"Syrian Regime Forces Prevent Palestinians from Travelling to Turkey and Tighten Procedures to them"

Recent Updates

The AGPS reporter in northern Syria confirmed that the Syrian army checkpoints tighten procedures of inspection and audit of the Palestinian refugees heading to the north of Syria.

According to our correspondent that the Syrian regime forces prevented a number of residents of Al Nairab in Aleppo, who decided to travel to Turkey in order to emigrate to European countries, from entry to areas control by the Syrian opposition.

He added that the regime forces forced everyone who holds Palestinian nationality to get out of the bus traveling to Turkey, while they allowed the passengers who hold Syrian nationality to follow their way.

The reporter pointed out that this incident is not the first of its kind where many incidents recorded of preventing any Palestinian from travelling to Turkey just because he holds a Palestinian citizenship, as many of them had been arrested for the same reason.

Meanwhile, Neirab camp in Aleppo suffers from the migration of Palestinian families and youth of camp as a result of the dire security and living conditions heading to Turkey and European countries. It was noted recently that a large number of youth have left the camp to Turkey trying to gain access to the European asylum countries.

Moreover, there are a large number of young people and families at Turkey waiting to reach the European mainland either legally or illegally due to the Syrian security services and Al Quds brigades prosecution to the Palestinian youth to force them to join the PLA, as well as the



security tightening on the youth movement in and outside the camp, and the arrest of the security services for many of them.

On the other hand, violent clashes broke out in the Yarmouk camp south of the Syrian capital Damascus today morning between Palestinian armed groups and ISIS alongside with Nusra Front. The clashes were concentrated at Rija square and the Court area, while ISIS still imposes control over about 60% of neighborhoods and lanes Yarmouk.

In the same context, a number of besieged residents had land reclamation "Shaker Stadium" behind Al Waseem project for agriculture, where they secured water watered the land after plowing it with primitive means, and spraying the available hoping to fill some of the agricultural materials needed for food.

It was mentioned that the Yarmouk camp is besiege by the Syrian army and the PFGC groups for 712 days respectively, while power is cut for more than 782 days, and water cut for 272 days respectively, while the siege victims' toll has reached 176 victims.



In Damascus suburb, Zakia-Khan Al Shieh road, which is the only road that connects the camp with the Syrian capital, is still poses a real threat to the residents of the camp, because of continued exposure to shelling and targeting with machine guns, shells, and snipers.

On May 14, 2015, the Syrian regime forces targeted a civilian car was carrying a number of refugees, during their passage through the way of death, which resulted in at least five victims including the young woman "Falasteen," her brother "Mohammed Said Fayez Saleh," their mother "Khalidiya Fayez Zahir," and the driver accompanying them, "Khaled Ramly, "in addition to a number of casualties,

Moreover, many residents of the camp were arrested by the Syrian regime checkpoints in Artoz and Khan Al Shieh entrance.

It is noteworthy that all people of the camp are forced to take the path of "Zakya- Khan Al Shieh" despite its risk due to the continuous closure of all roads linking the camp and the capital Damascus.

In a different context, Syrian security services continue arresting each of the two Palestinian women "Shamsa Rashdan," 56 years and her daughter "Asia Qwaide,r" 16 years from Yarmouk. The two women were arrested two years ago, and there is news of their presence in one of the security branches in Damascus.

The AGPS has documented the names of 36 Palestinian detained Women in Syrian prisons, while the total toll of Palestinian detainees, which documented by the AGPS has reached (883) detainees, and (398) victims died due to torture in Syrian prisons.

Statistics

The AGPS documented statistics, "actionpal.org.uk," indicated that bombing is the first cause that led to deaths in the Palestinian refugees in Syria, where it has resulted in the death of 1006 victims, while armed clashes in second place caused the death of (616) victims.

The torture to death in the Syrian jails comes in the third place , as the AGPS documented (397) names of Palestinian refugees who died due to torture in the Syrian regime's prisons, while 276 refugees died due to sniping, and (177) have died because of siege, starvation, and lack of medical care.

The total number of Palestinian victims, who were documented by the AGPS has reached 2881 victims were documented by name, place, and cause of death.

Numbers and Statistics till 9/6/2015

- *80,000 Palestinian refugees escaped from Syria, including 10,687 refugees in Jordan, 51300 refugees in Lebanon, and 6,000 refugees in Egypt, according to the UNRWA's statistics till February 2015.*
- *At least 27933 Palestinian Syrian refugees have reached Europe during the last 4 years.*
- *The number of Palestinian detainees who were documented by the AGPS has reached 883 detainees, and 398 victims were killed due to torture in the Syrian prisons.*
- *The Yarmouk Camp: - Siege, imposed by the Regular Army and PFGC, continued for 712 days respectively. In addition, power cuts*

continued for more than 782 days, water was cut for 272 days respectively. The number of victims due to the siege has reached to 176 victims.

- *Al Husayneyya Camp: - Regular Army is still preventing the residents of the camp to return back to their houses for 593 days respectively.*
- *Al Sbeina Camp: - Regular Army is still preventing the residents of the camp to return back to their houses for 574 days respectively.*
- *Handarat Camp: - Residents have left the camp for 776 days after the Syrian Opposition Groups controlled it.*
- *Dara'a Camp: - It is now almost 419 days without water and 70% of its buildings were demolished.*
- *Jermana, AL Saieda ZAINAB, Al Raml, Al Aedein Camps in Homs and Hamma: - A relatively quiet situation in light of the economic crises.*
- *Khan Al Sheih Camp: - Roads linking the camp to the city center are still closed except for Zakia- Khan Al Sheih road.*
