### “The Lebanese General Security Issues New Decisions for Regularization of Palestinians of Syria in Lebanon”



- Most Residents of Khan Al Shieh Camp in Damascus Suburb Basically Relay on Aid

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### **Recent Updates**

The Lebanese General Security Issued new decisions regarding the Palestinian and the Syrian refugees coming from Syria; those decisions were published at the official website of the LGS under the title, "Palestinian and Syrian People / Palestinian and Syrian Regularization."

The decisions included Palestinian refugees from Syria by several points, namely:

Regularization of Palestinian refugees in Syria, who are currently reside in Lebanon since before the Syrian events, to leave without entry prevent stamp.

Renew residencies extend up to 30. 11.2015 for free even if their stay exceeds a year.

The resolution stressed that all Palestinian Syrian refugees entered Lebanon before 05.01.2015 and exceeded the legal period of up to four years from the date of entering the Lebanese territories and who wish to leave, to exclusively visit departments and border posts to regularize their status and to pay the owed fees.

The decision added several points concerning Syrian nationals.

Conflicting reports on the implementation of the renewal decision free of charge among the Lebanese areas, while the Palestinian refugees displaced from Syria to Lebanon are suffering very difficult economic and social situations.



The suffering is increasing along with their legal status, in addition to humiliation and abuse when they try to issue official papers, especially in the Lebanese General Security Centers.



The Lebanese government considers the Palestinian of Syria in Lebanon, "tourists," which drops their rights due to the Lebanese state and the Lebanese government.

The Lebanese government, especially the Lebanese public security, experiencing volatile policies toward the Palestinian refugees displaced from Syria, sometimes it issues a decision to renew residencies for two or three months; the Palestinian refugee applies residency procedures, which may takes a month or two, and when receiving, the period granted to him is nearing completion.

In addition, the Lebanese government prevents the displaced Palestinian refugees to work on its territory.

The number of Palestinian refugees from Syria amounted to about 45,000 refugees; 45% of them are children, while the refugees scattered in several areas of Lebanon.



Turning to Syria, the remained residents of the Yarmouk camp in Damascus, who estimated between 3000-5000 civilians, are suffering from acute shortage of medical services because of the continued siege imposed by the regular army and PFGC groups.



Meanwhile, main hospitals of the camp have been subjected to shelling, which led to major damage causing stoppage of work.

The control of ISIS since the exacerbated Daash on the camp since the beginning of last April that situation, where the organization has forced most of the relief agencies inside the camp to get out of it towards the town of Yalda, after the organization of the assassination of many activists.



It is noteworthy that 183 of the refugees in the camp died as a result of the siege imposed on them because of the nutrition and medical care shortage.

In the Damascus correspondent of the working group in Wormwood Khan Palestinian refugee camp has confirmed, that a large number of young people Mekhem khan alchih unemployed and aid always waiting for, the fact that most of the population in sub-trapping zone.

He added that most of the youth camp are not working and have no source of livelihood for only some assistance from UNRWA and the number of institutions Alagathih hat provide institutions aid for a limited number of households, which is not enough need only aid UNRWA, which comes every two or three months.

Our correspondent pointed out that the bread and vegetables, fuel gas and fuel oil and gasoline are available on the black market, and entered the camp from the vicinity of the camp town Zakya, but the price is very high in terms of materials adversely affected close by Zakia only artery that feeds 2,000 families in the camp.





It is noteworthy that the regular army roadblocks ongoing closure of all connecting roads between the camp and the center of the capital Damascus, forcing parents to take the road (Khan Wormwood - Zakya sub and dangerous) to get to Damascus, where they are targeting the road frequently propelled grenades and heavy machine guns, have been documented WG 141 victims of the camp, the children spent mostly by shelling.

On the other hand received the working group for Velstina sorah reports that Syrian security released Syrian Palestinian young, "the faith of Mohammed" after arrest for about three years, moved in between the Syrian regime's security branches, and was released on bail from the central prison in Adra Rural Damascus, a resident of the city of Damascus.

The working group documented 61 Palestinian detained in the prisons of the Syrian regime, their fate is still unknown, while he spent dozens of refugee under torture, noting that Syrian security and many of the families of the detainees secret of the fate of their children, especially of women.

On the subject of various Malaysian authorities continue to detain Palestinian refugee "Ibrahim Abu-out" in the Kuala Lumpur airport for more than two months, he appealed to where Abu came out earlier both:

The Palestinian Authority and the PLO and the Palestinian embassy in Malaysia, and human rights organizations, and organizations of the United Nations for urgent action to release him, warning at the same time,



the intention of the Malaysian authorities deported to Syria or Lebanon, which may pose a risk to his life.



It is noteworthy that he was arrested Abu came out, by the Cambodian authorities, who deported him to Malaysia, during an attempt to "Abu came out" to reach Europe.

Turning to Austria where held in the city of Brooke und to Athia Austrian exhibition Photography of refugees from the Yarmouk camp young man, "Mahmoud Abdullah" (Hakeem Abdullah) under the title "Dreamers" Dreamers, where Leroy show the suffering of the siege of the Yarmouk camp and hunger to immigration and exile, The exhibition runs in the days 19\_20\_21 / 11/2015 in the lounge Erbsenfabri Bruckneudorf.

It is noteworthy that the Palestinian community are active in European countries through art exhibitions, conferences and seminars in the attempts which, for the delivery of the suffering of the Palestinian refugees, particularly in Syria and the Palestinian refugee camps and deported death fought by refugees across the boat up to the countries of



asylum, as well as to preserve the identity of the Palestinian refugees and to prevent melted in European societies .



### Numbers and Statistics till 5/11/2015:-

- 15,500 Palestinian Syrian refugees in Jordan, 45,000 Palestinian Syrian refugees in Lebanon, and 6,000 refugees in Egypt, according to the UNRWA's statistics till July 2015.
- At least 36,000 Palestinian Syrian refugees have reached Europe during the last 4 years.
- **The Yarmouk Camp:** - Siege, imposed by the Regular Army and PFGC, continued for 857 days respectively. In addition, power cuts continued for more than 927 days, water was cut for 417 days respectively. The number of victims due to the siege has reached to 182 victims.
- **Al Sbeina Camp:** - Regular Army is still preventing the residents of the camp to return back to their houses for 718 days respectively.
- **Handarat Camp:** - Residents have left the camp for 919 days after the Syrian Opposition Groups controlled it.

- **Dara'a Camp:** - It is now almost 563 days without water and 70% of its buildings were demolished.

- **Khan Al Sheih Camp:** - Roads linking the camp to the city center are still closed except for Zakia- Khan Al Shieh road.
