### "Five Refugees Died Due to Siege, Sniping and Illness Including a Girl and an Old Man"

## Victims

The old man **Talib Ali Abu Khalifa** died due to malnutrition and the lack of medical care due to the siege imposed on Yarmok camp for more than 801 days, which raises the siege victims' toll to 181 victims who died due to hunger and the lack of medical care, according to AGPS documentary statistics.

**Majd Al Dein Adel Mousa** from Al Husayneyya camp and Ahmed Fathi Ahmed from the PLA army died due to the clashes with the Opposition forces in Tal Kurdi area at Adra area in Damascus suburb, which raises the number of the PLA victims to 145 victims , according to the monitoring and documentation team at AGPS.

The Palestinian refugee **Essam Ezzildein Qaddoura** from Yarmouk camp died due to sniping while he was returning back from his work at Adra town in Damascus suburb.

The Palestinian female child **Reham Mohammed Kanbry** 9 years from Handarat camp for Palestinian refugees at Aleppo died at Tal Refat city in Turkey due to illness which lasts for 4 years because she was exposed to an electric shock.



### Recent Updates

Mass media sources reported that ISIS seized an ambulance car for the Charity Commission for Palestine People Relief in besieged Yarmouk and took it to its headquarter at Al Hajar Al Aswad area adjacent to the camp.

The Media reported that Al Nusra front interfered to return back the ambulance to the camp but ISIS refused and considered that the ambulance is for the Islamic Jihad Movement and its right to have it. It is mentioned that the ambulance was stolen by ISIS which is the



only ambulance in the camp that is used to carry wounded and injured people during the bombing to the Yarmouk medical center or to the field hospital at Yelda.



On Thursday-Friday night , violent clashes broke out at several fighting axes in Yarmouk which centralized on the beginning of the camp and Palestine street between ISIS alongside Al Nusra front against the Regular Army and the Palestinian factions, coincided with targeting the camp with several missiles on separate areas of the camp without any casualties. It is worthy to mention that the Regular Army and the PFGC are imposing a strict siege on the camp for more than 801 days. The siege led to the increase of the bad of health and living situations which already increased after the incursion of ISIS since the beginning of April 2015.

In a different context, Al Sad neighborhood at Der'aa city south of Syria was exposed to violent bombing with heavy rocket called Elephant Rockets which led to dozens of victims including children, according to activists. It is referred that Der'aa camp and Al Sad





neighborhood are exposed to frequent bombing by the Syrian regime which led to dozens of victims and wounded people during the last period.



It is mentioned that the AGPS documented the death of 317 Palestinian Syrian refugees at least at Der'aa governorate.

On the other hand, an unknown armed group kidnapped the UNRWA south area director Mr. Jamal Al Rawi 57 years from Al Muzareeb compound. He was kidnaped while returning back from his work at Da'el town to Al Muzareeb and it is noted that he is an English language teacher.

### **Turkey**

The relatives of the Palestinian refugee Yasin Mohammed Mefleh appealed the Turkish authorities to release their detained son from Izmir prison since a week. AGPS received a letter from the father of the detained refugee that his son is detained without reasons though he has all documents which prove that he is Palestinian Syrian. The Family of the detained refugee appealed Palestine Embassy to immediately interfere to release their detained son.



### **Numbers and Statistics till 11/9/2015:-**

- 15,500 Palestinian Syrian refugees in Jordan, 45,000 Palestinian Syrian refugees in Lebanon, and 6,000 refugees in Egypt, according to the UNRWA's statistics till July 2015.
- At least 36,000 Palestinian Syrian refugees have reached Europe during the last 4 years.
- The Yarmouk Camp: - Siege, imposed by the Regular Army and PFGC, continued for 801 days respectively. In addition, power cuts continued for more than 871 days, water was cut for 361 days respectively. The number of victims due to the siege has reached to 180 victims.
- Al Sbeina Camp: - Regular Army is still preventing the residents of the camp to return back to their houses for 663 days respectively.
- Handarat Camp: - Residents have left the camp for 864 days after the Syrian Opposition Groups controlled it.
- Dara'a Camp: - It is now almost 508 days without water and 70% of its buildings were demolished.
- Jarmana, AL Saieda Zainab, Al Raml, Al Aedein Camps in Homs and Hamma: - A relatively quiet situation in light of the economic crises.
- Khan Al Sheih Camp: - Roads linking the camp to the city center are still closed except for Zakia- Khan Al Shieh road.
