"Warplanes Drop Three Explosive Barrels at Khan Eshieh Outskirts"



- After 80 days of cut-out, running water arrives again to Al-Nayrab Camp houses.

RECENT UPDATES

Military warplanes of Syrian Forces dropped, yesterday, tree explosive barrels on Al-Iskan Street and Al-Reda Street near Khan Eshieh Camp, causing status of panic to civilians and to children in particular.

This shelling considered to be an additional breach committed by the Syrian regime against the current truce which was agreed upon between the regime and the opposition forces under international auspices.

The regime forces stationed in the cohort (137) targeted, by several bursts of heavy machine guns, the last road for the people of Khan Eshieh Camp connecting with Zakya nearby town, noting that all roads leading to the camp are closed except this one. It should be noted that the AGPS has documented 151 victims of Palestinian refugees from Khan Eshieh Camp killed since the start of the war.



Turning to Aleppo, where houses of Al-Nayrab camp has been supplied by running water after a severance of about 80 days continuously, which doubled the burdens on people inside the regime-controlled camp.



It is noteworthy that Al-Nayrab camp is one of the most important positions kept by the regime given that it is located very close to both Military and civic airports of Aleppo northern City.

Moving to Turkey, where the authorities, finally, delivered at Al-Khabour Town the corpses of three PRS shot dead at the borders two weeks ago, they are: “Imad Assouz” and his wife “Aminah Saleh” in addition to “Hanan Mousa”.

The delivery has been in collaboration with the General Assembly of Palestinian Refugees which is affiliated to the Syrian Interim Government of Opposition. The corpses have been buried after 15 days of waiting inside the mortuary, while a child witnessed the accident “Jafar Azzouz” is still missing until now, unconfirmed reports indicated that he could be in an orphanage or under Turkish family’s custody.



Turkish judge demanded the competent officials to put more efforts on finding the child and returning him back to his relatives and grandmother who suffered nervous breakdown after her son’s family tragic news.



It is noteworthy that the Turkish Authorities had shot dead three PRS while they were crossing the borders, the three Palestinians were resident of Al-Sayydia Zaynab Camp in Damascus Countryside fled their house after surviving many car bombs recently.

NGOs

The Palestinian house in the Netherlands has distributed food parcels to the new refugees in Nijmegen Centre of asylum seekers in the Netherlands, where they had a conversation with the refugees regarding their conditions and the legal proceedings, and answered the legal questions of asylum application and the thereafter.

- *The Yarmouk Camp: still under siege imposed by the Syrian Regime's Army and PFLP-GC (Popular Front for the Liberation of Palestine – General Command), continued for 993 days respectively. In addition, power cuts continued for more than 1046 days, water cut for 543 days. The number of victims due to the siege has reached to 186 victims.*
- *Al Sbeina Camp: Syrian Regime's Army still preventing the residents from returning back to their houses for 849 days respectively.*
- *Handarat Camp: All of its residents have left the camp for 1042 days after the Syrian Opposition Groups controlled it.*
- *Dara'a Camp: Running water cut continues for 703 days, and 70% of its buildings were destroyed.*
- *Jarmana, AL-Saieda Zainab, Al-Raml, Al-Aedein Homs and Al-Aedein Hama: A relatively quiet situation in light of the economic crises.*
- *Khan Al-Sheih Camp: Roads linking the camp to the city center are still closed except for Zakia-Khan EShieh road.*
