Recent Updates

Syrian security forces continue arresting a group of Palestinian medical staff and keep their fate unknown, while a number of them died due to torture in its prisons under the pretext of providing medical and humanitarian help for the residents of the camp and the wounded from neighboring regions.



AGPS documented a number of detainees doctors; their fate is still unknown; they are:

- Palestinian Syrian refugee doctor, "Ala'a Qassem Hamid", 67- year-old, a doctor in general surgery and a professor at the Faculty of Human Medicine at the University of Damascus. He served as a Head for the general surgery department at Al-Assad University Hospital and was arrested by the Syrian regime forces after they raided his clinic in the Yarmouk camp on 13 August 2012 on charges of treating the wounded.*
- Palestinian Syrian refugee doctor "Ala'a Al- Deen Yousif" 62- year- old, a doctor in neurological surgery in the Yarmouk camp. He was arrested from the first checkpoint in the Yarmouk camp on 25 December 2012.*
- Palestinian Syrian refugee doctor, "Malik Mohammad Yousif," a graduate of Dentistry, Master in Surgery "fourth year," was arrested by the Syrian regime forces from Damascus University - Faculty of Dentistry on 23 May 2013.*



It is mentioned that the medical staff and institutions in the Yarmouk camp suffered of serious abuses by the Syrian army and security when hospitals and ambulances were targeted sometimes and the medical staff were kidnapped and killed at other times causing the death of dozens of paramedics, nurses, specialists, and pharmacists.

Till now, the Syrian security forces hide the fate of the Palestinian detainees and their numbers in its prisons, while AGPS documented 990 detainee; 421 detainees of them died due to torture in the Syrian prisons.

In the meantime, the World Relief Organization continues in cooperation with the Charity Organization, and for the third day respectively, removing the rubble and dust of the streets of Husseneia camp in Damascus suburb as part of the rehabilitation project of homes and mosques in the camp. The project included the re-restoration of mosques, in addition to installing glass windows for the affected homes in the camp. It is mentioned that the re-restoration and rehabilitation project, which started on 1st November 2015, will continue for 15 days.





In the south of Syria, The Palestinian refugees in Daraa governorate in general and the areas of Palestinian refugees compounds especially in Daraa camp, Al- Muzeireeb, and Gleen compounds are suffering from complete absence of the necessities of life, while water and electricity are still cut by the Syrian regime forces since 561 days.

Residents are trying to solve the problem by incurring the water from distant places and paying money to buy fuel if available to run some electricity generators adding to the flour crisis which is waiting for the permission of the Jordanian authorities to be entered to the opposition control areas, in addition to the high prices of materials and scarcity of financial resources due to the ongoing war which affected on the economic situation.



Moreover, Daraa camp and Muzeireeb compound are still targeted, as the AGPS documented 328 victims in Daraa governorate. Unofficial statistics estimates the number of those remained in Daraa camp up to 500 residents and about 8,500 Palestinian refugees in Muzeireeb



compound, in addition to the displaced people from Daraa camp in Muzeireeb compound and Daraa governorate areas.

The Syrian regime army and the Palestinian groups continue preventing the residents of Sbeina camp in Damascus suburb to return to their homes for 716 days respectively.

Palestinians were forced to leave the camp as a result of violent clashes between the regular army and armed opposition groups which ended with the control of the regular army on the camp completely.

The residents displaced to neighboring towns and camps found them in new suffering added to their tragedy, while eye witnesses confirmed that more than 80% of the camp is destructed almost completely.

Statistics

The AGPS monitoring and documentation team documented the names of seven Palestinian refugees from the Yarmouk camp died in October, including tow refugees were executed by Jaish Al- Islam in the south of Damascus after the death of four of its members in an explosion by ISIS in Yalda area; they are: the Palestinian refugees "Ahmed Abu Ammar," and "Ahmed Hossam Haniyeh," 21-year-old from the Yarmouk camp after the members stormed Dar Al- Qada'a prison and took five young men sentenced to "imprisonment" for four months for belonging to an assassinations network belonging to ISIS.

