"Air Strikes Target the Eastern District of Khan Sheikh Camp, Resulted in Casualties among Civilians"



- A Palestinian Refugee Died due to Air Strikes at Khan Al Shieh Camp
- Syrian Security Arrests 9 Palestinians from Al Aedein Camp in Homs during last June
- Violent Clashes at the Outskirts of Handarat Camp in Aleppo
- 36 Palestinian Refugees Died during June 2016, and 34 Died in the Same Month of 2015

Victims

The Palestinian refugee, Basel Yousef, from Khan Al Shieh camp, died due to wounds he attained by the Russian shelling that targeted the outskirts of the camp before about a week, raising the number of victims who died during the last 48 hours to 4 victims.

Three refugees died yesterday; they are: Mahmoud Omar Saed, Mahmoud SAed Mohammed (Abu Suhaib), and Hasan Subhi Saleh, in addition to 5 injuries.

Recent Updates

The Russian warplanes implemented air strikes against the eastern neighborhood Khan Al Shieh camp in Damascus suburb with two rockets, one of them did not explode. The shelling resulted in a number of injuries, including women and children, a Honda car was burnt, and great damages of buildings and properties.





For their turn, residents of the camp demanded the UN and the human rights organizations to intervene in order to stop shelling the camp that is inhabited with unarmed civilians.

The deteriorated security situation at Khan Al Shieh area exacerbated the humanitarian and living conditions due to the closure of Zakia-Khan Al Shieh road, which is the only road connects the camp with the Syrian capital of Damascus. The Syrian regime prevented the entry of food, medicine, and bread.

Meanwhile, activists said that the continuous strict siege imposed by the Syrian regime will result in the loss of all food and medical materials, as they warned of repeating the same scenario that happened in Yarmouk, which resulted in the death of 187 refugees due to starvation and siege.

The monitoring and documentation team of the AGPS confirmed that Syrian security forces arrested 9 Palestinian refugees from Al Aedein camp in Homs during last June. The detainees are: Ibrahim Adel Kayed, Emad Ahmed Shaheen, Mahmoud Khalid Mahmoud Shatara, the 16-year-child Khaled Mohammed Mahmoud Idris, Muhammad Musa Shatara (Abu Musa), Moataz Abbas (Abu Ezz,) who is displaced from Yarmouk, the Mukhtar of Al Aedein camp "Dirar Asaad Hadeed - Abu-Assad, Ibrahim Majd al-Asadi, and Hisham Atta Hassoun", in his forties.

The AGPS correspondent in Aleppo reported that violent clashes broke out in the vicinity of Handarat camp between the Syrian army alongside al-Quds Brigade and groups of the armed opposition, using all kinds of light and heavy weapons.



Local media resources reported that the opposition fighters besieged a group of al-Quds brigade.



The camp is completely empty of its residents, since most of them were forced to leave due to the violent clashes that broke out between the Regime and the opposition before almost 1159 days, which ended with the opposition's control over the camp.

The Syrian armed opposition forces prevented the return of residents to the camp since that period, while the camp was repeatedly shelled with explosive barrels throughout that period, which resulted in the destruction of approximately 80% of the camp's homes. .

The monitoring and documentation team of the AGPS documented nearly 36 victims who died during June 2016, while "34" refugees died during the same month in 2015, as a result of the ongoing conflict in Syria.

The AGPS noted that the victims of June 2016 were scattered according to the Syrian cities as follows: 18 refugees died in Damascus suburb, 6 refugees died in Aleppo, 3 refugees died in Damascus, 2 refugees died in Deir al-Zour, 2 refugees died in Daraa, and 2 refugees died in Raqqa.



The AGPS pointed out that the "34" victims who were killed in June 2015 were scattered according to the Syrian cities as follows: 4 refugees died in Damascus, 2 refugees died in Damascus suburb, 2 refugees died in Idlib, a refugee died in Lebanon, and 14 refugees were killed in scattered areas.

The AGPS showed that the number of Palestinian refugees who died because of the ongoing war in Syria has reached "3280" victims.

Palestinians of Syria; Numbers and Statistics till 5\07\2016:

- *15500 Palestinian Syrian refugees are in Jordan*
- *42.500 Palestinian Syrian refugees are in Lebanon*
- *6000 Palestinian Syrian refugees are in Egypt, according to the UNRWA statistics till July 2015*
- *8000 Palestinian Syrian refugees are in Turkey*
- *1000 Palestinian Syrian refugees are in Gaza*
- *More than 71.2 thousand Palestinian Syrian refugees have reached Europe till the End of December 2015*
- *The Yarmouk Camp: siege, imposed by the Regular Army and PFGC groups, continued for 1113 consecutive days. Power cut continued for more than 1175 days, water was cut for 664 days respectively. The number of siege victims is 187.*
- *Al Sbeina Camp: - Regular Army is still preventing the residents of the camp to return back to their houses for 967 days respectively.*
- *Handarat Camp: - All Residents have left the camp for about 1 159 days after the Syrian Opposition Groups controlled it.*

- *Dara'a Camp: - It is now almost 820 days without water and almost 70% of its buildings were demolished.*
- *Jermana, AL Saieda ZAINAB, Al Raml, Al Aedein Camps in Homs and Hamma: - A relatively quiet situation in light of the economic crises.*
- *Khan Al Sheih Camp: - Roads linking the camp to the city center are still closed except for Zakia- Khan Al Sheih road.*
