Victims

The Palestinian Syrian Child Retaj Feras Badran from Der'aa camp south of Syria died due to wounds she attained by a snipers bullet. The residents of the camp live in panic and fear due to the spread of snipers in the areas overlooking lanes and streets of the camp, which led to the siege and the inability of people to move freely fearing to be targeted by those snipers who shoot fire at any moving object in the street.

Recent Updates

The Yarmouk camp for Palestinian refugees south of Damascus was exposed to a number of mortar shells that targeted separate areas of the camp. A mortar shell targeted an area near one of the camps mosques during the Friday Prayer which spread panic amongst the residents of the Yarmouk in the mosque.



The Yarmouk camp witnessed a notable tension during the last two days due to the clashes and bombing between the Syrian Opposition forces at Yelda area and the ISIS alongside Al Nusra Front. According to the AGPS correspondent that the clashes led to a number of wounded people from the two parties where the Regular Army and the PFGC still impose a complete siege on the camp since more than 794 days.



In a related context, The negotiation committee to neutralize the Yarmouk camp entered little quantities from the special medicine for the typhoid and jaundice Upper Respiratory Infection inside the besieged Yarmouk camp through the main entrance. They delivered the medicine to the medical staff of the Palestine Red Crescent in Palestine Hospital.



It is referred that the cases of Typhoid and Jaundice were increased lately amongst children, women and old people due to the lack of medical care and hygiene, which is resulted from the control of ISIS on the Yarmouk camp and the siege that is imposed by the Regular Army and the PFGC over the camp.

In Europe, Adham Mohammed Raheel from Khan Al Shieh camp in Damascus Suburb was buried yesterday; he died due to drowning in one of the Swedish lakes. It is mentioned that Adham died a week ago and his relatives said that the drowning was on purpose.



In Netherlands, The Palestine Home in Netherlands organized a visit to three shelter centers in Netherlands and they are Ter apel-veenhuzien-Apeldoorn. The delegation supervised the situation of the refugees in the shelter centers. The Palestine Home in Netherlands clarified that they listened to the problems of a number of new refugees and called them to be in touch.





Missing

The Palestinian refugee Mohammed Melhem from Al Aedin camp in Homs was being missed since 11 days in Hungary while he was in the way to Germany for migration. No news about him till moment .



Numbers and Statistics till 4/9/2015:-

- 15,500 Palestinian Syrian refugees in Jordan, 45,000 Palestinian Syrian refugees in Lebanon, and 6,000 refugees in Egypt, according to the UNRWA's statistics till July 2015.
- At least 36,000 Palestinian Syrian refugees have reached Europe during the last 4 years.
- The Yarmouk Camp: - Siege, imposed by the Regular Army and PFGC, continued for 794 days respectively. In addition, power cuts continued for more than 864 days, water was cut for 354 days respectively. The number of victims due to the siege has reached to 180 victims.
- Al Sbeina Camp: - Regular Army is still preventing the residents of the camp to return back to their houses for 656 days respectively.

- Handarat Camp: - Residents have left the camp for 857 days after the Syrian Opposition Groups controlled it.
- Dara'a Camp: - It is now almost 501 days without water and 70% of its buildings were demolished.
- Jarmana, AL Saieda ZAINAB, Al Raml, Al Aedein Camps in Homs and Hamma: - A relatively quiet situation in light of the economic crises.
- Khan Al Sheih Camp: - Roads linking the camp to the city center are still closed except for Zakia- Khan Al Shieh road.
