Recent Updates

The AGPS Monitoring and Documentation Team documented about 133 victims who died during April 2017, while 22 refugees died during the same month of 2016 due to the continuing conflict in Syria.

The AGPS noted that the victims of April 2017 were distributed according to the Syrian cities as follows: 55 refugees died in Damascus, 3 in Daraa, 2 in Hama, and 4 others whose locations were not known.



The AGPS reported that the 22 victims who died in April 2016, were distributed according to the Syrian cities as follows: 8 refugees in Damascus, in addition to 66 in Damascus suburb, 3 in Daraa, 4 in Aleppo, and a refugee died in one of the Syrian towns.

As for the south of the Syrian capital, Damascus, and despite what was reported and confirmed yesterday by media sources close to the Syrian regime, about the beginning of exiting process of hundreds of Sham Liberation Organization fighters and their families from the Yarmouk camp to the countryside Idlib within the "four cities" agreement between



Syrian Regime and armed opposition factions, but that agreement was not applied on the ground.

According to the AGPS correspondent, the exiting process was postponed indefinitely without knowing the real reasons behind the postponement.



On Saturday, July 6, 2015, Palestine Charity Committee distributed money for 53 orphans from Muzareeb. The Committee also distributed 2655 thousand Syrian pounds donated by the good people to be distributed in Muzareeb, and 5,000 Syrian Pounds were distributed for every orphan.

In addition, almost 17,000 Palestinian families in Muzareeb, as well as hundreds of Palestinian families who were displaced from Daraa refugee camp, are living in extremely harsh conditions, due to the repeated shelling, as well as the lack of any assistance from UNRWA or others.

On Greece, hundreds of Syrian refugees stranded in Greece are suffering from extremely harsh living conditions. They complain of medical negligence and lack of treatment and medicine. All roads between them



and European countries have been closed. Those refugees have risked their lives to reach Greece from Turkish shores.

They have been forced to stay in temporary refugee camps in Greece under extremely harsh conditions, where refugees suffer from the lack of hygiene and basic services in their places of residence. Most of the dwellings are temporary dwellings or tents, in light of great spread of insects and poisonous reptiles such as scorpions and snakes.

The families appealed to all international and humanitarian organizations, the International Red Cross, and the Palestinian Embassy in Greece to intervene to end their tragedy.

In addition, Palestinians of Syria and the Palestinian community in Germany organized a solidarity vigil with the hunger striker in the Israeli prisons since April 17, in protest against the Israeli practices against them to secure all their humanitarian demands which were approved and guaranteed by all international laws.





The protesters appealed to the United Nations, human rights bodies, and the International Red Cross to intervene in order to meet the humanitarian demands of the prisoners which were guaranteed by international conventions and legislation regarding prisoners of war, especially the Fourth Geneva Convention.

meanwhile, the Syrian regime continues to arrest the Palestinian refugee "Mahmoud Huneri" from the Yarmouk refugee camp south of Damascus unrevealing his fate. For their part, human rights activists reported the testimony of released prisoners who have seen them in the Sidnaya military prison in the village Sidnaya north of the Syrian capital Damascus, noting that his last viewing was on 25 - 12 - 2015.

Meanwhile, hundreds of Palestinian refugees remain in Syrian security prisons and continue to conceal their fate, places and conditions of detention.

Palestinians of Syria; Numbers and Statistics until 07\05\2017

- *The AGPS documented 3488 Palestinian victims, including 455 women.*
- *1189 Palestinians are detained in the Syrian regime intelligence and security branches, including 87 women.*
- *The Regular Army and the PF-GC groups are besieging the Yarmouk camp for 1388 consecutive days.*

- *1955 male and female Palestinian refugees died due to the lack of nutrition and medical care because of the siege; most of them are from the Yarmouk Camp.*
- *It is now more than 1120 days without water in Deraa camp, and 971 days in the Yarmouk camp.*
- *Residents of Handarat camp are prevented from returning to their houses for 14644 days, while the camp is controlled by the Regular Army for more than 198 days.*
- *Almost 85,000 Palestinian Syrian refugees have reached Europe till the end of 2016, while the number of Palestinian refugees in Lebanon is almost 31,000, in Jordan 17,000, in Egypt 6000, in turkey 8000, and in Gaza 1000.*
