"Palestinian Refugee Killed as Syrian Gov't Renews Onslaughts on Daraa Camp"

Victims

Palestinian refugee Kasem AlZinghari, nicknamed Abu Mohamed AlMakdisi and sheltered in Daraa Camp, was killed on Wednesday, June 7, 2017, in an offensive launched by the US-led coalition forces on the site of ISIS-affiliated Khaled Ibn AlWalid battalion in Yarmouk Basin, West of Daraa.

The coalition fighter jets struck an ISIS-run court in Yarmouk Basin with eight missiles.

According to AGPS figures, 370 Palestinians sheltered in Daraa province were killed in the raging warfare.

Latest Developments

Palestinian refugee Hassan Khamis was pronounced dead after the Syrian government forces targeted Daraa Camp for Palestinian refugees and AlSadd Road, south of Syria, with dozens of surface-to-surface missiles and barrel bombs. Civilian homes sustained heavy material damage in the attack.

Over recent days, the humanitarian situation in southern Syria has taken a turn for the worse due to the simmering hostilities rocking Daraa Camp, AlSadd neighborhood, and AlMuzeireeb town.

Daraa residents continue to call on all concerned human rights and relief institutions to urgently work towards a cessation of hostilities in the area. They further urged UNRWA and the relief charities to provide civilians with much-needed medicines and emergency items.



70% of civilian buildings in Daraa have been totally or partially knocked down in the rampant warfare. Water supplies to the camp have also been cut off for over 1,153 consecutive days.

Meanwhile, the Syrian government forces tasked the political committee in southern Damascus to appoint delegates to speak up for the Palestinian refugee community south of Damascus during a projected round of talks with government representatives.

The calls were launched following a meeting between members of the political committee in southern Damascus and government envoys. Two Imams (mosque preachers) from Beit Sahem and Babila towns—Sheikh Abu Abdou AlHindi and Sheikh Anas AlTawil—were in attendance.

Civil Action Committees

The Palestine Charity Commission, in partnership with Tariq AlHayat Association, distributed 450 food baskets to Palestinian families in southern Damascus.



Hundreds of Palestinian families fled Yarmouk Camp to nearby towns after ISIS militias held sway over large areas of the camp in early April 2015.



Palestinians of Syria: June 9, 2017 Statistics:

- *At least 3,511 Palestinians, including 462 women, were killed in war-torn Syria.*
- *1,603 Palestinian refugees, including 99 women, are incarcerated in Syrian government lock-ups.*
- *Yarmouk refugee camp has been blockaded by the Syrian regime army and Popular Front for the Liberation of Palestine - General Command (PFLP-GC) for 1,418 days in a row.*
- *196 Palestinians died of undernourishment and medical neglect in the blockaded Yarmouk Camp.*
- *Water supplies cut off in Deraa and Yarmouk camps respectively for 1,153 and 1,004 days.*
- *Residents of Handarat Camp, in Aleppo, denied access to their homes for 1,497 days. Government battalions have been holding sway over the camp for more than 231 days.*
