Victims

"Nidal Ahmed Al-Ali Al-Salibi," from Daraa camp died on Tuesday 7th of July morning, after shells were dropped at Al Kashif neighborhood in Daraa camp.

The Palestinian refugee "Mohammed Darwish," from Daraa camp- Naseeb town- Daraa province, also died due to warplanes' bombing at the area.

It is noteworthy that the AGPS documented 214 victims from Daraa camp who died during the war events in Syria, many of them died during participation in the ongoing conflict in Syria.

Recent Updates

An explosive device exploded at Muzareeb town, which is inhabited with 8500 Palestinian refugees, and resulted in material damage. According to the AGPS correspondent, the explosive device was planted in a shop at Alsarafees crossing, and there are no casualties among civilians.





Meanwhile, many residents of Muzareeb town put responsibility of this explosion on the Syrian regime and its affiliated groups; while similar cases was recorded at Muzareeb and several areas and Palestinian camps, which claimed the lives of dozens of victims.

In Damascus, rockets and mortars targeted the Yarmouk camp on Wednesday night, where two missiles were dropped at Haifa Street and several rockets at the Yarmouk main street, causing major destruction at the place of their fall, coinciding with violent clashes between the regular army alongside affiliated groups and ISIS alongside Al-Nusra Front on several fighting axes in the camp.

Turning to Damascus suburb, where the regular army targeted the sides of Khan Al Shieh camp with heavy artillery shells.

Our correspondent reported news about a number of shells that were dropped inside the camp, pointing out that one of the shells landed in the main street at a house owned by Orsan family, while the other one landed on a home in Al Smika lane, and a third shell landed on one of the shops versus Rafea' Pharmacy on Main Street.



The shelling resulted in only material damage, while the adjacent areas and towns are still witness rise in the Syrian military operations and air attacks with rockets and explosive barrels.

Moreover, two shells targeted Al Wafedeen camp, one of them landed on Al Sarafees bus station, and the other one landed on the sides of the camp, resulted in the injury of a 13--year-old child was taken to a hospital near the camp for treatment.

It is referred that the camp, which includes a number of displaced Palestinian and Syrian refugees, is suffering from poverty, high unemployment rate, and poor living conditions even before the events in Syria.

Lebanon

A delegation from Palestinians of Syria Teachers League in Lebanon visited Mr. Muneer Ibraheem, official of education file in UNRWA on Monday, July 7. The delegation was briefed about work mechanisms, the aims of establishing such league, and the means of helping the displaced Palestinian Syrian students in Lebanon.

The participants addressed many topics such as the ways of supporting education and teachers, and honoring the successful students who were excellence in Lebanon despite all difficult living conditions faced by the Palestinians of Syria children.

At the end of the visit, official of education file in UNRWA promised the delegation to do his best efforts in order to support the league, and to



contribute alleviating the consequences of displacement towards the Palestinians of Syria teachers in Lebanon.

On the other hand, Alquds Charity Committee in cooperation with Palestinians of Syria Committee in Lebanon carried out a collective Iftar for the Palestinian families coming from Syria and a number of Syrian refugee families who are reside in Bidawi camp in Tripoli south of Lebanon.

This step came as an attempt to enforce the social solidarity relations between the residents of the displaced Palestinian Syrian camps in Lebanon, as well as to alleviate their economic burdens and their dire humanitarian situations.

Macedonia

The Macedonian Authorities arrested the Palestinian refugee 'Sami Khalid Thiab' in charges of entering its territories illegally.

The AGPS mentioned that the refugee Thiab was missed in Macedonia in 10th of April 2015 while trying to travel to Europe.



It was mentioned that Macedonia has become a station in which refugees, who escape the ongoing war in Syria, passed by in order to continue their way to European countries after reaching Greece then Macedonia.

Statistics

The AGPS documentation and monitoring team revealed that 314 Palestinian refugees died since the beginning of events in Syria from the beginning of 2015 till the end of last June. The team also announced that during the last six months victims were distributed as follows:

33 Palestinian refugees died during January 2015 in Syria, 45 Palestinian refugees died in February 015, 100 Palestinian refugees died in March 2015, including 83 refugees died due to torture in the prisons of the Syrian regime, while 65 Palestinian refugees died in April 2015, including 32 refugees died due to gun shot, while 38 refugees died during May 2015, and 34 refugees died in June 2015.

Meanwhile, the AGPS announced that the number of Palestinian refugees who died due to the ongoing war in Syria has reached 2921 victims.

Numbers and Statistics till 8/7/2015

- *80,000 Palestinian refugees escaped from Syria, including 10,687 refugees in Jordan, 51300 refugees in Lebanon, and 6,000 refugees in Egypt, according to the UNRWA's statistics till February 2015.*

- *At least 36,000 Palestinian Syrian refugees have reached Europe during the last 4 years.*
- *The Yarmouk Camp: - Siege, imposed by the Regular Army and PFGC, continued for 741 days respectively. In addition, power cuts continued for more than 811 days, water was cut for 301 days respectively. The number of victims due to the siege has reached to 177 victims.*
- *Al Husayneyya Camp: - Regular Army is still preventing the residents of the camp to return back to their houses for 622 days respectively.*
- *Al Sbeina Camp: - Regular Army is still preventing the residents of the camp to return back to their houses for 603 days respectively.*
- *Handarat Camp: - Residents have left the camp for 805 days after the Syrian Opposition Groups controlled it.*
- *Dara'a Camp: - It is now almost 448 days without water and 70% of its buildings were demolished.*
- *Jermana, AL SaiedaZainab, Al Raml, Al Aedein Camps in Homs and Hamma: - A relatively quiet situation in light of the economic crises.*
- *Khan Al Sheih Camp: - Roads linking the camp to the city center are still closed except for Zakia- Khan Al Sheih road.*
