Sri Lanka

The story of the Palestinian Syrian refugee "Tariq Ouda" is one of hundreds stories suffered by the Palestinian refugee due to the war in Syria. Tariq had to escape to the four corners of the earth in search of safety and security similarly as to the other Palestinian refugees.

Thailand was his destination and station where he found stability and security; he lived there for three years and seven months without any problems, only those related to housing and accommodation, but he embraced this temporary life until he faced the problem of his passport that was washed in the washing machine by mistake.

However, he went to the Syrian consulate in Thailand in order to grant a new travel document, but the Syrian consul refused as he remained without a document proving his personal identity, which would expose him to the prosecution and deportation, especially for the fact that he has no "Visa" for about two years and a half.

Tariq decided to leave Thailand and travel illegally with a false passport; his trip started through Thailand, Cambodia, and Indonesia that arrived in Sri Lanka Colombo, as he was detained by airport security in transit.

In a letter received by the AGPS, Tariq confirmed the news of his detention for five days in Sri Lanka airport without food or water or bathroom, and pointed out that he does not know when he will be



released. He said: "Whenever I ask them about the date of my release, they tell me a new story, the last thing I knew that they will deport me to Jakarta," he added, if I already was deported to that country, I certainly would go to prison because I entered Jakarta with false passport.

Accordingly, the Palestinian refugee "Tariq Ouda" launched a distress call and an appeal to the Palestinian Liberation Organization, the human rights organizations, and the international organizations to intervene to solve his problem and to get him out of his crisis.

Victims

The Palestinian girl "Israa Ghazi Sors" was also died in 4th of March while she was heading to her UNRWA school, "Fatimia" in Sayeda Zeinab. It is mentioned that the young girl is from Husseneia camp in Damascus suburb.

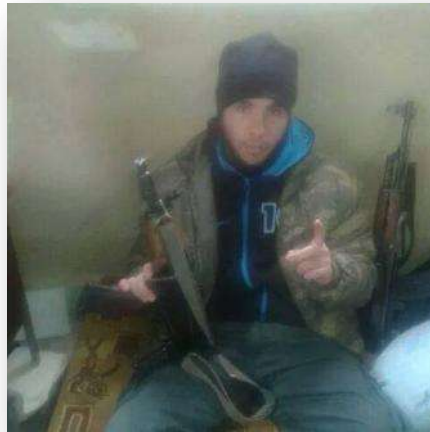
Four victims died because of the continued war in Syria, including a young girl from Husseneia camp; they are: the Palestinian refugee "Tariq Khalid Ali" who died after being shot directly by an armed group inside the Yarmouk camp after refusing to open his home to the gunmen and snipers to be spread on the surface of his building, so the gunmen broke into the house and killed him.



This came during the violent clashes that broke out between Al Nusra Front and Aknaf Bait Al Maqdis brigades in the Yarmouk refugee camp, after the assassination of a member of Aknaf Bait Al Maqdis by Al Nusra front.

The Palestinian refugee "Marwan Wajeih Al Khatib" died in a hospital in Damascus after he left the Yarmouk camp for treatment.

Meanwhile, the young man "Oubada Yousif Dahoudi" (20 years) from Al Nairab camp in Aleppo was also killed in the clashes that broke out on Handarat area in Aleppo between the armed groups affiliated to the Syrian opposition and the regular army alongside with the Palestinian al-Quds Brigade, it should be noted that " Dahoudi" is a member of Al Nusra Front.

Recent Updates

Dozens of Palestinian refugees from Husseneia camp gathered on the borders of Husseneia area hoping to return to their camp and their homes, after the entry of a delegation from the UNRWA and the General Authority for Palestinian Arab refugees to inspect UNRWA installations in the camp and to see the progress of the restoration and maintenance of those facilities.

After the completion of the exploratory round, the Commissioner-General of UNRWA delivered a speech at the Women Center in the camp in which



he stressed the need for the return of residents to camp in order to alleviate their suffering. He also stressed the UNRWA's continuing reform and rehabilitation process for the facilities that were damaged, as he also expressed the readiness of the agency to carry out its humanity responsibilities towards the Palestinians of Syria.

For their part, some residents who were able to enter the camp with the UNRWA delegation asked many questions about the date of their return to their homes and how, as they demanded to return as soon as possible, but it was not a specific date for their awaited return since they were abandoned and displaced from the camp of about 514 days respectively. The Syrian regime forces evacuated the camp and closed it.

