### Victims

*Palestinian resident of Syria-based Yarmouk Camp Bassam Ali Youssef, born in 1978, died under torture in Syrian government lock-ups.*

*The casualty was kidnapped in 2013 from a UNRWA-run vocational education center in Al-Mezzeh, in Damascus.*

*According to AGPS statistics, 459 Palestinian refugees were tortured to death in Syrian penal complexes.*

### Latest Developments

*Palestinian refugee Aisha Salah Sweid, born in 1962, was released on Tuesday as part of prisoner swap deal struck between the Syrian government and the opposition in the north.*

*The deal culminated in the release of 54 women and children held captive by the regime forces.*

*AGPS kept record of the internment of 1,154 Palestinian refugees in Syrian jails, among whom 83 female refugees.*

*In a related development, Palestinian refugee Raslan Tawfiq Raja, was kidnapped by the Syrian government troops deployed at the Ein checkpoint, set up on the main access road to Khan Al-Sheih Camp for Palestinian refugees.*

*The abduction is another chain in the series of violations, by the regime battalions, of the reconciliation accord struck with the opposition outfits and which stipulated that the latter retreat from the camp and its adjacent towns.*

*Meanwhile, five Palestinians have been incarcerated in government prisons, four among whom identified as members of the Daoud family.*

*The four family members are: 29-year-old Nour Ahmad Daoud, a resident of Al-Hajar Al-Aswad area and the father of a young girl. He was kidnapped in 2013; 30-year-old Daoud Ahmad Daoud, a resident of Al-Hajar Al-Aswad and the father of two boys and a girl. He was kidnapped at the Al-Batikha checkpoint.*

*The list also includes the two brothers Mahmoud Mohamed Kheir Daoud, 21, and Ali Mohamed Kheir Daoud, 19. Both are residents of Al-Hajar Al-Aswad and were kidnapped in 2014 from Al-Dweilaa area, in Damascus.*

*27-year-old Mustafa Marwan Hussein, a resident of Misraba, was kidnapped in 2013 from the UNRWA-led vocational education center in Al-Mezzeh, in Damascus.*



*In another development, Palestinian refugee from Syria Mustafa Hajawi, a resident of Yarmouk shelter, was forcibly deported from Sweden to Greece.*



*Mustafa Hajawi was arrested by the Swedish authorities on January 25 at a Swedish immigration agency after he had gained residency rights from the Greek authorities.*

*Al-Hajawi headed to Sweden from Greek in September 2014. The Swedish authorities revoked his residency rights on account that he was granted such rights in Greece and will thus be treated as someone who received protection from a European state.*

### ***Palestinians of Syria: February 8, 2017 Statistics:***

- *At least 3,434 Palestinians, including 455 women, were killed in war-torn Syria.*

- *1,154 Palestinian refugees, including 83 women, are incarcerated in Syrian government lock-ups.*
- *Yarmouk refugee camp has been blockaded by the Syrian regime army and Popular Front for the Liberation of Palestine - General Command (PFLP-GC) for 1,329 days in a row.*
- *190 Palestinians died of undernourishment and medical neglect in the blockaded Yarmouk Camp.*
- *Water supplies cut off in Deraa and Yarmouk camps respectively for 1,033 and 840 days.*
- *Residents of Handarat Camp, in Aleppo, denied access to their homes for 1,377 days. Government battalions have been holding sway over the camp for more than 112 days.*
- *Government troops ban residents of Al-Sbiena Camp from returning to their homes for 1,182 days running.*
- *Over 79,000 Palestinian Syrian refugees fled to Europe until mid 2016.*
- *31,000 Palestinians from Syria are housed in Lebanon.*
- *17 Palestinians from Syria are taking refuge in Jordan.*
- *6,000 Palestinian-Syrian refugees are sheltered in Egypt.*
- *8,000 Palestinian-Syrian refugees are taking shelter in Turkey.*
- *1,000 Palestinian-Syrian refugees are sheltered in the blockaded Gaza Strip.*
