"For 5th Day Running, Syrian Gov't Forces Strike Daraa Camp with Missiles, Barrel Bombs"



- **Palestinian Minor Killed While Fighting alongside Syrian Gov't Troops**
- **Situation in Daraa, Yarmouk Camps Exacerbated by Water Crisis**

Victims

15-year-old Palestinian minor Ibrahim Mahmoud Mi'ari was pronounced dead after he was forced by the pro-government Liwa AlQuds battalion to join bloody confrontations against the opposition outfits.



Around 500 fighters, out of 3,500 fighters enlisted at the non-Palestinian Liwa AlQuds brigade, have been identified as Palestinians who previously sought refuge in such shelters as AlNeirab, Handarat, and AlRaml. Fighters from Aleppo city and its northern and western suburbs, along with so-called Shabah AlAswad combatants, have also been fighting alongside the AlNeirab-headquartered battalion.

Latest Developments

Reporting from southern Damascus, AGPS news reporter said the Syrian government forces renewed onslaughts on Daraa Camp and AlSadd Road using barrel bombs and missiles.

The government fighter jets struck Daraa and AlSadd neighborhood at the crack of dawn, before they showered the area with surface-to-surface



missiles and barrel bombs. The assault resulted in heavy material damage.

Recently, clashes have flared up in the area between the opposition outfits and the government forces as the latter has been ceaselessly striving to creep into Daraa Camp.



Meanwhile, residents of Yarmouk and Daraa camps have launched cries for help over the acute water crisis, saying they have been forced to drink water spouting from contaminated artesian wells.

Speaking with AGPS, experts warned of the life-threatening diseases and kidney disorders inflicted by the unhygienic artesian wells due to the germ-infested deposits and the absence of water-disinfection endeavors.

The Syrian government has cut off water supplies to Yarmouk Camp for over 1,005 days running and to Daraa Camp for over 1,154 consecutive days.



Palestinians of Syria: June 10, 2017 Statistics:

- *At least 3,511 Palestinians, including 462 women, were killed in war-torn Syria.*
- *1,603 Palestinian refugees, including 99 women, are incarcerated in Syrian government lock-ups.*
- *Yarmouk refugee camp has been blockaded by the Syrian regime army and Popular Front for the Liberation of Palestine - General Command (PFLP-GC) for 1,419 days in a row.*
- *196 Palestinians died of undernourishment and medical neglect in the blockaded Yarmouk Camp.*
- *Water supplies cut off in Deraa and Yarmouk camps respectively for 1,154 and 1,005 days.*
- *Residents of Handarat Camp, in Aleppo, denied access to their homes for 1,498 days. Government battalions have been holding sway over the camp for more than 232 days.*
- *Nearly 85,000 Palestinian Syrian refugees fled to Europe until the end of 2016.*
- *31,000 Palestinians from Syria are housed in Lebanon.*
- *17,000 Palestinians from Syria are taking refuge in Jordan.*
- *6,000 Palestinian-Syrian refugees are sheltered in Egypt.*
- *8,000 Palestinian-Syrian refugees are taking shelter in Turkey.*
- *1,000 Palestinian-Syrian refugees are sheltered in the blockaded Gaza Strip.*
