***“Dozens of Al Muzaireib Residents survived a Massacre after Warplane Dropped an Explosive Barrel that did not explode”***

- A Palestinian was killed due to torture in the Syrian regime prisons.
- A group of notables of Khan Al Sheih headed to one of the Regular Army headquarters in an attempt to open the road connecting the camp with the surrounding areas.
- PRCS volunteers carried out a sit-in for honoring one of their friends who was killed due to torture in the Syrian regime prisons before days.
- Living crises suffered by AL Rmdan residents at Damascus city.
- Egyptian security arrested a number of Palestinian families while they were travelling to Europe.
- Relief agencies inside Yarmouk camp distributed a part of vegetables crop to the besieged residents.

### **Recent Updates**

*Warplanes targeted a gathering of Al Muzaireib residents with an explosive barrel, but fortunately it did not explode. The town survived from a real massacre had this barrel exploded. Al Muazireib town received hundreds of Palestinian families who fled from Dara'a camp because of clashes and repeated shelling that targeted the camp.*

*The town suffered a severe lack of food and medical supplies because of the repeated clashes in the surrounding area.*

*A delegation of notables of Khan Al Sheih camp in Damascus city headed to the regular army "Seventh Division" headquarters in an attempt to discuss the possibilities of opening the road of Zakia-Kahn AL Sheih which is considered the only way connecting the camp with the city center. There was no available information about the results of this visit. It is worth mentioning that the Regular Army closed Zakia-Kahn Al Sheih road after the clashes that broke out with the opposition forces. In the same context, a number of residents were killed by sniper shots on the road of Zakia- Khan Al Sheih.*

*The services team of Jafra Association in Yarmouk camp at Damascus city distributed 200 kg of eggplant and zucchini to residents in order to secure food self-sufficiency, and to alleviate the pain as well as the consequences of the blockade on the Yarmouk refugee camp for 391 days,*



respectively, by the Regular Army and the Popular Front - General Command.

A number of relief agencies in Yarmouk camp agricultures empty lands and public gardens with various summer vegetables. The residents of the camp agriculture their food storage on the roof of the residential buildings; the foods the residents distribute vary, including different types of herbs, cucumber, tomato, zucchini, along with other crops with high nutritional value. Employees and volunteers of the Palestinian Red Crescent Association in Yarmouk carried out a sit-in in order to honor Maher Nehad Hmaid, a volunteer who died 2 days earlier in the Syria regime army prisons due to being tortured. One of his colleagues spoke about his traits, saying that he was lively and active in serving the community. She also emphasized the necessity of continuing work for the residents, in light of the difficult circumstances of the camp and the medical work.

Al Rmdan camp residents are living in a state of relative quietnes;, however, they live in similar conditions to other Palestinian camps and compounds in Syria who are suffering of huge living crises, most importantly, the high prices, unemployment, and the lack of food, medicine and fuel.

The camp is located in the south-east of Damascus city with distance of approximately 50 km and 9 km away from Al Dameir city. This camp was created with endeavors of UNRWA in Syria years after the Nakba, in the fifties of the twentieth century, and the camp gave shelter to several families from various towns and villages in Palestine.

### ***Egypt***

*The Egyptian security arrested, yesterday, a number of Palestinian and Syrian families while they were trying to reach Europe by sea. A number of these forces raided a gathering of these families in a place near Alexandria beach and arrested them in charge of trying to illegally immigrate. It is mentioned that this was not the first time Egyptian authorities had arrested Palestinian and Syrian families and detained them in difficult circumstances for long periods of time.*

### ***Civil Work Committees***

*Services department of Palestine Charity Committee in the Yarmouk camp cleaned the wastewater network in Loubieh and Haifa Streets. This work included all main streets of the camp; while this action on behalf of the Body of Palestine Charity Committee comes in order to maintain the cleanliness of the camp, and control the spread of insects and diseases among the population.*
