“Bombing on Daraa Camp Southern Syria, Yarmouk Camp in Damascus and the Vicinity of Khan AL Sheih Camp in Damascus City”



Daraa Camp

- A Palestinian refugee was killed in Syria, raising the death total toll of Palestinian Syrian victims to 2511.
- The water cut in the Yarmouk camp for the second month and the aids distribution resumed.
- The residents of Jermana Camp between the security tension and the high cost of house rents.
- The road of Zakia- Khan AL Sheih is the only road that remains for the residents, despite its danger.

Victims

The young man Fawaz Al Naimi was killed due to the heavy bombing that targeted Daraa camp for Palestinian refugees southern Syria, which raised the death total toll of Palestinian Syrian victims to 2511 victims, which was documented by the documentation team of the Action Group for Palestinians of Syria.

Recent Updates

Heavy shelling targeted Daraa Camp for Palestinian refugees southern Syria which resulted in the death of the young man "Fawaz AL Naimi" in addition to the massive destruction in civilian houses. Meanwhile, the southern region witnessed clashes and acts of heavy shelling sharply increased during the past few days. In the same context, the camp suffers from an acute shortage of medical and basic services because of the destruction of large areas of it, in addition to the massive destruction of infrastructure because of the heavy shelling of the camp and the surrounding areas during the past months.

People of the camp are complaining about the non-arrival of relief aid, especially "UNRWA" aid in addition to the foodstuffs because of the permanent tense situation, prompting many families to flee to the neighboring areas and villages.

In a related context, the bombardment renewed yesterday in the Yarmouk camp for Palestinian refugees in Damascus, where different parts of it were targeted with a number of shells, causing material damage to properties.

The water cut has entered its second month amid the aggravation of livelihood crises due to the continuation of the siege imposed by the Regular Army and groups of the PFGC, in light of power cut which exacerbating health and living problems. In a related context, a limited quantities of food aid were distributed yesterday to the people who are trapped for more than 15 months, while clashes broke out at dawn yesterday between the Regular Army alongside with groups of the Popular Front with groups affiliated to the opposition, followed by sounds of explosions turned out to be caused by the bombing of the camp with missiles.



Yarmouk camp

In Damascus city, Jermana camp receives hundreds of Palestinian families who were displaced from their camps because of the siege, bombing and clashes, while the camp became so crowded which led to the high price of houses rent. The suffering of people increased of high cost of living and the high rate of unemployment in light of the security tension and the frequent bombing and clashes on the surrounding neighborhoods and the widely spread of checkpoints and the restrictions of the resident's movement from and to the camp.



Jermana camp



Khan Al Sheih camp residents are suffering of the continuous cut of the roads that connect the camp with the city center because of the clashes and the frequent bombing that the surrounding areas witness. The roads cut prompted the residents to go through Zakia road despite its danger because it is exposed to bombing and sniping frequently but the residents are obliged to go through Zakia road to secure their basic needs or going to the capital for cure.

On the other hand, sounds of heavy explosions were heard in the camp, turned out to be resulted in the bombing of the surrounding areas with several shells, while some shrapnel reached the camp which spread a horror and worry state amongst the residents especially in light of the frequent targeting of the camp and the surrounding areas during the few last days.
