Recent Updates

People of Khan Dannon camp in Damascus suburb complain many immoral and harassment acts practiced by the regular military checkpoint members on the road to their camp.

A resident confirmed to the AGPS that the checkpoint members harassed women and girls of the camp by verbal and abrasives harassment while they passed through the checkpoint."

He also noted that "the members looting many nutrients that the shops owners and parents enter to the camp."

He noted that all of those practices are under esophagus and ears of the Popular Committees of the Palestinian groups, which fights alongside the regime, without showing any reaction or defend the women of the camp, as claimed.

In Damascus, sporadic clashes broke out yesterday in Yarmouk between ISIS alongside AL Nusra Front and Ahrar al-Sham alongside groups of residents.

Ahrar al-Sham group managed to control some buildings that were under the control of "Daash" groups near Zein neighborhood.

Meanwhile, ISIS and Al Nusra front attacked several Syrian army points and Palestinian militant groups in Thalathein Street. Media sources close to the Syrian regime announced that many of the PFGC members were wounded during the attack.

Groups of Syrian regular army and PFGC continue to impose a strict siege on the Yarmouk refugee camp for (679) days respectively, while ISIS breaking into the camp since 1st of April has aggravated the humanitarian situation inside the camp.

It is worth mentioning that the PLO delegation in Damascus discusses with a number of Syrian officials and Palestinian factions about the Yarmouk refugee camp, humanitarian assistance, and the file of Palestinian detainees.

During the meeting, they discussed ways to address the crisis of Yarmouk camp after ISIS controlled large parts of the camp; the two officials also discussed opening safe corridors to facilitate the introduction of aid to the camp, and discussed the Palestinian detainees in Syria file and regularize their status.



Turning to Aleppo, the young man, "Nayef Fayyad," from Nairab camp was injured by shrapnel while he was in the city and was taken to a hospital. It is noteworthy that many of the neighborhoods of Aleppo witnessed acts of bombing and frequent clashes between the regular army and groups affiliated to the Syrian armed opposition.

In Lebanon, delegation from "Shahid" human rights institution has met the President of the Lebanese Palestinian Dialogue Committee "Hassan Mneimneh" where the delegation delivered the former minister "Mneimneh" the human rights organization's report which talks about the conditions of Palestinian refugee camps in Lebanon.

The delegation will also display several human rights and humanitarian issues concerning Palestinian refugees in Lebanon generally, and the displaced Palestinians from Syria in Lebanon in particular. The delegation discussed with Mneimneh the suffering of Palestinian refugees from Syria, the case of renewing their residency by the Lebanese General Security, and the difficulty of obtaining permits to enter Palestinian refugee camps by the army intelligence, as well as depriving students of the official exams this year.



For his part, chairman of the Lebanese Palestinian Dialogue Committee promised to make efforts to follow up the issues of Palestinian refugees from Syria in Lebanon with the concerned Lebanese government bodies.

Arrest

The members of Al Kubri checkpoint in Damascus suburb arrested the young man "Muneer Mohammed Yousef" from Khan Al Shieh camp, in light of the continuing closure of most roads that link the camp with the capital center of Damascus except for Zakia-Khan Al Shieh road.

Meanwhile, the Syrian Security raided a house at Al Quds Street in Al Aedein camp, two days ago, as they arrested the young man "Amjad Mohammed Hadba," in his thirties. It was mentioned that he was arrested for the second time during the past two years.

Civil Work Committees

Food aid distribution at Yelda area adjacent to Yarmouk camp; the aids were distributed by three intuitions; Al Wafaa European Campaign, PLO, and Charity Committee for the Relief of Palestinian People.

Al Wafaa European Campaign(12) distributed 200 food rations, bread, baby milk, water, and dates during two days , a European delegation that presented five countries participated in the distribution process and also the delegation witnessed the suffering of the people and listened to their concerns.



The campaign Al Khair Al Aseel , which was launched in cooperation with the international Relief Organization since two days, continues to distribute 2000 food parcels on the residents of the camp, where the Hope campaign distributed about 1500 children milk cans to the Yarmouk residents in cooperation with the Viva Palestine Malaysia.

In addition, the PLO distributed in its charity campaign 1000 food parcels and 2000 bread packs and children milk cans to the Yarmouk residents at Yelda town and it is expected that the relief work will continue today to the residents of the camp.



Numbers and Statistics till 7/5/2015

- *At least 27933 Palestinian Syrian refugees have reached Europe during the last 4 years.*
- ***The Yarmouk Camp:** - Siege, imposed by the Regular Army and PFGC, continued for 679 days respectively. In addition, power cuts continued for more than 749 days, water was cut for 239 days respectively. The number of victims due to the siege has reached to 176 victims.*

- *80,000* Palestinian Syrian refugees escaped from Syria to the neighboring towns, including *10,687* refugees in Jordan, *51,300* in Lebanon and *6,000* refugees in Egypt, according to UNRWA statistics till February 2015.
- **Al Husayneyya Camp:** - Regular Army is still preventing the residents of the camp to return back to their houses for *560* days respectively.
- **Al Sbeina Camp:** - Regular Army is still preventing the residents of the camp to return back to their houses for *541* days respectively.
- **Handarat Camp:** - Residents have left the camp for *743* days after the Syrian Opposition Groups controlled it.
- **Dara'a Camp:** - It is now almost *386* days without water and *70%* of its buildings were demolished.
- **Jermana, AL Saieda ZAINAB, Al Raml, Al Aedein Camps in Homs and Hamma:** - A relatively quiet situation in light of the economic crises.
- **Khan Al Sheih Camp:** - Roads linking the camp to the city center are still closed except for Zakia- Khan Al Sheih road.
