"Cluster bombs Target Khan Al-Sheih Camp leaving One Victim and Number of Injuries"



- Mortars target Daraa camp in the south of Syria.
- Al Yarmouk is in a holding pattern after inner fights among ISIS members.
- Syrian security keeps arresting a whole Palestinian family for three years.
- For the fifth year, ongoing water crisis in Danun Camp.

Recent Updates

Yesterday, " Mohammed Abu Setah" and " Abduallah Saleh Eisa" were killed and others were injured because the Russian aircrafts were shelling Khan Al-Sheih with cluster bombs which are internationally prohibited.

AGPS reporter confirmed that the raids at Sunday night shelled parts of the river and farms around Khan Al-Sheih, which killed two Palestinians and injured more than three civilians. He also highlighted that aircrafts used internationally prohibited weapons like cluster bombs in its raids on the camp.

Khan Al-Sheih, which receives hundreds of displaced families from different areas, has been shelled on 29 September 2016 with different



kinds of weapons. As a result, number of victims and casualties were reported and widespread destruction in the houses. Different places were being targeted, the pro-UNRWA school "Beersheba" was one of those places. It was targeted by two mortars and led to some casualties among students and staff. Moreover, the Russian and Syrian aircrafts shelled the civilians' houses around Al Huda mosque with one missile causing casualties, massive destruction and a state of panic among civilians. While on 2 October 2016 the Syrian regime bombed an ambulance within its injured passengers which killed the Palestinian medic "Mohammed Ali".



Reportedly, Daraa Camp has been shelled with mortars and heavy machine guns by the Syrian regime in different places of the camp. Luckily, no injuries were reported but there were some material damages.

It's worth noting that Syrian regime forces targeted the camp the day before yesterday with mortars which led to the death of the Palestinian child "Nasem Qwaider" and some serious injuries.



In the same time, trapped people in Yarmouk were in a state of fear especially after ISIS members were in a state of alert; because " Abu Ja'far" the brother of the ex-prince of ISIS "Abu Sayyah Farramah" was shot during clashes between him and "Bayomi". This will definitely lead to inner fights among ISIS members and a new immigration to the people of the camp.

Tadamon neighborhood and Yarmouk camp are witnessing a state of tension among "Abu Sayyah Farramah" affiliates; they violated the rules of "Abu Hisham Al Khabouri" their new prince, by closing Al Rijah barrier and targeting its square, which is under the control of Jabhat-Fateh Al Sham" with two mortars. It's good to mention that " Abu Hisham Al Khabouri " has opened Al Rijah barrier partially after a long time of siege.



In Rijah Square, there were fierce clashes between Jabhat- Fateh Al Sham" members Vs Syrian regime forces allied with Palestinian groups. Noting that Syrian regime forces and ISIS were closing the whole area.

All that comes amid the siege of regime forces and PFGC to the camp, which continued to (1203) consecutive days. Obviously, Siege has its



consequences like, continued power cut for more than (1264) days, water was cut for (754) days respectively and (187) victims because of siege, hunger and lack of medical care.

In Khan Danun Camp, people are suffering from water crisis for five consecutive years'. They are complaining about its cuts all the week except one day, so they have to buy water every two days, which costs them 14,000LS per month. They also blaming the responsible authorities for their carelessness.

In a previous time, drinking water has been cut off in the same camp after a serious pollution in water network because of the admixture of drinking water with sewage.

It comes amid difficult living conditions, lack of financial resources, unemployment and war, which citizens of the camp suffer from.

- *Yarmouk Camp: siege, imposed by the Regime's Army and PFGC groups, continued for (1203) consecutive days. Power cut continued for more than (1264) days. water was cut for (754) days respectively. The number of siege victims is (187).*
- *Sabina Camp: Regime's Army is still forbidding the residents of the camp to return back to their houses for (1056) days respectively.*
- *Handarat Camp: - All Residents have left the camp for about (1248) days after the Syrian Opposition Groups controlled it.*
- *Daraa Camp: - It is now almost (906) days without water and almost 70% of its buildings were totally destroyed.*
- *Jarmana, AL Sayeda -Zeinab, Al Raml, Al Aedein Camps in Homs and Hama: A relatively quiet situation in light of the economic crises.*
- *Khan Al Sheih Camp: Roads linking the camp to the city center are still closed except for Zakia- Khan Al Sheih road.*
