VICTIMS

Taysir Rahal, Palestinian refugee from Alsayeda-Zainb camp, announced dead in Daraya. Rahal, pro-Assad fighter, was killed during the clash with the Syrian opposition forces in the west of the Syrian capital, bringing the number of Palestinian victims in Alsayeda-Zainb camp, from both sides, to (47) during the Syrian war.

RECENT UPDATES

The Syrian military helicopters have launched raids on several locations around Khan Eshieh camp. The helicopters dropped, at least, four explosive barrels resulting in huge explosions in the area and significant damage in civilians' homes.



It is worth noting that Assad army had targeted the road between Khan Eshieh and Zakyah earlier using the heavy machine guns. The road is the only access to Damascus centre making citizen's lives at a high risk . It is indicated that all other roads to the capital have been closed by check points of the Syrian army.



NGOs

The European Alwafaa campaign announced that it carried out several charitable tours in the Bekaa province in Lebanon. The campaign had launched a relief project entitled "Together For A Warm Winter" to cover refugees in Palestine, Syria, Lebanon and Turkey, Alwafaa said. The recent tours in Lebanon covered the border mountain villages with Syrian (The Faour - Housh Aharima- Gaza - Qaraoun - Alrvida - Bikfaya - Majdal Belaid - Rashaya - Khirbet Roha - Majdal Belaas).

Alwafaa campaign have appealed all charities and relief organisations working in Lebanon to visit these villages in order to alleviate the suffering of those stranded people.



Palestinians of Syria in numbers and statistics Until 12 January 2016

- *15,500 Palestinian Syrian refugees in Jordan, 42,500 Palestinian Syrian refugees in Lebanon, and 6,000 refugees in Egypt, according to the UNRWA's statistics till July 2015.*
- *More than 71,200 Palestinian Syrian refugees have arrived Europe until the end of December 2015.*

- *The Yarmouk Camp: still under siege imposed by the Syrian Regime's Army and PFLP-GC (Popular Front for the Liberation of Palestine – General Command), continued for 924 days respectively. In addition, power cuts continued for more than 984 days, water cut for 484 days. The number of victims due to the siege has reached to 185 victims .*
- *Al Sbeina Camp: Syrian Regime's Army still preventing the residents from returning back to their houses for 920 days respectively.*
- *Handarat Camp: All of its residents have left the camp for 984 days after the Syrian Opposition Groups controlled it.*
- *Dara'a Camp: Running water cut continues for 638 days, and 70% of its buildings were destroyed.*
- *Jarmana, AL-SaiedaZainab, Al-Raml, Al-Aedein Homs and AedeinHama: A relatively quiet situations in light of the economic crises.*
- *Khan Al Sheih Camp: Roads linking the camp to the city center are still closed except for Zakia-Khan EShieh road.*
