Victims

Palestinian refugee Mahmoud al-Sayed, from the Palestine Liberation Army (PLA) died in an offensive targeting Tishreen Military Hospital, north of Damascus province.



203 PLA fighters were killed since the outburst of hostilities in Syria, according to AGPS statistics.

Several Palestinian refugees fled war-ragged Syria for fear of being kidnapped at government checkpoints and forced to join PLA as military conscripts.

Latest Developments

The government forces targeted on Monday AlSadd Road and other residential neighborhoods in Deraa, in southern Syria, with barrel bombs, resulting in heavy material damage.

Several Palestinian families have been taking shelter in Deraa AlBalad and the adjacent AlSadd Road.

Palestinian families housed in southern Syria have been facing dire conditions due to the security turmoil and the unabated shelling rocking the area, particularly Deraa Camp.



In another development, ISIS has released gruesome snapshots purporting to show the brutal execution of Palestinian youth Mohamed AlTayeh in AlUruba neighborhood in Yarmouk Camp on allegations of informing on the group and collaborating with Tahrir AlSham battalion.

One of the pictures showed the Palestinian refugee as being dressed in orange jumpsuit kneeling on the floor while a balaclava-clad man dressed in black is seen holding a sword to his head.

Another shot showed the head of the handcuffed hostage as being severed from his body.





Local sources said the casualty had been fighting alongside Tahrir AlSham squads before he was captured by ISIS and released after he was made to admit repentance. However, Tayeh was taken hostage again and publically executed with a sword while handcuffed on account that held contacts with Tahrir AlSham.

Sometime earlier, three residents of Yarmouk were executed by ISIS mobs, who have been holding sway over the camp since early April 2015. At the same time, a tough blockaded has been imposed on Yarmouk by the regime army and their war accomplices.

Meanwhile, opposition sources quoted ex-detainees as stating that they had met a number of Palestinian female refugees in the regime-run Adra lock-up until March 2, 2017.

The list of female detainees spotted in the penitentiary included: Muhsina Balou, from Duma; She is the wife of Duma's former judge Sa'id Jabein. Muhsina has been charged with terrorism.

Two other detainees—Etab AlHaj and Nour AlMashouti—have been incarcerated for the third year on account of their political activism.

AGPS documented the imprisonment of 1,170 Palestinians in Syrian government lock-ups.

Civil Action Commissions

The Palestine Charity Commission distributed 200 bread bundles to families displaced from Jilin and its environs.



Efforts have also been underway by the charity to secure water supplies to 50 displaced families.

Dozens of Palestinian and Syrian families fled Jilin for fear of being killed in the massacres perpetrated by ISIS militias against civilians housed in the area.

Palestinians of Syria: March 6, 2017 Statistics:

- *At least 3,455 Palestinians, including 455 women, were killed in war-torn Syria.*
- *1,170 Palestinian refugees, including 83 women, are incarcerated in Syrian government lock-ups.*
- *Yarmouk refugee camp has been blockaded by the Syrian regime army and Popular Front for the Liberation of Palestine - General Command (PFLP-GC) for 1,354 days in a row.*
- *190 Palestinians died of undernourishment and medical neglect in the blockaded Yarmouk Camp.*
- *Water supplies cut off in Deraa and Yarmouk camps respectively for 1,059 and 867 days.*
- *Residents of Handarat Camp, in Aleppo, denied access to their homes for 1,403 days. Government battalions have been holding sway over the camp for more than 137 days.*
- *Government troops ban residents of AlSbiena Camp from returning to their homes for 1,208 days running.*
- *Over 79,000 Palestinian Syrian refugees fled to Europe until mid 2016.*
