"Massive Destruction at Yarmouk by Explosive Barrels"



- 38 Palestinian Refugees Died during Last May 2015, and 39 Died during the Same Month in 2014

Victims

The AGPS monitoring and documentation team confirmed that it documented the death of 38 victims during last May 2015, while 39 refugees died in the same month on 2014 due to the ongoing conflict in Syria.

The AGPS noted that the 38 victims who died in 2015 were distributed to the Syrian cities as following:

13 victims died in Yarmouk, 8 victims died in Khan Al Shieh Camp, while 17 victims died in different areas in Syria.

Meanwhile, the 39 victims who died on April 2014 included 14 victims from Yarmouk, 3 victims in Daraa, 3 victims in Khan Dannon camp, 2 victims in Nairab Camp-Aleppo, and 1 victim in Al Raml Camp-Latakia.

Recent Updates

Syrian warplanes targeted several parts of the Yarmouk camp yesterday with more than 4 explosive barrels. The shelling targeted in Ghazal lanes adjacent to Mashroua Al Waseim area and resulted in only material damages.

Meanwhile, the Syrian regime has stepped up the bombing of Yarmouk refugee camp following the storming of ISIS, although there are about 8,000 civilians trapped inside the camp, which led to casualties among them.

In the meantime, residents of Al Nairab Camp in Aleppo complain of degrading mechanism followed by UNRWA during the distribution of cash assistance to them. According to a statement of a resident, UNRWA is dealing with them with great disregard.

He added that the camp residents are forced to wait in front of the bank for long hours under the sun in order to receive financial aid, and pointed out that the reason for this is due to new resolutions that recently developed by the UNRWA, which requires the presence of all members of



the family for the individual data audit process of the Palestinian refugees residing in Syria, and to make sure of their presence inside.

Another refugee complained from ill-treatment of the banks towards them, according to the refugee, the Bank give priority and preference to the auditors of its customers, while asking the Palestinian refugees to return or wait for another day.

Meanwhile, the Palestinian refugee woman "Israa Murad Al-Salem," 21 years, from Homs, who was recently released from Syrian prisons after three years of detention, managed to communicate with her family after days of searching for them.

Detainees

Syrian security forces arrested the Palestinian refugee "Mohamed Khair Musa," from Khan Al Shieh camp in Damascus suburb, while many residents of Khan Al Shieh camp have been arrested by the Syrian regime checkpoints in Artoz and the only entrance to Khan Al Shieh camp.

"Taha Derbas," at the beginning of his forties, originally from Tirat Haifa village in Palestine, was also arrested on 20th of last May after he assaulted the medical staff of Bisan hospital at Al Aedein camp in Homs.

Release

Syrian security forces released four Palestinian refugees, including three from Al Aedein camp in Homs. They are: "Abid Ghassan Aliwa", in his



thirties, originally from Acre city in Palestine, after being detained for nearly a month and a half, "Tariq Akram Hashem Salaymeh," in his forties, originally from Al Shajara village in Palestine, after being detained for more than two years, and "Yusuf Mohamed Bassiouni" in his forties, originally from Haifa city of in Palestine, after being detained for about thirty days.

The AGPS correspondent in Deraa reported news about the release of the PLA Sergeant "Iyad Ibrahim Al-Naimi," 38 years after being detained for more than three years by the Syrian security services.

New York

"It is rudeness sitting between us and listen to the pain of the people you caused it, I think that the right place for you to sit is not here with countries that respect human rights, the natural place in terrorism court next to Boko Haram and ISIS," with these strongly worded speech, the son of Yarmouk camp, "Faris Shehabi" addressed the representative of State of Zionist occupation, during his speech at the evening session of the Conference of UNRWA support.

The conference was held yesterday in New York City, highlighting the suffering of Palestinian refugees in Syria, in the Yarmouk refugee camp, and other Palestinian forgotten camps, which were subjected by bombing, destruction, siege, and full absence of services. "Shihabi" talked about his experience and the experience of thousands of Palestinian refugees who were forced to ride the boats of death and risk their lives and the lives of their children, because of what they suffer in



Syria of a tragic situation because of the continued conflict there in search of safety, security, and a decent life in European countries.



At the conclusion of his speech, Mr. Shihabi demanded the international community to work on advocacy of Palestinian refugees and their protection and relief, stressing that the plight of the Palestinian people in Syria are not the first of the Palestinian people who have been displaced and expelled from their homeland by the rape of the Zionist occupation, which previously affected all Palestinians in Lebanon, Iraq, and Kuwait.

He also demanded United Nations, international organizations, and human rights organizations to find a justice and comprehensive solution for the Palestinian refugee issue through the application of international resolutions issued by the United Nations including resolution 194 that states the return of Palestinian refugees to their homes.

It is worth mentioning that Mr. "Shihabi" was supposed to deliver his speech during the opening session of the conference in the presence of the Secretary-General of the United Nations, "Ban Ki-moon," and official delegations, but it has been postponed for the evening session, for unknown reasons.



Numbers and Statistics till 3/6/2015

- *80,000 Palestinian refugees escaped from Syria, including 10,687 refugees in Jordan, 51300 refugees in Lebanon, and 6,000 refugees in Egypt, according to the UNRWA's statistics till February 2015.*
- *At least 27933 Palestinian Syrian refugees have reached Europe during the last 4 years.*
- *The number of Palestinian detainees who were documented by the AGPS has reached 877 detainees, and 394 victims were killed due to torture in the Syrian prisons.*
- *The Yarmouk Camp: - Siege, imposed by the Regular Army and PFGC, continued for 706 days respectively. In addition, power cuts continued for more than 776 days, water was cut for 266 days respectively. The number of victims due to the siege has reached to 177 victims.*
- *Al Husayneyya Camp: - Regular Army is still preventing the residents of the camp to return back to their houses for 587 days respectively.*
- *Al Sbeina Camp: - Regular Army is still preventing the residents of the camp to return back to their houses for 568 days respectively.*
- *Handarat Camp: - Residents have left the camp for 770 days after the Syrian Opposition Groups controlled it.*
- *Dara'a Camp: - It is now almost 413 days without water and 70% of its buildings were demolished.*
- *Jermana, AL SaiedaZainab, Al Raml, Al Aedein Camps in Homs and Hamma: - A relatively quiet situation in light of the economic crises.*
- *Khan Al Sheih Camp: - Roads linking the camp to the city center are still closed except for Zakia- Khan Al Sheih road.*
