Victims

Palestinian refugee Mohamed Ghazawi, a resident of Yarmouk Camp, was shot and killed by a gendarme as he attempted to enter the Turkish territories, fleeing war-torn Syria.



AGPS documented the death of 3,477 Palestinians from Syria due to war-related incidents.

The Turkish authorities have opted for a closed-door immigration policy, banning Palestinians from Syria from entering Turkey.

Latest Developments

An agreement reportedly struck between Tahrir AlSham Commission in Yarmouk and the Syrian government stipulated that the former forfeit its strongholds and retreat to Idlib. No official sources have confirmed the piece of news yet.

In early April 2015, ISIS militias held sway over large parts of Yarmouk Camp in cooperation with Tahrir AlSham battalion (formerly known as AlNusra Front).



In another development, the Syrian fighter jets struck on Tuesday morning AlMenshiya neighborhood, housing dozens of Palestinian families in Daraa AlBalad.

At the same time, simmering clashes between the pro-regime forces and the anti-government outfits, including Tahrir AlSham, have rocked the area.

The Syrian government army has stepped up military offensives on opposition-led zones in southern Syria.





Meanwhile, a number of civilians were left injured on Monday in a deadly assassination attempt that took away the life of the commander of the Maghawir AlJawalan battalion, Muthana Ajaj AlSa'di. The shooting attack, carried out from a Kia Rio car driven by anonymous gunmen, left 35-year-old Ibrahim Ahmed Saleh, from AlSeiteriya family, among other civilians in AlMuezireeb, wounded.

Palestinians of Syria: April 11, 2017 Statistics:

- *At least 3,476 Palestinians, including 455 women, were killed in war-torn Syria.*
- *1,183 Palestinian refugees, including 86 women, are incarcerated in Syrian government lock-ups.*
- *Yarmouk refugee camp has been blockaded by the Syrian regime army and Popular Front for the Liberation of Palestine - General Command (PFLP-GC) for 1,363 days in a row.*
- *195 Palestinians died of undernourishment and medical neglect in the blockaded Yarmouk Camp.*
- *Water supplies cut off in Deraa and Yarmouk camps respectively for 1,094 and 945 days.*
- *Residents of Handarat Camp, in Aleppo, denied access to their homes for 1,438 days. Government battalions have been holding sway over the camp for more than 172 days.*
- *Nearly 85,000 Palestinian Syrian refugees fled to Europe until mid 2016.*
- *31,000 Palestinians from Syria are housed in Lebanon.*
