### ***Victims***

*The 25-year-Palestinian refugee, Nidal Ibrahim Al Shamali, from Al Aedein camp in Hama, died due to torture in the Prisons of the Syrian Regime, after being detained for 2 years.*



### ***Recent Updates***

*Emir of Al Nusra Front in the Yarmouk Camp, Abu Yousef Al Deraawi Al Hourani, was assassinated yesterday by an explosive device that targeted him near Malhamat Al Milion area in the besieged camp.*

*The leader of Al Nusra Front, Abu Mohammed Joulani had appointed Abu Yousef, who is known with hate for ISIS, as the new emir of Al Nusra branch in the Yarmouk refugee camp. Abu Yousef was appointed after the Emir, Abu Khader, was isolated and who was in alliance with ISIS, and who paved the way for its entry to the Yarmouk camp last April.*





*The 20-year-Palestinian refugee, "Laith Shihabi," from the Yarmouk refugee camp was shot dead by "Abu Ali Mohammad Saedi," a leader of Al Nusra Front, while the real reasons behind this incident are unknown yet.*

*Members of Yalda checkpoint of the Syrian armed opposition closed the road between the Yarmouk camp and Yalda area from the two sides, after the security tensions in the Yarmouk refugee camp.*

*The relationship between ISIS and Al Nusra in the one hand, and the armed opposition groups in the other hand, is strained, after ISIS and Al-Nusra Front in the Yarmouk camp and Al Hajar Al Aswad were accused of assassinating members of the armed opposition and a number of activists in Yalda.*

*Turning to Damascus suburb, three mortar shells targeted the eastern neighborhood of Khan Al Shieh camp in Damascus suburb, and resulted in limited material damages.*

*A state of panic and tension prevailed as a result of targeting the adjacent farms with anti-aircraft Shilka, while it hit the residents' houses, and some shots exploded in the roofs.*

*The shelling coincided with violent clashes that broke out at Al Salam highway and the vicinity of Darousha between the regular army and armed opposition groups.*



### **Sweden**

*Swedish media sources said that the government will impose a border control on the southern borders of Sweden starting on Thursday, and will continue for an initial period of 10 days and can be extended. Control will be imposed mainly on the Oresund Bridge, which connects Sweden with Denmark, and the ports of ships in Scona.*

*This comes after the announcement of Sweden that it is no longer able to provide guarantees to receive more refugees, according to Immigration Minister Morgan Johansson.*

*The minister pointed out in a press conference that "the most demanding problem lies in the very rapid rise in the number of asylum seekers arriving in Sweden, stressing that the country is no longer able to open a sufficient number of reception centers.*

*Two days ago, the number of asylum seekers has reached 2160 refugees in only one day, while during 7 days; their number has reached 10,822 people. Thousands of Palestinian refugees fled from Syria and rode the sea or on foot, bringing them up to the European countries of asylum and especially Sweden.*





### ***Numbers and Statistics till 12/11/2015***

- *15,500 Palestinian Syrian refugees in Jordan, 45,000 Palestinian Syrian refugees in Lebanon, and 6,000 refugees in Egypt, according to the UNRWA's statistics till July 2015.*
- *At least 36,000 Palestinian Syrian refugees have reached Europe during the last 4 years.*
- *The Yarmouk Camp: - Siege, imposed by the Regular Army and PFGC, continued for 864 days respectively. In addition, power cuts continued for more than 934 days, water was cut for 424 days respectively. The number of victims due to the siege has reached to 182 victims.*
- *Al Sbeina Camp: - Regular Army is still preventing the residents of the camp to return back to their houses for 725 days respectively.*
- *Handarat Camp: - Residents have left the camp for 926 days after the Syrian Opposition Groups controlled it.*
- *Dara'a Camp: - It is now almost 570 days without water and 70% of its buildings were demolished.*
- *Jarmana, AL Saieda Zainab, Al Raml, Al Aedein Camps in Homs and Hamma: - A relatively quiet situation in light of the economic crises.*
- *Khan Al Sheih Camp: - Roads linking the camp to the city center are still closed except for Zakia- Khan Al Shieh road.*
