“Bombing, Clashes and Burning Water Tank in the Yarmouk Camp”



- A Group of the Armed Syrian Opposition adopted the exploding of a building hold by the Regular Army in the Yarmouk camp.
- Bombings targeted the vicinity of Al Nairab camp.
- Members affiliated to the Regular army insulted and beat Refugees from Al Aedin camp in Homs.
- An officer of the PLA died in Al Madameyya town in Damascus suburb.
- A state of calmness was prevailed in the streets of Khan Al Sheih camp in light of the Power and Telecommunications cut.
- The Action Group”99 victims from the residents of Al Husayneeya camp died since the beginning of the Syrian conflict.”

Recent Updates

The Yarmouk camp witnessed violent clashes between the armed groups inside the camp and the regular army with the PFGC on the other hand near the Yarmouk Municipality in Palestine Street. That coincided with the fall of a number of shells targeted the surrounding of al-Yarmouk secondary school at "Jalal Kawash" street. Unknown front from the camp has burnt the mobile water tanks which are used by the relief associations to distribute water on the remaining people inside the camp as an attempt to ease the effects of water outage since "65" days. It's noteworthy that the camp has seen in the recent period many of the security incidents from unknown fronts. The affiliated groups to the Syrian Opposition accused the regular army and the PFGCGs for the incidents while the latter confirmed that what happened is a purge between internal opposition groups.

In the same context, Aknaf Bait Al Maqdis "one of the closest groups for the armed opposition Syrian forces" adopted the bombing of a building holed by the regular army soldiers. The video, published by the group on their official Face-Book webpage, showed the process of setting the explosive bombs by their elements, and how they infiltrate into the building, in the night, where a number of the regular army soldiers and groups of Fatah al-Intifada were inside.

In the morning, they bombarded the building that resulted a number of casualties and injuries, according to the statement declared by one of the "Aknaf Bait Al Maqdis "leaders. He added that this bombing came as a response to the bombing, the continuation of the siege and the water outage which the Yarmouk camp is exposed to by regular army forces , the PFGC and Fatah al-Intifada.

The Action Group couldn't make sure of the validity of the video from another source.

In Aleppo, Al-Neirab camp for Palestinian refugees was targeted by a number of shells and the explosion sounds were heard clearly inside the camp, prompting a state of anxiety among its people. It's known that that the camp, which is controlled by the regular army, is one of the strategic areas in Aleppo due to its nearness to the Nairab' military airport.



In a separate context, a group of Popular Committees elements that affiliate the Syrian regular army broke into Mohammed Zuhair Al Sebai' pharmacy in Ikrima village to the east of the camp in order to kidnap him. It comes after "AL Sebai" received many threats via his phone to close his pharmacy. A number of the popular committees attacked the pharmacy and hit Al Sebai severely injuring him with a number of fractures in the skull. And in a related context, the committees "affiliated to the regular army" has raided the University City' street looking for "Jamal Al Sayed", later he was arrested, then a state of tension prevailed the camp.

In Damascus suburb, the officer "Subhi Omran Krdaisy" was killed due to clashes between the Palestine Liberation Army and the forces of the Syrian opposition. He is from Al Lathekia and a PLA officer form Muadamiyat area in Damascus suburb. This bringing the number of the Palestinian Liberation Army members who have died due to the clashes in Syria to "94" victim.

A state of calmness was prevailed in the streets of Khan Al Sheih camp in Damascus Suburb coincided with sounds of explosions due to bombing the surrounding farms and areas. In terms of living, the residents, who receive hundreds of displaced people from the surrounding camps into their camp, suffer of the continuation of power cut for long periods in



addition to the weakness of the internet and communication networks and the high prices and fuel unavailability.

Release

The Syrian Security released the young man Abdulrahman Subheyya who was born in 1981 from Asl Aedin camp in Hama where he was arrested the last year.

The Action Group for Palestinians of Syria

The Action Group for Palestinians of Syria documentation team announced that the number of the Palestinians from Al Husaeneyya camp who died since the beginning of the events is 99 victims, 73% of Males and 27% of females.

The Documentation team mentioned that bombing was the main cause of death so that the average of the bombing death toll is 26% as 70 victims. The bombing led to the death of whole families most of the time as Al Sawlama family who were killed due to the bombing at the camp on 14th of October 2012 where the Mother Maryem Rudeni and he four daughters Shorouq, Hamas, Fedaa and Hanan Jamal Sawlama.

On 17th January 2013, 11 refugees were killed due to bombing the camp by the MEG warplanes. Sniping and direct shooting were the second cause of death in the camp where the number of the victims was 15 refugees from the camp. On 26th of September 2012, the corpses of Saleh Abu Ras, Musa Abu Ras and Firas Abu Ras were found in front of Al Ashra Al Mobashareen Bel Janna Mosque inside the camp after they were field executed by the militias and Committees that are affiliated to the Syrian Regime.

On 8 January 2013, the activists Esam Khozaei and Omar Helal were executed by the Regular Army and their corpse were thrown near Al Sayyeda Aisha Mosque inside the camp. It was documented that five of the camp's residents died due to torture in the Syrian prisons, on 13th of



June 2013, it was announced that the two brothers Hammam and Lawrence Al Shafi died after being arrested for unknown period.

The Palestinian Camps in Syria, Numbers and Statistics

- *The Yarmouk Camp: - Siege, imposed by the Regular Army and PFGC, continued for 495 days respectively. In addition, power cuts continued for more than 578 days, water was cut for 65 days respectively. The number of victims due to the siege has reached 156 victims.*
- *41 Palestinian refugees were killed outside of Syria .94 PLO members were killed due to Clashes in Syria.*
- *Al Husayneyya Camp: - Regular Army is still preventing the residents of the camp to return back to their houses for 397 days respectively.*
- *Al Sbeina Camp: - Regular Army is still preventing the residents of the camp to return back to their houses for 366 days respectively.*
- *Handarat Camp: - Residents have left the camp for 566 days after the Syrian Opposition Groups controlled it.*
- *Dara'a Camp: - It is now almost 212days without water and a complete absence of basic services.*
- *Khan Al Sheih Camp: - Roads linking the camp to the city center are still closed except for Zakia road.*
- *Khan Danoun Camp: - Economic crisis is still continuing, specially unemployment and high prices.*
- *Al Nairab Camp: - Power is still cut for more than a year.*
- *Jermana, AL Saieda ZAINAB, Al Raml, Al Aedein Camps in Homs and Hamma: - A relatively quite situation in light of the economic crises.*
