"Khan Al-Sheih Residents' Protest in front of UNRWA's Office Demanding to Take its Responsibilities"

Recent Updates

Dozens of Khan Al-Sheih residents' in Damascus countryside were protesting yesterday in front of UNRWA's office. They were demanding to establish healthy and educational centers and to commit with UNRWA humanitarian duties towards 12000 civilians inside the camp.



UNRWA announced closing all of its schools' after the direct hit which Salameh Girls Preparatory School in Khan Al- Shieh had taken on 28 September 2016 that resulted in one eighth grade student being injured, as well as two teachers, one of whom was seriously wounded. The explosion hit an entrance door adjacent to the teachers' room inside the school compound.

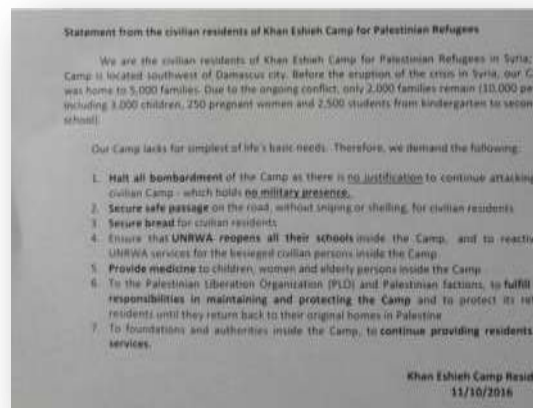
On 30 September 2016, UNRWA in the Near East strongly condemned the parties responsible for the shelling of one of its schools in Khan Al-Shieh in western Damascus countryside.

It reiterated its strong demands that all concerned parties refrain from employing methods and means of warfare – including weapons – that expose civilians, including Palestine refugees, to grave risk of death and



injury. All parties must comply fully with their obligations under international humanitarian law, including as regards the protection of civilians.

At the end of the sit – in, the protesters handed a note from Khan Al-Sheih residents' to UNRWA and Palestinian parties. They listed in the note some points. For instance, the camp is clear from weapons or armed people, demands to stop targeting the camp and to open safe roads, the necessity of delivering food, infants' milk and medical aids and appeals for UNRWA, PLO and all Palestinian parties to take responsibility towards the camp and support its residents' steadfastness till they return to Palestine



Turning to another subject, Yarmouk camp in the south of Syria witnessed at Monday night fierce clashes between Syrian regime and its Palestinian parties' affiliates against ISIS in the outskirts of "Yarmouk Secondary" in Jalal Kawash St. In the same time, a number of mortars were dropped on different places in the camp without any recorded injuries.



AGPS reporter conformed that the pro-UNRWA Karmel School had been handed over by ISIS to FPM (Free Palestine movement), which is allied with Syrian regime without bloodshed.

Some activist said that handing the school which is near to Yarmouk municipality, the center of regime members and Palestinian parties, is a preface for ISIS withdrawal from the camp.

In a related context, ISIS has published yesterday some photos of military training during a graduating ceremony for what they called "Succession camps" in Yarmouk.



Moving to another subject, AGPS reporter confirmed the news of targeting one of the houses in Neirab on Monday by one missile without any recorded injuries. In the same time, the surrounding towns of the camp were witnessing violent clashes between regime army and armed opposition groups.

On 7 October 2016, Neirab witnessed missile strike, One of the missiles fall on a farm land causing material damages. It's worth mentioning that



the adjacent location of the camp to Neirab military airport made it a battleground to the parties of struggle in Syria. It has been bombed and shot leaving victims and injuries since the beginning of war in Syria.

Palestinians of Syria; Numbers and Statistics until 11/10/2016

- *(15500) Palestinian Syrian refugees are in Jordan.*
- *(42,500) Palestinian Syrian refugees are in Lebanon.*
- *(6000) Palestinian Syrian refugees are in Egypt, according to the UNRWA statistics till July 2015.*
- *(8000) Palestinian Syrian refugees are in Turkey.*
- *(1000) Palestinian Syrian refugees are in Gaza.*
- *More than (79,000) Palestinian Syrian refugees have reached Europe till mid-2016.*
- *Yarmouk Camp: siege, imposed by the Regime's Army and PFGC groups, continued for (1211) consecutive days. Power cut continued for more than (1272) days. water was cut for (762) days respectively. The number of siege victims is (188).*
- *Sabina Camp: Regime's Army is still forbidding the residents of the camp to return back to their houses for (1064) days respectively.*
- *Handarat Camp: - All Residents have left the camp for about (1256) days after the Syrian Opposition Groups controlled it.*
- *Daraa Camp: - It is now almost (914) days without water and almost 70% of its buildings were totally destroyed.*
- *Jarmana, AL Sayeda -Zeinab, Al Raml, Al Aedein Camps in Homs and Hama: A relatively quiet situation in light of the economic crises.*
- *Khan Al Sheih Camp: Roads linking the camp to the city center are still closed except for Zakia- Khan Al Sheih road.*
