RECENT UPDATES

Four Palestinian Syrian youth conscripted in PLA (Palestine Liberation Army) were killed yesterday, they are: “Jihad Abdul-Karim Al-Shihabi” who was killed in clashes between the regime’s army and the opposition in Eastern Gota of Damascus Countryside, “Rami Ahmad Joma” from Hama Camp, “Mohammad Swied from Khan Dannoun Camp, and “Yousuf Al-Taweel”, the three of them were killed during clashes occurred between regime’s army and ISIS near the thermal power plant in Harran Al-Awamied town in Damascus Countryside.



These incidents bring the total number of PLA victims to 172, almost all of them killed during fighting alongside the Syrian regime.

In north of Syria, the surrounding areas of Al-Nayrab Camp witnessed clashes broke out between the regime’s army and the opposition forces.

Sounds of explosions and gunshots clearly heard from inside the camp which is under full control of the pro-regime groups, Al-Quds brigades in particular.



The high importance of the camp's geo-military location and its proximity to the airport led to endless battles and shelling in attempts to take control of the camp by both of the fighting parties.



In Lebanon, many letters sent to the AGPS indicate that the Lebanese Authorities did stopped some Palestinian families at the borders and prevented them from entering the country despite holding the needed documents.

The Lebanese authorities instructed the airlines to stop Palestinians' boarding heading to Lebanon, causing many cases of family disintegration as members of families who are in different places could not reunite again in Lebanon.



In Macedonia, hundreds of Palestinian refugees from Syria trapped at the Greek-Macedonian borders renewed appeals to the international human rights organizations to help them.



The trapped migrants demanded to let them continue their on-foot trip towards West Europe where they intend to claim asylum, also, to put more pressure on those countries' governments to facilitate their mission and end their suffering in Greece where they sleep in open areas without the minimal care.

It is noteworthy that thousands of refugees, hundreds of PRS were brought into more suffering after the newly reached agreement concerning regulating the migrants flood across the Aegean Sea and the Balkans route.

Palestinians from Syria in numbers and statistics Until 6 April 2016

- *15,000 Palestinian refugee from Syria in Jordan,*
- *6,000 Palestinian refugees from Syria in Egypt, according to the UNRWA's statistics of July 2015.*
- *More than 71,200 Palestinian refugee from Syria arrived Europe by the end of December 2015.*
- *Al-Yarmouk Camp: still under the siege imposed by Syrian Regime's Army and the PFLP-GC (Popular Front for the Liberation of Palestine – General Command for 1026 days. Power cut for 1087 days, water cut for 576 days. The number of victims resulting from the siege is 186.*
- *Al-Sbeina Camp: Syrian Regime's Army still preventing the residents from returning to their houses for 882 days.*

- *Handarat Camp: All of its residents have left the camp for 1074 days after the Syrian Opposition Groups controlled it.*
- *Dara'a Camp: water cut continues for 735 days. 70% of its buildings are destroyed.*
- *Jarmana, AL-Saieda Zainab, Al-Raml, Al-Aedein Homs and Al-Aedein camp of Hama: A relatively quiet situation with economic crises.*
- *Khan Eshieh Camp: All roads linking the camp to the city are still closed back and forth except for Zakia-Khan Eshieh road.*
