### ***Recent Updates***

*Media sources, close to the PLA, reported news about the killing and wounding dozens of PLA members at Tal Kurdi area near the central prison in Adra, where the region is witnessing violent clashes.*

*The AGPS documented "142" PLA victims; most of them died during clashes in different parts of Damascus.*

*It is noteworthy that military service is mandatory for Palestinian refugees in Syria, forcing many young people, who refuse to perform military service during the war in Syria, to travel to neighboring countries.*

*On the other hand, shelling targeted different parts of the Yarmouk camp, and resulted in casualties among civilians, coincided with violent clashes on several axes between the Syrian army alongside groups loyal to it and ISIS alongside Al-Nusra Front.*

*In terms of living aspect, the remained residents are living tragic situations as a result of lack of food and water and the continuous power cuts for more than two years.*

*In Damascus suburb, Jaramana residents are still suffering from worsening economic crises, especially homes rent, high rates of unemployment, and the increase in demand, prompting them to live in stifling conditions.*

*This suffering accompanied with decreasing aid provided by UNRWA and charitable bodies, which cover only a little part of their costs.*

*In the meantime, one of the Syrian opposition groups detains the 18-year-Palestinian young man, "Mohammed Mahdi Naji" from Nairab camp. He was arrested by members of "Ahrar al-Sham" group in the town of Sermin in Idlib suburb while heading to Turkey, while reasons of detentions are not clear yet.*

*It is noteworthy that many residents of Neirab camp and other camps have been arrested by armed opposition groups on charges of cooperation and work alongside the pro-Regime armed groups.*

### **Hungary**

*Hungarian authorities detain a group of Palestinian and Syrian families on the border with Serbia three days ago. The Hungarian authorities informed them that they will be deported to a refugee camp, and they will be forced to fingerprints, so as to force them to provide asylum in Hungary.*



*It is noteworthy that thousands of Palestinian and Syrian refugees are crossing from Greece to Macedonia all the way to Hungary in order to reach the European asylum countries, but the Hungarian authorities force those detained to put their fingerprints, which deprives them to live with their families in the European countries of asylum, according to Dublin's decision to fingerprint, and which decides to return refugees to countries where their fingerprints were taken, with exceptions in the application of that item in some European countries.*



### ***Turkey***

*Turkish Assembly "Fidar" for solidarity with Palestine in Turkey announced its readiness to launch and implement 'Bahjat Al Aed' project by producing food basket and Eid clothing, in an attempt to bring joy and happiness to the hearts of the children of Palestine in the besieged Gaza Strip, and the refugee camps in Syria.*

*Vidar called on institutions and individuals to contribute to the project and to mitigate the impact of the blockade imposed on the people of the*



*Gaza Strip, as well as the painful reality experienced by the children of Palestine in Syria and Turkey camps.*

### ***Statistics***

*The AGPS monitoring and documentation team documented the names of 11 Palestinian refugees who died in Daraa south of Syria, including 6 refugees died in the town of Muzeireeb and five refugees died in Daraa camp because of the ongoing conflict in Syria; the victims are:*

- *The young man, "Mohammed Ibrahim Hosan" from Daraa camp, died on 08/10/2015 during clashes that broke out in Daraa between the Syrian armed opposition forces and the regular army. Ibrahim is fighting alongside the Syrian opposition Brigades in Daraa.*
- *The Palestinian refugee, "Hamid Nassif Almisawi" 70 years, his wife "Azra Almisawi" 65 years, and "Khalida Kamal Ibrahim," who died on 08.11.2015 by the bombing of Muzeireeb compound in Daraa with explosive barrels.*
- *The young Palestinian, "Ahmed Mwafaq Sersawi" 18-year-old died during his participation in the fighting ranks of the armed opposition and the ongoing battle against the Syrian army "Southern Storm"*
- *The Palestinian refugee "Ihab Ahmed Mezal" died on 08.12.2015, during his participation in the fighting ranks of the armed opposition groups, after they tried to storm Alhubuob barracks of*

*the Syrian army in Daraa within the so-called battle "South Storm."*

- *On 08/15/2015 the 3-year- Palestinian girl, Elaf Ammar Nassif, and her mother Aisha al-Sharif, 35 years, died due to wounds they attained following the shelling that targeted the town of Muzeireeb. The Palestinian young man Samer Yahya Sary, 40 years, died in the same bombing.*
- *The Palestinian media activist Tariq Ziad Khader, 29 years, from Daraa camp, died due to shelling; he is a correspondent for one of the armed opposition groups media organizations, and activist of human rights. He is originally from the village of Ain Ghazal at the city of Haifa in Palestine.*
- *The young man "Iyad Alsrouje" from Muzeireeb town died on 08.16.2015 during clashes in the city of Daraa southern Syria; he was fighting alongside the Syrian opposition groups.*
- *On 8/25/2015, the Palestinian refugee "Saeed Mohammed Rashaida," a Fatah official in Daraa camp, died due to torture in the prisons of the Syrian regime after being detained for more than two years.*

### ***Numbers and Statistics till 9/9/2015***

- *15,500 Palestinian Syrian refugees in Jordan, 45,000 Palestinian Syrian refugees in Lebanon, and 6,000 refugees in Egypt, according to the UNRWA's statistics till July 2015.*

- *At least 36,000 Palestinian Syrian refugees have reached Europe during the last 4 years.*
- *The Yarmouk Camp: - Siege, imposed by the Regular Army and PFGC, continued for 799 days respectively. In addition, power cuts continued for more than 869 days, water was cut for 359 days respectively. The number of victims due to the siege has reached to 180 victims.*
- *Al Sbeina Camp: - Regular Army is still preventing the residents of the camp to return back to their houses for 661 days respectively.*
- *Handarat Camp: - Residents have left the camp for 862 days after the Syrian Opposition Groups controlled it.*
- *Dara'a Camp: - It is now almost 506 days without water and 70% of its buildings were demolished.*
- *Jarmana, AL Saieda ZAinab, Al Raml, Al Aedein Camps in Homs and Hamma: - A relatively quiet situation in light of the economic crises.*
- *Khan Al Sheih Camp: - Roads linking the camp to the city center are still closed except for Zakia- Khan Al Shieh road.*
