Lebanon

Under the slogan "Don't leave them alone" a number of activists launched a campaign on Facebook named "Rescue trapped youth between the borders of Syria and Lebanon" and that of Solidarity with the three Palestinian Syrian refugees stuck since 3 May in the neutral zone at the Lebanese-Syrian border.

The activists' solidarity with each of " Adham Maw'ad " , " Hossam Al Yateim " and " Mustafa Al Yateim " , three young men were among a group of nearly 49 Palestinian and Syrian refugees, were deported from Lebanon to Syria after being arrested by the Lebanese authorities on charges of having fake passports , while attempting to travel from " Rafik Hariri " airport in Beirut to Libya , but the three young men refused to return to Syria, fearing for their lives .

According to one of the activists" in the Campaign Rescue trapped youths between the borders of Syria and Lebanon" , he came for solidarity with the Palestinian Syrian refugees in Lebanon, in general, and the three young people stuck at the border , in particular, and against racism and arbitrary decisions taken by the Lebanese authorities against them.

Adding that the basic idea of the campaign pick the slogan "Don't leave them alone ," that the participants writes expressions of solidarity with the trapped youth and copy the paper and sent us so that we publish it , in order to raise their case to the public and international opinion and try to make their suffering and voices heard to the world.

For their part, the three young men strapped on the Lebanese-Syrian border appealed via a voice message to local, international and human rights organizations, the PLO and the Palestinian factions to interfere to put an end to their suffering.

Turkey

A sandstorm hit "Ferran Shaheir " camp yesterday, which sheltering Syrian and Palestinian refugees , near the Turkish-Syrian border , where winds tore most of the tents , lifting a number of wounded among the refugees.

Quoting by a refugee in the camp, "We are suffering from neglect and lack of services , especially medical, where we are forced to treat the wounded ourselves , and demand international and relief agencies to move quickly to put an end to this suffering . "

- "Tayseir Fayez Turkmen" (52 years) passed away by the poor medical care and lack of medicines as a result of the siege imposed on the Yarmouk refugee camp since about 320 days , respectively

Recent Updates in Syria

A state of tension and panic prevailed at Khan Al Sheih camp in Damascus city yesterday because of the explosive barrels and mortar shells which targeted areas surrounding the camp. The vicinity of the camp witnessed, almost daily, shelling and clashes often lead to banditry between the camp and the city center causing an out of many medical supplies and food in the camp.

On the other hand, a number of students of high school certificate got out of Yarmouk refugee camp yesterday to do the exams, and mentions that, earlier, a number of students of elementary school Certificate returned from Yarmouk refugee camp to their homes in the camp , after the completion of formal exams outside camp.



Civil Work Committees

"Palestine Charity Commission" equipped an ambulance for the Palestinian Red Crescent , in an attempt to compensate the shortage of medical services within the Yarmouk refugee camp , and in the same context the commission equipped tankers to transport drinking water to people's homes , especially with the beginning of summer and high temperatures .