As well as, the youth refugee "Mo'ath Ayman Al-Badawi" died in the Yarmouk camp after a fire broke out while trying to extract fuel through



the burning of plastic materials, as he was severely burnt and died. He was buried in the camp cemetery.

The Palestinian refugee "Tamer Mohammed" from the Yarmouk camp died due to shelling that targeted the camp on 6 October 2015 by explosive barrels.

The refugee " Said Shuraitah " from the Yarmouk camp was also killed by a sniper shot while he was in Palestine Street, as well as the Palestinian refugee" Ahmed Mohammed Issa Al Rayyan " from the Yarmouk camp, Al- Magarebah Street died after being injured by bombing of Palestine square in which the young man, Ryan, was wounded, in addition to two other young men.

On 27 October 2015, unidentified group assassinated secretary of the Palestinian National Authority and an official of the Democratic Front in the Yarmouk camp "Abu Ahmed Houari" after being shot in Al- Magarebah Street in the besieged camp while the perpetrators escaped without knowing their identity.

Child "Salah Al- Deen Riad Alsauvani," 11 - year- old also died as a result of the blockade and the lack of medical care in the Yarmouk camp. It is mentioned that "26" Palestinian refugees died in last October, according to the AGPS Monitoring and documentation statistics.

Civil Work Committees

Under the title "Concepts of Trade Union Actions," the Training and Rehabilitation Committee of the Palestinian Syrians League in Lebanon



held a training course on 1st October 2015 in the Palestinian Return Centre in the Arab region in Sidon, south Lebanon.



The lecture which was delivered by the trainer Dr. Abu Bakr Mesaieed shed light on the importance of syndicate work, its history and origination as well as the concepts of syndicate work and the general rules in the syndicate work, also he spoke about the motives of Syndicate work and forms of trade union banners as well as the qualities of a successful syndicator.

Palestinian of Syria committee in Lebanon distributed 228 school bags and a number of stationery bags on Palestinian Syrian students in camps and compounds of Tyre city, the distribution included the following:

In Al- Burj Al- Shamali camp, 88 bags were distributed in Palestine and Jabaliya schools on some poor families as well as Rachidia camp where 50 school bags and distributed in Al-Aqsa secondary school, Ain Al- Asal school, and Al- Naqab school in addition to Al- Bass camp where 45 school bags were distributed on Deir Yasseen secondary school and Al-Shajarah school as well as Al- Ma'ashhoq area. After visiting churches



compound, the committee distributed 40 school bags on all Palestinian Syrian students who are studying the Syrian curriculum in order to attend the exams of elementary and secondary school exams in Syria this year.

It is worth mentioning that the number of Palestinian students in Tyre city is about 1,100 students according to UNRWA statistics distributed in the schools of Tyre city, while the total number of Palestinian Syrian refugees in Lebanon is about 45,000 refugees.

Numbers and Statistics till 3/11/2015

- *15,500 Palestinian Syrian refugees in Jordan, 45,000 Palestinian Syrian refugees in Lebanon, and 6,000 refugees in Egypt, according to the UNRWA's statistics till July 2015.*
- *At least 36,000 Palestinian Syrian refugees have reached Europe during the last 4 years.*
- *The Yarmouk Camp: - Siege, imposed by the Regular Army and PFGC, continued for 855 days respectively. In addition, power cuts continued for more than 925 days, water was cut for 415 days respectively. The number of victims due to the siege has reached to 182 victims.*
- *Al Sbeina Camp: - Regular Army is still preventing the residents of the camp to return back to their houses for 716 days respectively.*
- *Handarat Camp: - Residents have left the camp for 917 days after the Syrian Opposition Groups controlled it.*

- *Dara'a Camp: - It is now almost 561 days without water and 70% of its buildings were demolished.*
- *Jarmana, AL Saieda Zainab, Al Raml, Al Aedein Camps in Homs and Hamma: - A relatively quiet situation in light of the economic crises.*
- *Khan Al Sheih Camp: - Roads linking the camp to the city center are still closed except for Zakia- Khan Al Shieh road.*
