"On Eve of Human Rights Day: 3,403 Palestinian Refugees Killed in War-Torn Syria, over 1,134 Held in Jails"

Latest Developments

On the eve of the Human Rights Day, marked annually on December 10, AGPS raises alarm bells over the serious violations, often amounting to war crimes, perpetrated against the Palestinian of Syria.

Since the group's founding in 2012, AGPS monitored several cases of human rights infringements in beset Syria.



AGPS kept record of the death of 3,403 Palestinians due to war-related incidents in Syria. Shelling topped the list with 1,128 casualties. 818 refugees were fatally gunned down while 456 refugees, including 35 girls and women, were tortured to death in Syrian lock-ups.



Meanwhile, 1,134 Palestinians, including 80 female refugees, have been locked up in Syrian jails.

The detainees' families have frequently appealed to the Syrian government forces to disclose the fate of their jailed relatives. However, most of their cries for help have gone unheeded.

The detainees have also been subjected to dire detention circumstances and harsh psycho-physical torture. Most of the prisoners have been bereaved of their right to a fair and public trial.

In another development, over the past couple of days, the Syrian regime tanks struck the Deraa Camp for Palestinian refugees in southern Syria with a round of shells, ruining civilian homes.

Another air strike targeted a number of residential neighborhoods housing Palestinian refugees in Deraa Al-Balad town, sparking panic among children and women.

Residents of Deraa Camp have sounded distress signals over the lack of medical treatment and relief assistance. Unabated shelling on the camp took away the lives of dozens of civilians and turned 70% of residential buildings to rubble.

At the same time, reporting from Rural Damascus, AGPS field correspondent said the government battalions notified the local reconciliation committee of their intent to carry out a large-scale search campaign against civilian homes at Khan Al-Sheih Camp.

The move comes at a time when troops from the Palestine Liberation Army (PLA) have imposed a tight military cordon in and around the



camp and grabbed hold of a civilian home in favor of military use. Other pro-government outfits have turned civilian homes in the camp into military barracks.

Civil Actions Committee

A fundraising campaign was launched by the European Al-Wafaa Campaign so as to secure \$ 3,500 for the treatment of the Palestinian refugee Omar Moussa, 31, after Lebanese hospitals refused to treat him for free.

A few days earlier, Omar's mother launched calls from the Lebanese region of Bsaba to mobilize support for her son. She appealed to the Palestine Liberation Organization and Palestinian factions in Lebanon, along with the concerned charities, to rally round Omar, who was critically wounded in a motorbike crash last month.

Palestinians of Syria: December 10, 2016 Statistics:

- *There are 15,500 Palestinian-Syrian refugees in Jordan.*
- *42,500 Palestinian-Syrian refugees are in Lebanon.*
- *6,000 Palestinian-Syrian refugees are sheltered in Egypt, according to UNRWA figures covering the period from July 2015 backwards.*
- *8,000 Palestinian-Syrian refugees are taking shelter in Turkey.*
- *1,000 Palestinian-Syrian refugees reside in the blockaded Gaza Strip.*
- *Over 79,000 Palestinian Syrian refugees fled to Europe until mid 2016.*
- *Yarmouk refugee camp has been blockaded by the Syrian regime army and Popular Front for the Liberation of Palestine - General Command (PFLP-GC) for 1,271 days in a row. Electricity and water supplies have been cut off, respectively, for 1,330 days and 791 days. The number of those killed due to the blockade has hit 191.*

- *Sbiena refugee camp: Refugees could not go back to their homes as a result of the blockade slapped by the Syrian regime forces since 1,124 days running.*
- *Handarat refugee camp: All refugees left the camp since 1,316 days after opposition outfits grabbed hold of the area.*
- *Deraa refugee camp: Water has been cut off for 974 consecutive days while 70% of its buildings have been knocked down.*
- *Homs camp, Hama camp, Jaramana camp, al-Sayda Zeinab camp, Al-Raml camp: A of State of relative calm has been reported in the abovementioned areas. However, economic crises have been on the rise.*
