### **Recent Updates**

*Although the tragic situation that the Palestinians refugees in Syria live, like frequent bombings and continues siege, the camps continue to stand beside the Gaza Strip people because they are exposed to an oppressing aggression from the Israeli occupation.*

*The Yarmouk people, who are besieged for a year, participated in solidarity demonstrations and roamed the streets of the camp and were launched after Al Jomaa Prayer. The scouting team holding the Palestinians flags was at the head of the demonstration. The people chanted mottos that describe the Palestinian blood unity and their stay beside their families against the Israeli aggression.*

*The people of AlHusiniya, Jermana, Al'aedeen in Homs, and the Palestinians of Syria in Sidon in Lebanon joined the solidarity sit-ins with the people of the Gaza Strip against the Israeli aggression hoping to stop the aggression on the civilian people and ensuring the fate and aim unity.*



***Solidarity with Gaza in Al'aedeen refugee camp***

*Returning back to the Yarmouk camp case, the camp is still under a strict siege, imposed by the Regular Army and the Popular Front-General Command for a year. The camp suffers of acute shortage of food items*



*and medical services which led to 151 victims because of hunger and lack of medical care.*

*UNRWA distributed a limited amount of food aids to the people of the Yarmouk, where the Palestine Red Crescent volunteers participated in the distribution process.*



*Distribution of aid in Yarmouk refugee camp*

*Khan Al Sheh Palestinian Refugees Camp, in Damascus City, witnessed the return of electricity to its houses, after it was cut for about two weeks, where the telephone and ADSL internet are still cut.*

*In a related context, two explosions were heard in the camp, it appeared to be bombing on the surrounding areas. It is mentioned that the camp and its vicinity witness a repeated bombings which resulted in cutting the roads that connect the camp with the capital center. The cut has a negative impact on the availability and the price of basic materials.*

### **Serbia**

*Tens of detained Palestinians of Syria in the Serbian prisons announced immediate appeals, through the Action Group for Palestinians of Syria, all sides and organizations such as human rights and official organizations to an immediate interference to put an end to their suffering. The Serbian authorities detained them in charge of illegal immigration and calling to deport them to Greece as soon as possible.*



*In details, 29 Palestinian refugees from Khan Al Sheih Palestinian Refugees Camp in Damascus city decided to leave their camps because their camps were exposed to bombing and siege. They try to reach the European countries hoping to find safety and stability, but the Serbian police arrested them during their travel to a European country through their airport. The Police detained them in Cap Dom prison in Nis City.*

*It is worth mentioning that no country in the world grants the Palestinians coming from Syria VISAS which compel them to risk their lives and travel illegally. All these ways will expose the refugees to be cheated and deceived or to violence under the pretext of illegal immigration.*

### ***Jordan***

*The Jordanian authorities prevented the Taiba Charity Association to distribute food aids to the Palestinians of Syria refugees in the Cyper City compound, under the pretext of not having a former permission from the Jordanian authorities.*



***Cyper City compound***



*It is worth mentioning that there are 200 Palestinians of Syria refugees in the Cyper City compound, who left their camps because of the bombing and the siege. The Cyper city compound is a building that contains of 6 floors and 140 rooms Located in the Ramtha city 100km north of Amman near the Syrian borders. The building is for Asian workers who work in factories in Irbid.*

### **Civil Work Committees**

*The Charity commission for the Relief of Palestinian People in cooperation with a number of relief commissions distributed 200 meat packages to the displaced people in the shelter centers in Al Zahra neighborhood in Damascus.*
