"Three Civilians Wounded in Onslaught on Khan Al-Shih Camp, Water Tanks Destroyed by Machinegun Fire"



- **Palestinian refugee killed while fighting alongside Syrian regime troops**

Victims

Youngster Mohamed Adel Al-Dames, sheltered in the Sbienna Camp for Palestinian refugees, was killed while fighting alongside the Syrian regime army in unabated hostilities with the opposition outfits in Khan Al-Shih, in Damascus western outskirts.

Several Palestinian refugees were killed as they stood as bulletproof vests for the Syrian regime militias during bloody hostilities with the opposition squads.



Latest Developments

Three civilians were left wounded on Friday after two artillery shells hit civilian homes in the western neighborhood of Khan Al-Shih Camp for Palestinian refugees. Heavy material losses were inflicted by the offensive.

At the same time, the self-propelled Shilka tanks deployed in the nearby Dierkhabiya ranches, targeted water reservoirs in Khan Al-Shih Camp



with randomly-discharged spates of machinegun fire, resulting in remarkable damage. A round of explosive barrels and elephant missiles were also slammed into the environs of the camp.

The situation has remarkably gone down in Khan Al-Shih Camp for Palestinian refugees due to the unremitting blitzing and the tough blockade slapped by the Syrian regime army for 36 days in a row. As a result, civilians have run out of medicines and food items.

Moving southwards, the Syrian regime militias unleashed an explosive gas cylinder on the Deraa Camp for Palestinian refugees and another on the adjacent Al-Sadd Road, sheltering Palestinian refugee families. Civilian homes sustained material damage in the assault.

In another development, dozens of Palestinian asylum-seekers in Germany took to Berlin Streets in solidarity with the beleaguered residents of Khan Al-Shih Camp.



The rally-goers lifted the Palestinian flag and banners bearing solidarity slogans.



They further called for ceasing attacks on Khan Al-Shih Camp and securing a safe passage for relief items into the blockaded camp, a home to 12,000 civilian refugees.

Palestinians of Syria: November 05, 2016 Statistics:

- *There are 15,500 Palestinian-Syrian refugees in Jordan.*
- *42,500 Palestinian-Syrian refugees are in Lebanon.*
- *6,000 Palestinian-Syrian refugees are sheltered in Egypt, according to UNRWA figures covering the period from July 2015 backwards.*
- *8,000 Palestinian-Syrian refugees are taking shelter in Turkey.*
- *1,000 Palestinian-Syrian refugees reside in the blockaded Gaza Strip.*
- *Over 79,000 Palestinian Syrian refugees fled to Europe until mid 2016.*
- *Yarmouk refugee camp has been blockaded by the Syrian regime army and Popular Front for the Liberation of Palestine - General Command (PFLP-GC) for 1,236 days in a row. Electricity and water supplies have been cut off, respectively, for 1,295 days and 756 days. The number of those killed due to the blockade has hit 190.*
- *Sbiena refugee camp: Refugees could not go back to their homes as a result of the blockade slapped by the Syrian regime forces since 1,089 days running.*
- *Handarat refugee camp: All refugees left the camp since 1,281 days after opposition outfits grabbed hold of the area.*
- *Deraa refugee camp: Water has been cut off for 939 consecutive days while 70% of its buildings have been knocked down.*

- *Homs camp, Hama camp, Jaramana camp, al-Sayda Zeinab camp, Al-Raml camp: A of State of relative calm has been reported in the abovementioned areas. However, economic crises have been on the rise.*
- *Khan al-Shih refugee camp: All access roads out of and into the camp have been closed off by the Syrian regime army for 36 days running.*
