“The Water Crisis Continues in the Yarmouk Camp in Damascus and Daraa Camp Southern Syria”



Water crises in Yarmouk Camp

- A member of PFGC was killed while planting an explosive bomb in the Yarmouk Camp.
- Warplanes targeted Handarat Camp in Aleppo with explosive barrels.
- Palestine Charity Committee distributes water bottles to the children of Al Amal kindergarten in the Yarmouk Camp.
- Economic crises to the Palestinian families in Qudseia town in Damascus city.
- Reports about a meeting between a delegation from Khan Dannoun camp and leaders of the Opposition brigades in the vicinity of the camp.
- Bombing targeted the sides of Khan AL Sheih camp in Damascus city.

Victims

The young man Nidal Mahmoud Dawwa, a member of the PFGC was killed while he was planting an explosive bomb on the border-line, and according to the correspondent of the Action Group, Dawwa tried to plant and explosive bomb in the touch-line between the Regular Army, the PF, and the armed groups, but the bomb exploded and killed him.

Recent Updates

The water cut entered its 181 days in Daraa Camp for Palestinian refugees southern Syria, while the remains residents are suffering of severe difficulties of securing water. The water cut from the Yarmouk Camp for the 34 days respectively which aggravate the living crises of the besieged residents for more than a year, as the siege coincided with the power cut for more than a year and a half.

It is mentioned that the strict siege imposed by the Regular Army and groups of PFGC has led to the death of 155 victims as a result of the lack of nutrition and medical care. In the same context, Palestine Charity Committee distributed water bottles to the children of AL Amal kindergarten in the Yarmouk Camp, in order to maintain the safety of children and to reduce the spread of diseases among them.



On the other hand, explosive barrels and number of missiles targeted different places at Handarat Camp for Palestinian refugees in Aleppo, which is controlled by the Syrian Opposition forces, yesterday, causing material damages to the homes and property of the residents. It is referred that most of the people had fled because of repeated clashes and shelling.

In Damascus city, Palestinian families who were displaced from their camps because of the bombing, the clashes and the siege, especially the residents of the Yarmouk camp, who live temporarily in Qudsayya town, are suffering from high prices of rent houses, and thereby increasing the suffering of the people who lost their works due to the war.

Therefore, a delegation from the people of Khan Dannoun camp met a number of officials of the military opposition brigades located in the vicinity of the camp, which had previously warned the residents several times to target the camp. The delegation, according to the news, explained his point of view and emphasized on the need not to drag the camp in battles, thus, the Action Group has not been able to confirm the accuracy of these reports.



Meanwhile, helicopters hovered in the sky of Khan AL Sheih camp in coincided with targeting of the adjacent farms with a number of shells, while all roads linking between the camp and the surrounding areas are still closed except "Zakya-Khan Al Sheih", which forced the people to use it in spite of the risks.

The Situation of the Palestinian Camps in Syria:

The Yarmouk Camp: *The Continuance of the siege by the Regular Army and PFGC for the 466 respectively in addition to the power cut for more than 547 days and the water cut for 34 days respectively. The number of the siege victims is 155 victims.*

Al Husayneyya Camp: *The Regular Army still prevents the residents of the camp to return back to their houses for the 366 days respectively.*

Al Sbeina Camp: *The Regular Army still prevents the residents of the camp to return back to their houses for the 336 days respectively.*

Handarat Camp:*-The residents left the camp since 535 days after the Syrian Opposition Groups controlled the camp.*

Khan Al Sheih Camp:*-The continuance of closing the roads with the shortage of medical care and food supplies.*

Khan Danoun Camp: *a tension state due to targeting the camp with mortar shells before days in addition to that the camp is crowded and the shortage of basic services and bothering of the Regime checkpoints.*

Dara'a Camp: *The camp is suffering from the water cut since 181 days and the absence of basic services inside the camp in addition to the displacement of hundreds of its people due to the siege, frequent bombing, and clashes.*

Al Nairab Camp: *the spread of Al Quds Brigade members which is affiliated to the Syrian Regime and the continuance of the economic crises.*
