"Syrian and Russian Aircrafts Threaten More Than 12000 Civil Lives in Khan Al-Sheih"



- Palestinian young man was killed and another was injured during clashes in Aleppo.
- Airstrikes in the outskirts of Khan al-Sheih in Damascus countryside.
- One missile on Neirab causes material damages.
- One year for arresting the Palestinian activist " Niraz Saeed " by Syrian regime.

Victims

"Abed Al Rahman Mostafa", a Palestinian young man was killed during fights alongside the pro-Syrian regime "Al Quds Brigade" in the north of Aleppo.



He was killed during the confrontation between Al Quds Brigade groups and armed opposition groups. Some media sources, which are close to Al Quds Brigade groups, confirmed the injury of another Palestinian young man and a member of the Brigade called "Mohammed Mahmoud Najjeb".

It's good to remind that Al Quds brigade consists of more than (3500) members (according to unofficial resources) distributed in three battalions, armed with light, medium and heavy weapons. It includes Palestinian refugees from Neirab, Handart and Al Raml camps. It also contains fighters from Aleppo and its north west countryside, the "Black Ghost" and " Black Shirts" battalions. The number of Palestinian fighters in Al Quds brigade is estimated with less than 500 fighters.



Recent Updates

More than 12000 civilians including 3000 children live in Khan Al-sheih difficult humanitarian conditions; they are being bombed with explosive barrels, helicopters and mortars every day. Unfortunately, the situation is getting worse with a number of victims and injuries without medical care because of shelling hospitals and medical centers.



In the same context, Syrian regime helicopters' targeted the farms around the camp yesterday with two explosive barrels.

It comes amid closing all the connecting roads between the camp and the capital "Damascus" by Syrian regime barriers', which aggravates living and medical crises. Moreover, the camp witnessed violent raids yesterday leaving 3 victims and a number of casualties behind.

It's worth noting that AGPS had demanded in a previous statement the Syrian government to break the siege over the camp, open roads, and allow the medical personnel to enter the camp and provide people with needed medical care. It had also called the international community to



achieve international peace and security, secure Palestinian refugees and enforce parties of the conflict to neutralize Palestinian camps since they are recognized as asylum centers according to UNRWA.

In the north of Syria, Neirab camp in Aleppo was being attacked by missile strike. One of the missiles fell on a farm land leaving material damages.

The outskirts of the camp witnessed fierce clashes at night between armed opposition groups and Syrian regime forces on the fronts of Aziza, Sheikh Lotfi and Sheikh Saeed. It's should be mentioned that the camp is under the control of the Syrian regime allied with Al Quds Brigade.

Syrian security forces keep arresting the Palestinian photographer "Niraz Saeed" without knowing anything about his fate or even the reasons behind the arrest. On 2 October 2015, a syrian security group raided his house and dragged him to one of the security centers in Damascus in spite of syrian regime promises' not to arrest him.



Niraz and a number of activists, who had documented war events in Yarmouk during the last years, left the trapped camp after being threatened by ISIS to be assassinated.



He had also won many prizes for his artworks which documented the levels of Yarmouk siege. UNRWA prize for the best press photo was the most significant one. His photo was "The Three Kings" in addition to the movie "Letters from Yarmouk", which won many international prizes and its photos were published in exhibits in Quds and Ramallah.

Till now, Syrian security forces still hiding the truth about the number of Palestinian detainees in its prisons and their fate. AGPS documented (1109) detainees and (452) victims were killed because of torturing inside Syrian regime prisons.

Palestinians of Syria; Numbers and Statistics until 7/10/2016

- *(15500) Palestinian Syrian refugees are in Jordan.*
- *(42,500) Palestinian Syrian refugees are in Lebanon.*
- *(6000) Palestinian Syrian refugees are in Egypt, according to the UNRWA statistics till July 2015.*
- *(8000) Palestinian Syrian refugees are in Turkey.*
- *(1000) Palestinian Syrian refugees are in Gaza.*
- *More than (79,000) Palestinian Syrian refugees have reached Europe till mid-2016.*
- *Yarmouk Camp: siege, imposed by the Regime's Army and PFGC groups, continued for (1207) consecutive days. Power cut continued for more than (1268) days. water was cut for (758) days respectively. The number of siege victims is (187).*
- *Sabina Camp: Regime's Army is still forbidding the residents of the camp to return back to their houses for (1060) days respectively.*

- *Handarat Camp: - All Residents have left the camp for about (1252) days after the Syrian Opposition Groups controlled it.*
- *Daraa Camp: - It is now almost (910) days without water and almost 70% of its buildings were totally destroyed.*
- *Jarmana, AL Sayeda -Zeinab, Al Raml, Al Aedein Camps in Homs and Hama: A relatively quiet situation in light of the economic crises.*
- *Khan Al Sheih Camp: Roads linking the camp to the city center are still closed except for Zakia- Khan Al Sheih road.*
