### *"Targeting the Last Open Road to Khan Eshien Camp by Submachine Guns"*



- Thousands of Palestinians in Daraa are still under suffering.
- People of Al-Aidien Camp on Hama complain of the persistent economic crises.
- Documenting 1018 cases of arrest and enforced disappearance of Palestinian-Syrians.
- Denmark may confiscate the "precious" properties from asylum seekers to spend on them.

### ***RECENT UPDATES***

*The Syrian Regime's army targeted, yesterday, by submachine guns Khan Eshieh – Zakiya road which is the last open road to Khan Eshieh camp in Damascus Suburb, without reports of injuries so far.*

*At the same time, warplanes' raids hit the surrounding farms of the camp causing a tension and fear status among the civilians of the camp.*



*It is noteworthy that the regime's army is still closing all the road of Khan Eshieh camp towards capital Damascus back and forth which affected negatively the markets and caused a severe shortage of basic commodities and notable rise of the prices.*

*In a different context, the suffering of thousands of Palestinian-Syrians in south of Syria continued as the clashes and shelling and warplanes raids continued destroying 75% of the camp's building so far.*

*Regarding the medical sector, it is noted that there are neither hospitals nor medical centers inside the camp, in addition to the severe shortage of first aid supplies, and the need for an ambulance car to transport injuries towards the hospitals of Daraa city.*



*It is noteworthy that Jordanian authorities refuse to let any Palestinians pass the borders to get the medical care. In front of this situation; many activists warned from the spread of diseases among the camp's people especially while being forced to use the contaminated water as the regime still cutting the running water for 599 days.*

*Daraa camp residents are suffering from the electricity cut also, as the cut continues up to many days each time, added to shortage of heating fuel and many basic commodities.*

*It is noteworthy that the repeated bombing and the difficult living conditions have forced hundreds of Palestinian-Syrian families of the camp to take refuge in the neighboring towns.*

*In a related context, residents of Al-Aidien camp in Hama which hosts a large number of displaced families from camps and cities of Damascus, Aleppo, Idlib, Hama, Deir Ezzor and Raqqa and Deraa and Latakia, live a state of relative calm compared to the rest of the Palestinian refugee camps in Syria, but they suffer from the tightened security cordon imposed by the regular army at the entrances and exits of the camp, and repetitive arrests carried out by the regular army every now and then.*





*In the economic side, residents of the camp complain of the widespread unemployment due to the tense security situation, which casted a shadow on their life and made most of them lose work and become completely dependent on relief aid that is distributed every now and then.*

*On the other hand, the monitoring and documentation team of AGPS confirmed documenting (1018) arrest and enforced disappearance cases of Palestinian-Syrians from different camps in Syria.*

*Monitoring and documentation team of AGPS believes that the real number is much more than that as it is expected to exceed 1,500 arrestees, where the security situation, and fears about the fate of their relatives prevent families from announcing the arrest of their children. It is worth mentioning that 426 Palestinian refugees had died under torture in the prisons of the Syrian regime after being detained for varying periods.*

*Turning to Denmark where Danish media sources confirmed the intention of immigration authorities in Denmark to confiscate the properties – described as precious – from asylum seekers. According to the sources; the Danish authorities will leave with asylum seekers only DKK 3000 and the wedding ring, where everything else will be sold and spent on the refugees.*

*It is noteworthy that Denmark had adopted a strict policy in dealing with asylum seekers especially after the wining of migrants opposing parties in the last election.*



***Palestinians of Syria in numbers and statistics Until 12 December 2015***

- *15500 Palestinian Syrian refugees in Jordan, 45,000 Palestinian Syrian refugees in Lebanon, and 6,000 refugees in Egypt, according to the UNRWA's statistics till July 2015.*
- *More than 36,000 Palestinian Syrian refugees have arrived Europe during the last 4 years.*
- *The Yarmouk Camp: still under siege imposed by the Syrian Regime's Army and PFLP-GC (Popular Front for the Liberation of Palestine – General Command), continued for 894 days respectively. In addition, power cuts continued for more than 964 days, water cut for 454 days. The number of victims due to the siege has reached to 184 victims .*
- *Al Sbeina Camp: Syrian Regime's Army still preventing the residents from returning back to their houses for 755 days respectively.*
- *Handarat Camp: All of its residents have left the camp for 956 days after the Syrian Opposition Groups controlled it.*
- *Dara'a Camp: Water cut continues for 600 days, and 70% of its buildings were destroyed.*
- *Jarmana, AL Saieda Zainab, Al Raml, Al Aedein Homs and Aedein Hamma: A relatively quiet situations in light of the economic crises.*
- *Khan Al Sheih Camp: Roads linking the camp to the city center are still closed except for Zakia- Khan Al Shieh road.*
