"Heavy Shelling Targets Khan Al Shieh Camp in Damascus Suburb"

Recent Updates

A number of mortar shells targeted Khan Al Shieh camp, and led to material damage in buildings and property in the eastern neighborhood of the camp, while the adjacent farms were targeted with at least three explosive barrels causing the spread of panic among residents.

Meanwhile, the regular army continues to close all roads linking between the camp and the center of the capital, Damascus, except for "Zakya – Khan Al Shieh," forcing people to go through it despite the repeated shelling with missiles and medium weapons.

In the same context, violent clashes with missiles and medium weapons broke out in the Yarmouk camp, at dawn yesterday at the Yarmouk high school for girls and the municipality areas.

Moreover, the Syrian regime members and the Palestinian groups targeted the Yarmouk main Street with many explosive shots.

Moreover, some activists confirmed to the AGPS that the recent news related to the local council of Beit Sahem town of giving people of



Yarmouk camp "48" hours to leave is incorrect news. The incorrect news spread after the notable council of the town demanded to evacuate a building upon its owner's request, and the confusion has been resolved after the intervention of the local council with the Senate.

It is worth mentioning that thousands of Palestinian refugees from the Yarmouk refugee camp were displaced to neighboring towns following the storming of ISIS on April, while the regular army and PFGC groups still impose a siege on the camp for 714 days respectively.

Turkey

Activists confirmed to the AGPS that the Turkish authorities continue to detain about 50 Palestinian refugees in a stadium at Izmir for the second day respectively.

Activists added that the Turkish authorities arrested the 50 refugees while trying to reach Greece from the Turkish coast.

Moreover, the activists transfer the suffering of the detainees, where there are a number of women and children among them, where the stadium



lacks to the basic needs such as medical care and blankets, demanding at the same time to release them as soon as possible.

Civil Work Committees

Jafra Institution for Youth Development in Khan Al Shieh Camp in Damascus Suburb Opened a Summer Camp for children entitled as "Zaytoun Al Jaleil."

The club contains a set of activities and programs that focus on providing psychological support, risk awareness, and to develop children talents, including drawing, sports, theater, Dabka, in addition to teaching languages.

In the same context, "Al Marhama" campaign that was launched by a number of international relief agencies, is preparing to distribute aid to Palestinian refugees in Yalda town adjacent to the besieged Yarmouk refugee camp.



For his part, Dr. Mohammed Hannon, head of Al Marhama campaign, confirmed that the convoy includes six baskets of food, vegetables, baby milk, and bread in an attempt to alleviate the suffering of those affected people in the Yarmouk refugee camp and the southern region.

Numbers and Statistics till 11/6/2015

- *80,000 Palestinian refugees escaped from Syria, including 10,687 refugees in Jordan, 51300 refugees in Lebanon, and 6,000 refugees in Egypt, according to the UNRWA's statistics till February 2015.*
- *At least 27933 Palestinian Syrian refugees have reached Europe during the last 4 years.*
- *The number of Palestinian detainees who were documented by the AGPS has reached 888 detainees, and 398 victims were killed due to torture in the Syrian prisons.*
- *The Yarmouk Camp: - Siege, imposed by the Regular Army and PFGC, continued for 714 days respectively. In addition, power cuts continued for more than 784 days, water was cut for 274 days respectively. The number of victims due to the siege has reached to 176 victims.*
- *Al Husayneyya Camp: - Regular Army is still preventing the residents of the camp to return back to their houses for 595 days respectively.*
- *Al Sbeina Camp: - Regular Army is still preventing the residents of the camp to return back to their houses for 576 days respectively.*
- *Handarat Camp: - Residents have left the camp for 778 days after the Syrian Opposition Groups controlled it.*

- *Dara'a Camp: - It is now almost 421 days without water and 70% of its buildings were demolished.*
- *Jermana, AL Saieda ZAINAB, Al Raml, Al Aedein Camps in Homs and Hamma: - A relatively quiet situation in light of the economic crises.*
- *Khan Al Sheih Camp: - Roads linking the camp to the city center are still closed except for Zakia- Khan Al Sheih road.*