In the same context, the Deputy Governor of Damascus suburb, Mr. "RatibAdas" has determined, in his speech at Husseinia camp, the approaching return of people to their homes over the next ten days, he added that the directions and the mechanisms will be determined to start the return process.

It should be noted that the Syrian regular army had entered Husseneia camp supported by members of Fatah al-Intifada and the Struggle Front in October 2013, as they evacuated the camp of all its residents. Till now there are about (42000) Palestinian refugees and (3000) Syrians from Husseneia camp are still displaced outside the camp.



In the meantime, shelling targeted the Yarmouk refugee camp south of Damascus with rocket and mortar shells, provoking a wave of panic and fear among civilians, especially children, while our correspondent from inside the camp confirmed the death of six fighters from the armed opposition groups, including Al-Nusra Front.

This came after targeting the headquarters of the Front in Al Orouba area adjacent to the stadium area in the camp, as violent clashes broke out in Al Thalathein Street between the Syrian army alongside with the Palestinian groups and the armed opposition groups.

In the meantime, people of the Yarmouk refugee camp were gathered yesterday to the new point of distributing food aid in Palestine Street, where the (UNRWA) distributed a limited amount of food baskets on the Yarmouk people who suffer from the continuation of the siege imposed on them by the regular army and the PFGC for about (612) days respectively, also they complain of the continued power cut for more than 692 days, and water for 182 days.

In Aleppo, the Palestinian refugee "Ghassan Ismail Bash" was shot in his foot in Al Nairab Camp due to the random fire by a member of Al-Quds Brigade Group. It is noteworthy that many of Al Neirab residents were injured by random shooting at events and weddings and during the funeral of the victims of al-Quds Brigade Group.

Al Quds Brigade is considered one of the pro-Syrian regime groups, and fighting alongside the Syrian army in the war against the Syrian opposition; its fighters are spread in Neirab and Handarat camps in Aleppo and Al Raml camp in Lathakia, while 200 of its members died during the events of the war in Syria.

On the other hand, the residents of Khan Al Shieh camp in Damascus suburb suffer of great difficulties regarding the entry of ration materials and fuel as a result of the continued closure of the connecting roads between the camp and the surrounding areas due to the military operations taking place in those areas, which resulted in the high prices of food supplies and the loss of many of it. They also complain of water cut caused by power cut for long periods.

In the same context, a state of relative calm prevailed Al SAYeda Zainab camp, but the residents is suffering from stressful living crises, most



notably is the lack of food, medical, and heating supplies, as well as the continuation of power and telecommunications cut. Meanwhile, violent clashes were heard yesterday evening in the vicinity of the camp caused by the bombing that targeted its neighboring areas.

Germany

The Palestinian artist "Mohammed Al-Saadi" won the first price in the competition of Bank Hbar cup, which was held in the German city of Frankfurt.

Al-Saadi excelled among about 50 artists from Arab and European countries; he is 26 years old, from the besieged camp of Yarmouk, as he has arrived in Germany for nearly five months.



Numbers and Statistics till 10/3/2015

- *At least 27933 Palestinian Syrian refugees have reached Europe during the last 4 years.*
- *2685 Palestinian victims were documented by the AGPS.*
- ***The Yarmouk Camp:** - Siege, imposed by the Regular Army and PFGC, continued for 612 days respectively. In addition, power cuts continued for more than 692 days, water was cut for 182 days respectively. The number of victims due to the siege has reached to 172 victims.*

- *80,000* Palestinian Syrian refugees escaped from Syria to the neighboring towns, including *10,687* refugees in Jordan, *51,300* in Lebanon and *6,000* refugees in Egypt, according to UNRWA statistics till February 2015.
- **Al Husayneyya Camp:** - Regular Army is still preventing the residents of the camp to return back to their houses for **514** days respectively.
- **Al Sbeina Camp:** - Regular Army is still preventing the residents of the camp to return back to their houses for **483** days respectively.
- **Handarat Camp:** - Residents have left the camp for **685** days after the Syrian Opposition Groups controlled it.
- **Dara'a Camp:** - It is now almost **329** days without water and **70%** of its buildings were demolished.
- **Jermana, AL SaiedaZainab, Al Raml, Al Aedein Camps in Homs and Hamma:** - A relatively quiet situation in light of the economic crises.
- **Khan Al Sheih Camp:** - Roads linking the camp to the city center are still closed except for Zakia- Khan Al Sheih road.
