Victims

Mohammed Hassan Methqal Al Qadeya, 22 years, and Mohammed Saleh Saleh, 24 Years, from Khan Al Sheih camp were killed by fire shootings from the Free Army.

The Action Group for Palestinians of Syria announced that the number of Palestinians of Syria victims, who were killed in Khan Al Sheih camp, is 74 due to the conflict in Syria till the end of May 2014, According to statistics that were published earlier.

Recent Updates

Al Muzareeb town in Dara'a governorate was exposed to bombings with explosive barrels which resulted in 4 victims and a number of wounded. It is mentioned that 8500 Palestinian refugees live in AL Muzareeb. On 9th of February 2014, warplanes thrown explosive barrels on Al Muzareeb town near Turaan UNRWA School, which resulted in 40 injured students and four injured of school employees.



On 18th of February 2014, a horrible massacre was committed in Al Muzareeb compound, where Ain Al Zaytoun UNRWA School and its UNRWA clinic were targeted with explosive barrels while students were inside the school. The bombing resulted in 15 Palestinian victims. On 27th of April 2014, a school yard in Al Muzareeb was targeted with explosive barrels which resulted in some injuries most of them were children.

In the same context, Dara'a camp for Palestinian refugees, in the southern of Syria, was exposed to bombings with explosive barrels which resulted in a huge damage in people's houses. It is mentioned that the camp was exposed to frequent bombings with mortar and canon shells which resulted in the damage of big parts of the camp in addition to the fled of hundreds of families to the surrounding areas.

In Khan Al Sheih camp in Damascus city, a state of anger prevailed amongst the residents because some armed groups from the Free Army fired shootings on the residents of the camp which resulted in two victims, they are Mohammed Al Qdeya and Mohamed Saleh, and a number of injured, Esam Husine and Ali Hamada were known amongst the injured



people. A number of activists and dignitaries are calling the Free Army to punish the fire shooters and judging them and not to involve the camp in the conflict in Syria. They also insured that the camp contains unarmed civilian people so they call all parties to distance the camp from the conflict in Syria.

Khan Al Shieh camp witnessed warplanes hovering coincided with targeting the surrounding areas with explosive barrels. On the living side, the residents of the camp suffer of a strict siege that is imposed by the regular army of its entrances and exits. The residents also complain of the power and telecommunications cut for long hours.

On the other hand, the UNRWA distributed, yesterday, limited amount of aid to the Palestinian refugees in Yarmouk camp at Damascus, who are trapped for about a year.

The initiative of breaking the Yarmouk siege, which was signed since more than two weeks between Syrian Authorities and a number of civil committees with military brigades inside the camp, is still not implemented. This initiative witnesses a state of deadlock because the refusal of some armed groups to withdraw to outside the Yarmouk borders.

A solidarity march with Gaza strip came out from Yarmouk camp, yesterday, 9-7-2014, condemning the Israeli savage aggression in the strip, which led to the death of dozens of Palestinians and a number of wounded and injuries.

On the humanitarian side, people of Yarmouk suffer of lack of food supplies because of the siege imposed by Regular Army and members of PFLP -General Command which caused a humanitarian disaster led to the death of 151 people because of the lack of nutrition and medical care.

in addition to the continuation of power outage several months ago and the difficulty of getting safe drinking water, what caused a number of infections with diseases as a result of drinking unsafe water.

In the same context, sporadic clashes broke out in the vicinity of Khan Dannoun camp between groups of the Free Army and Regular Army at Al Tayba town square coincided with bombing on surrounding areas.

Meanwhile, a state of fear and panic prevailed between the residents of Al Aedein camp in Homs, yesterday, as a result of warplanes break the sound barrier of the camp. Coincided with heavy explosion sounds resulted in the bombing of surrounding areas.

Thus, residents of the camp still suffer of raised prices, the lack of food supplies and the spread of unemployment due to the deterioration of the economic situation.

Missing

The Action Group for Palestinians of Syria announced that the number of the missing Palestinian refugees has reached 245 people until the end of last May, including 155 from Yarmouk camp and 19 from Khan AL Sheih.
