### **Victims**

*The Palestinian refugee "Muneir Mohammed Khattab", 23 years, from the Yarmouk camp died during the warplanes shelling that targeted KfrBtina area in Damascus suburb before days, raising the toll of the Palestinians of Syria victims to 2641, including 988 victims died due to shelling, according to the AGPS statistics.*

### **Recent Updates**

*The Palestinian and Syrian refugees, who are detained at Karmouz prison in Egypt , declared their open hunger strike starting from Monday, 9-2 till they achieve their demands of urgent coordination among the concerned parties in order to receive them in the European Union countries specially the countries that have some members of the detained families, where it was a response to what the statement described as negligence that the refugees receive from the International and humanitarian organizations after 100 days of detention,.*

*The statement that the AGPS had received a copy of it, added that the detainees are treated as prisoners and stray away from the precious human life, which led to the deterioration of their health and psychological condition, however, they did not find but this means to meet their demands. The statement also pointed out that the refugees had launched several appeals to the United Nations, human rights*



*organizations, the PLO and the Palestinian factions to intervene in order to resolve their case, release them and alleviate their suffering, but they have not received any response.*

*On the other hand, the relief agencies, which supervise the aids distribution process to the Yarmouk camp residents, distributed about 500 food packages on the residents who went to Yelda town to get their shares from the aids.*



#### ***Aids distribution process to in the Yarmouk camp***

*As AGPS correspondent pointed out that the organizations divided the one share into three shares in order to cover the huge number of the besieged residents, according to the distributors. It is noteworthy to mention that the distribution via the "Yelda - BeitSahem" comes after repeated failure of attempts to enter aids through the main entrance of the camp, which is controlled by the regular army and groups of the Popular Front - General Command.*

*The Regular Army and the PFGC groups allowed the exit of three humanitarian cases to get treatment in one of the Damascus hospitals, where relief sides estimated the number of the urgent cases and who need to be transferred to hospitals as 100 patients, where there is no possibility to be treated inside the camp because of the acute shortage and lack of medical staff inside the camp due to the continuation of the siege. The siege also led to the suspension of all its hospitals except for Palestine hospital, which offers some simple medical services.*



*In the same context, the difficulties that face the refugees forced the teachers of Al Jarmaq School in the Yarmouk camp to suspend the school classes as they try to get food parcels to let the hunger far from their children, where Jarmaq School suspended the school classes in the Yarmouk refugee camp yesterday Sunday 2nd of Feb for their livelihood, as stated by the school ads board.*

*As one of Al Jaramaq School teachers commented to the AGPS, saying, "We are in a Al Jarmaq School offer our services to people in the camp for nearly two years, of course, our school is not the only one which suffers, but a number of other schools which offer their services to all students at all levels."*

*He added, "We serve the people of our camp, with pride and humility, and this is our duty, but this hurts when we ask for something that is available and possible and what hurts is that no one respond, it is supposed to take into account our situation that while they distribute aids we were at school and we couldn't go to receive the aids but to leave the school.*

*In Khan Al Sheih, the Syrian warplanes targeted the farms area with explosive barrels coincided with warplanes hovering over the camp, which led to a panic state among its residents fearing from the warplanes raids. The suffering of the camp continues due to the roads cut that connect the camp with the adjacent areas where they were obliged to go through Zakia Khan Al Sheih road despite the risks that they were exposed to like bombing and sniping.*

*The Syrian security forces, who are on the checkpoint of Al Jadeda town in Damascus Suburb, arrested the refugee "Sanad Saleh Sanad" While we did not know the destination, which was transferred to. On the other hand, the AGPS received information about the loss of contact with a Palestinian old man "Kher Al Din Muhammad Al Shabi" since about two weeks in Al Aedin camp in Homs. It is referred that Al Shabi was always available near Al Shekkat crossing that is close to Belal ben Rabah mosque on the eastern side of the camp.*

*In Malmo City in Sweden, dozens of Palestinian refugees were gathered in solidarity sit-in with the besieged people of Yarmouk camp since 582 days. The activists, who protested according to an invitation of Save the Palestinians of Syria movement, demanded to take the siege of the*



*Yarmouk camp away and to enter the food and urgent medical aids to the residents in addition to allowing for the residents who wanted to get out.*



### ***Numbers and Statistics till 8/2/2015***

- *At least 27933 Palestinian Syrian refugees have reached Europe during the last 4 years.*
- *2641 Palestinian refugees were documented by the AGPS.*
- *The Yarmouk Camp: - Siege, imposed by the Regular Army and PFGC, continued for 582 days respectively. In addition, power cuts continued for more than 662 days, water was cut for 152 days respectively. The number of victims due to the siege has reached 165 victims.*
- *80,000 Palestinian Syrian refugees escaped from Syria to the neighboring towns, including 14348 refugees in Jordan, 42,000 in Lebanon, according to UNRWA statistics till November.*
- *Al Husayneyya Camp: - Regular Army is still preventing the residents of the camp to return back to their houses for 484days respectively.*
- *Al Sbeina Camp: - Regular Army is still preventing the residents of the camp to return back to their houses for 453days respectively.*
- *Handarat Camp: - Residents have left the camp for 655days after the Syrian Opposition Groups controlled it.*
- *Dara'a Camp: - It is now almost 299days without water and 70% of its buildings were demolished.*
