children were Seriously Injured after bombing Khan Al Shaieh camp with Warplanes
- The Turkish Embassy in Lebanon Continues to Stop Granting the Visa to the Palestinians of Syria Refugees

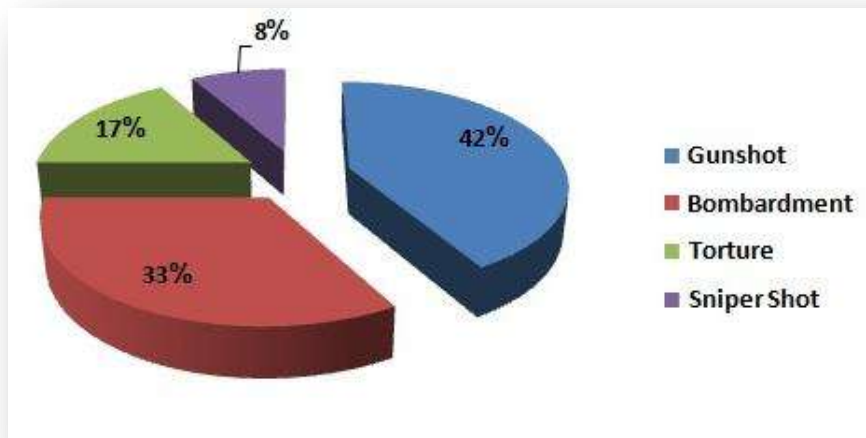

Statistics

The AGPS monitoring and documentation team announced that 12 Palestinian refugees died during August 2016, including 5 refugees due to a bullet and 4 other due to bombing and 2 refugees died due to torture in the Syrian prisons, and a refugee died by a sniper.

AGPS referred that the Palestinian victims, who died during August 2016, were distributed due to the place of death as: in Khan Al Sheih 3 Refugees, in Daraa 4 refugees, in Eastern Ghuta two refugees, in Handarat Camp one refugee and two refugees died in separate areas. It is mentioned that the number of refugees who died due to the ongoing war in Syria reached 3322 refugees, according to AGPS documentation.



Recent Updates

The PLA members' death toll reached 10 victims within 24 hours, where it announced, through social media pages, the names of the victims. They are Mohammed Majed Hurani, Qassim nabeel Desuqi died in Tal Sowan



battles in Daraa city in Damascus Suburb, Rafat Mohammed Hameed Al Shalamuni died in Ebte' city battles in Daraa Suburb between Regular Army and Opposition. The PLA announced the day before the death of seven Palestinian refugees from its members during violent clashes in Damascus Suburb. The Palestinian refugee Alaa Ayman Gharizi was killed by the so-called Thowar Al Tal Group, one of the Oppositions groups, in Al Tal area in Damascus Suburb, social media pages mentioned that the group beheaded him and sent his head to the house of his mother in Eastern Harna area in Al Tal in Damascus Suburb.



In southern Damascus, Mohammed Khalid Faraj, 1969, from Yarmok camp died due to a sniper's bullet by the regular Army, he got the bullet while leaving Al Saberin mosque in Yelda after performing Al Fajr prayer, which raises the number of the Palestinian refugees who died in Syria since the beginning of the war to 298 refugees, according to AGPS.

In Damascus Western Suburb, the Syrian and Russian warplanes launched airstrikes the day before and targeted one of Khan Al Sheih camp's lanes, which led to the injury of three children and one of them



has a serious injury. The bombing also resulted in a huge destruction to the civilian houses and a fire broke out in some houses.

All these events come in light of huge escalation during the last weeks in the pace and size of the airstrikes that targeted Khan Al Sheih Camp in Damascus Suburb. The bombing resulted in dozens of victims and wounded from the residents of the camp and the displaced families, who escaped the bombing and explosive barrels that targeted the surrounding villages and towns.



In a different context, the Turkish Embassy in Lebanon stopped issuing visas for Palestinians of Syria refugees in Lebanon and Syria, without showing the reasons. The stop issuing the visas forced hundreds of the Palestinians of Syria refugees to go through dangerous land roads to reach the Turkish territories, where they enter Turkey Illegally.

- *6000 Palestinian Syrian refugees are in Egypt, according to the UNRWA statistics till July 2015*
- *8000 Palestinian Syrian refugees are in Turkey*
- *1000 Palestinian Syrian refugees are in Gaza*
- *More than 79,000 Palestinian Syrian refugees have reached Europe till mid -2016*
- *The Yarmouk Camp: siege, imposed by the Regular Army and PFGC groups, continued for 1173 consecutive days. Power cut continued for more than 1234 days, water was cut for 723 days respectively. The number of siege victims is 187.*
- *Al Sbeina Camp: - Regular Army is still preventing the residents of the camp to return back to their houses for 1024 days respectively.*
- *Handarat Camp: - All Residents have left the camp for about 1218 days after the Syrian Opposition Groups controlled it.*
- *Dara'a Camp: - It is now almost 877 days without water and almost 70% of its buildings were demolished.*
- *Jermana, AL Saieda ZAINAB, Al Raml, Al Aedein Camps in Homs and Hamma: - A relatively quiet situation in light of the economic crises.*
- *Khan Al Sheih Camp: - Roads linking the camp to the city center are still closed except for Zakia- Khan Al Sheih road.*
