"ISIS Terrifies Residents of Yarmouk by Whipping Sentences in Public"



- Resources Close to the Regime Talk about the Delay of Sham Liberation Fighters Exit from the Yarmouk Camp
- Most of Deraa Camp Residents were Displaced due to the Frequent Shelling and the Destruction of Infrastructure

Recent Updates

Our correspondent in Yarmouk camp confirmed that ISIS terrorized the remaining Palestinian families inside the camp, where it carried out several public whipping and defamation of several residents after being accused of doing drugs. According to our correspondent, the whipping sentences take place in the public fields and in front of the people, and the ages of whipped people range between 15 and 50 years.



In the same context, media sources close to the Syrian regime reported that fighters of Sham Liberation Organization will postpone exiting with their families from Yarmouk camp until further notice.

The sources added that the exit of fighters was scheduled last night within the agreement between the Syrian regime and the opposition known as the "four towns" agreement.

A few days ago, the Sham Liberation Organization announced the completion of the first phase of the agreement, while food and medical



assistance were introduced to its controlled areas in the camp, and said that the exit of fighters will be in the second phase.

The camp is under strict siege imposed by the Syrian regime and PF - General Command groups for 1,388 days, while ISIS has controlled 55-60% of the camp area since early April 2015 with the assistance and support of the Nusra Front.

On the other hand, the repeated bombardment of Daraa camp for the past five years has led to the displacement of many residents, to escape from the explosive barrels, rockets, and multiple missiles that targeted the camp and led to the destruction of most of the infrastructure.

According to estimated statistics, 80% of the camp's buildings were completely destroyed by the shelling.



While the cut of drinking water exacerbated the suffering of the rest of residents, where the Syrian regime continues to cut water over the entire camp for 1119 days.



Palestinians of Syria; Numbers and Statistics until 06\05\2017

- *The AGPS documented 3488 Palestinian victims, including 455 women.*
- *1189 Palestinians are detained in the Syrian regime intelligence and security branches, including 87 women.*
- *The Regular Army and the PF-GC groups are besieging the Yarmouk camp for 1388 consecutive days.*
- *1955 male and female Palestinian refugees died due to the lack of nutrition and medical care because of the siege; most of them are from the Yarmouk Camp.*
- *It is now more than 1119 days without water in Deraa camp, and 970 days in the Yarmouk camp.*
- *Residents of Handarat camp are prevented from returning to their houses for 14623 days, while the camp is controlled by the Regular Army for more than 197 days.*
- *Almost 85,000 Palestinian Syrian refugees have reached Europe till the end of 2016, while the number of Palestinian refugees in Lebanon is almost 31,000, in Jordan 17,000, in Egypt 6000, in turkey 8000, and in Gaza 1000.*
